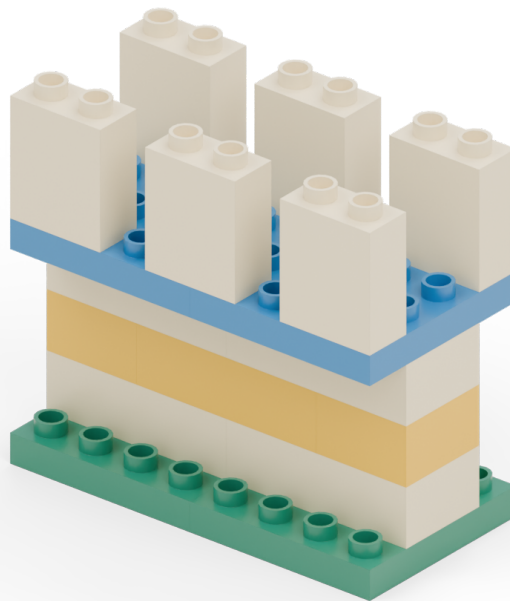


BUILD TOGETHER

Castle wallwalk

17 pieces / 7 steps

A striped wall becomes a raised walkway with a row of battlements on each side. Follow the alternating layers, then look out over an imaginary kingdom.



A little model, a little story

Choose a name for the wall.

Describe three things you can see from the top.

Make up a friendly message to send across the kingdom.

Digital guide; no bricks included. Make it together with an adult.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Match the shapes

Compare each part with its picture and count its rows of studs. A square brick has two rows of two studs; a long brick has two rows of four. Use the full parts list for the exact shapes and quantities.

Follow the colours

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep contrasting colours where they help you recognise the model.

Count the studs

The bumps on top are called studs. Count them when a step asks for a gap or an overhang. Put the build on a flat surface and keep its front facing the same way as in the pictures.

Add a little at a time

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces look lighter so you can see what has changed. Each list tells you exactly what to add.

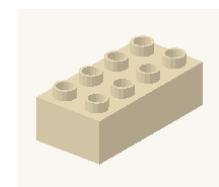
Build together

An adult can read the steps while a child finds the pieces. The counts are for this one model. For two models to stay built, add their parts lists together.

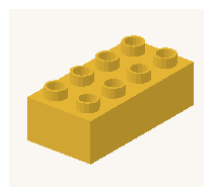
Exact parts checklist

[] 4 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs)

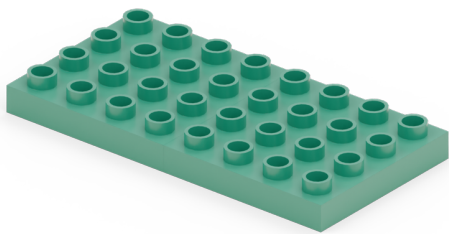
[] 6 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 1 - 2

01 / Set two green square plates side by side to make an eight-by-four base.

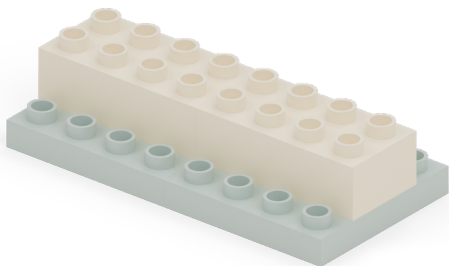


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Centre two cream long bricks end to end across the base. Leave one row of green studs showing along each long edge.



ADD THESE PIECES

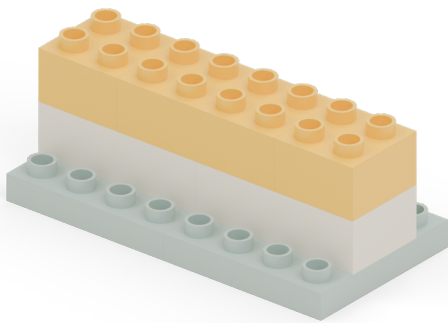
2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 3 - 4

03 / Join the middle seam with a yellow long brick. Put a yellow square at each end to finish the layer.



