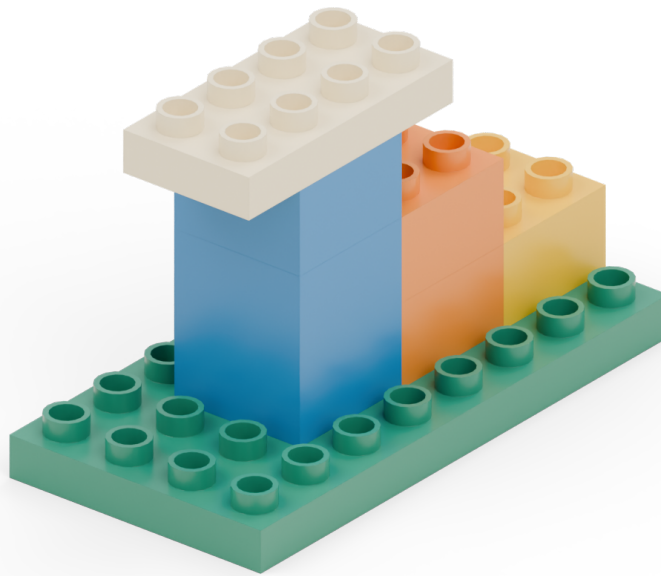


BUILD TOGETHER

Stepped lookout

7 pieces / 4 steps

Three bright levels rise to a small lookout platform. This seven-piece build is a simple way to explore height and count the steps together.



A little model, a little story

Count the three levels.

Imagine what can be seen from the platform.

Take turns describing something near and something far away.

Digital guide; no bricks included. Make it together with an adult.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Match the shapes

Compare each part with its picture and count its rows of studs. A square brick has two rows of two studs; a long brick has two rows of four. Use the full parts list for the exact shapes and quantities.

Follow the colours

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep contrasting colours where they help you recognise the model.

Count the studs

The bumps on top are called studs. Count them when a step asks for a gap or an overhang. Put the build on a flat surface and keep its front facing the same way as in the pictures.

Add a little at a time

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces look lighter so you can see what has changed. Each list tells you exactly what to add.

Build together

An adult can read the steps while a child finds the pieces. The counts are for this one model. For two models to stay built, add their parts lists together.

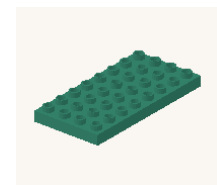
About this build

The top plate overhangs at both ends. Press it into place before playing.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

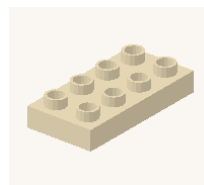
Exact parts checklist

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Choose your own colours for the same parts; changing a part's shape is a different substitution.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

Shape-only checklist

Use this list to sort the shapes. Check the full colour list before building; the two lists count the same pieces.

[] 1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs)

[] 1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs)

[] 4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

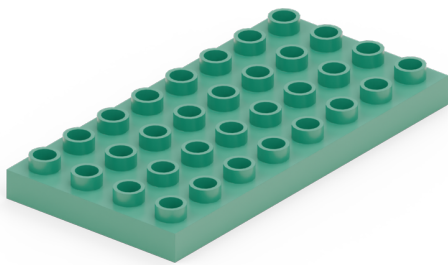
[] 1 x Tall square brick (2 × 2 studs, double height)

Total: 7 pieces

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 1 - 2

01 / Place the green base plate on the table with its long edge running away from you.

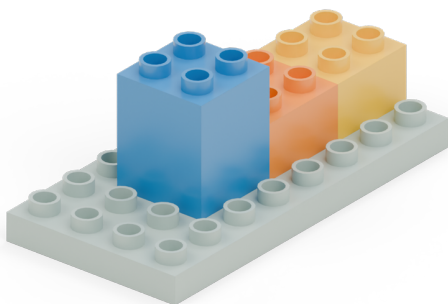


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Leave one stud column free along each side. Place the yellow square at the front, the orange square behind it, and the tall blue square behind the orange brick.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Orange)

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

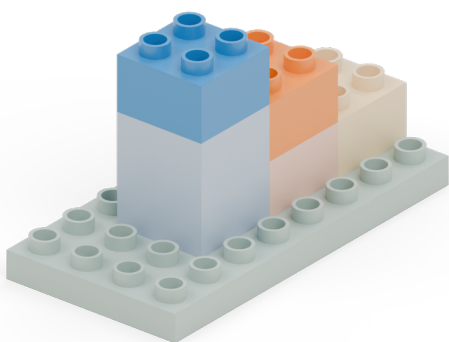
1 x Tall square brick (2 × 2 studs, double height) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 3 - 4

03 / Add an orange square on the orange brick, and a blue square on the tall blue brick. The three levels now rise like steps.



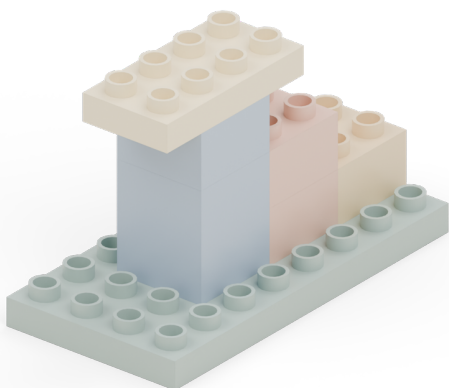
ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Blue)

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Place the cream small plate on the highest blue brick. Leave one row of the plate overhanging at both the front and the back. Press it into place.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

READY TO PLAY

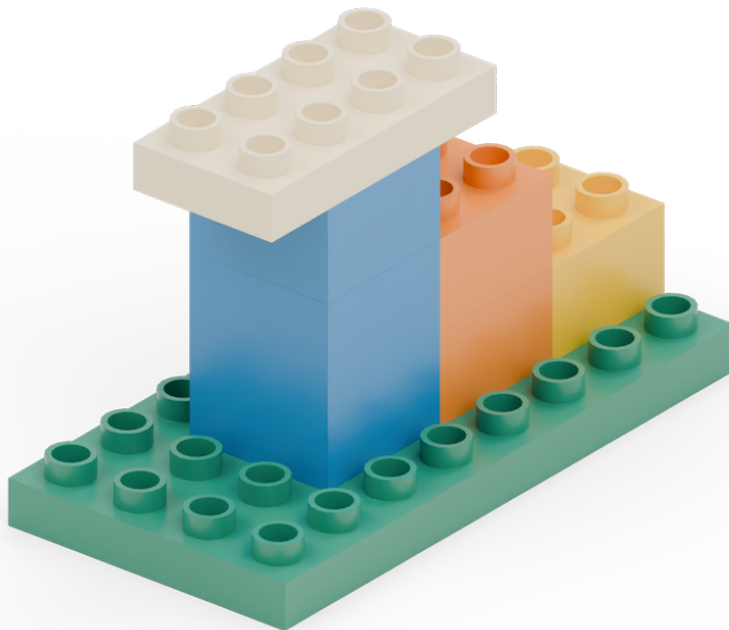
Your little story

Count the three levels.

Imagine what can be seen from the platform.

Take turns describing something near and something far away.

The top plate overhangs at both ends. Press it into place before playing.