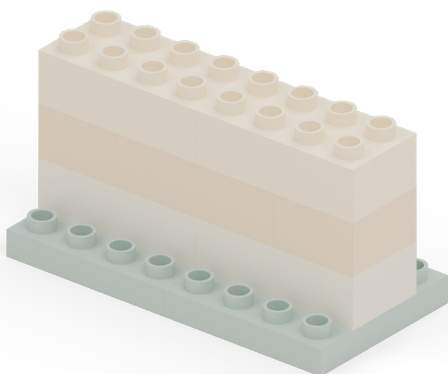
ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Add two more cream long bricks across the wall, lined up with the bottom cream layer.



ADD THESE PIECES

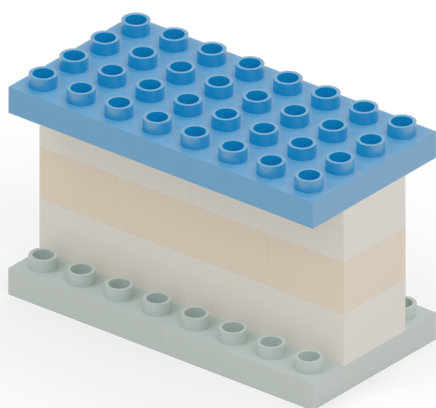
2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 5 - 6

05 / Add two blue square plates over the wall, lined up with the green base, for the walkway.

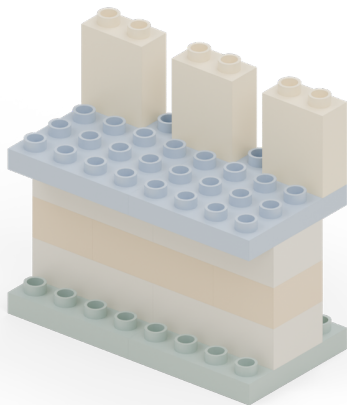


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Make three cream battlements along the back edge. Leave one stud column between neighbours. The middle brick spans the seam between the blue plates.



ADD THESE PIECES

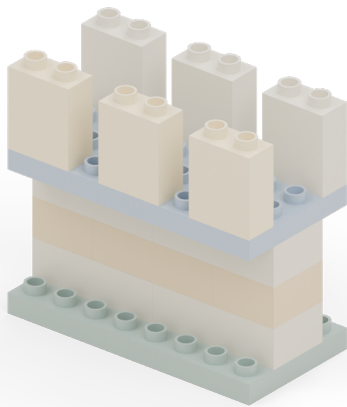
3 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 7

07 / Make three cream battlements along the front edge. Leave one stud column between neighbours. The middle brick spans the seam between the blue plates.



ADD THESE PIECES

3 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)
(Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

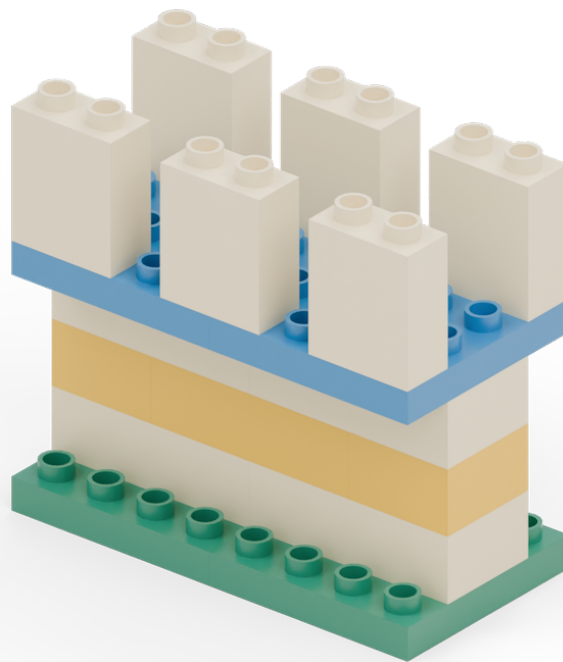
