

BUILD TOGETHER

Woodland treehouse

70 pieces / 26 steps

A staircase leads to a raised cabin beneath two leafy canopies. Build the trunks and deck together, then add the little house and garden bench.



A little model, a little story

Name the treehouse club.

Describe what can be seen from the deck.

Tell a story about a visitor arriving up the steps.

Digital guide; no bricks included. Make it together with an adult.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Match the shapes

Compare each part with its picture and count its rows of studs. A square brick has two rows of two studs; a long brick has two rows of four. Use the full parts list for the exact shapes and quantities.

Follow the colours

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep contrasting colours where they help you recognise the model.

Count the studs

The bumps on top are called studs. Count them when a step asks for a gap or an overhang. Put the build on a flat surface and keep its front facing the same way as in the pictures.

Add a little at a time

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces look lighter so you can see what has changed. Each list tells you exactly what to add.

Build together

An adult can read the steps while a child finds the pieces. The counts are for this one model. For two models to stay built, add their parts lists together.

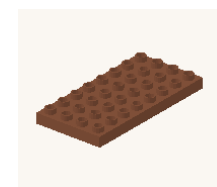
About this build

This is a tall model. Support the base when moving it; the two leaf canopies finish at different heights so they clear each other.

- [] 1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs)
- [] 1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs)
- [] 4 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs)
- [] 44 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)
- [] 4 x Tall roof slope (2 × 3 studs)
- [] 1 x Wide plate (4 × 6 studs)

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 1 - 2

01 / Set two green large base plates side by side to make a twelve-by-twelve garden. Keep the twelve-stud edges running from back to front.

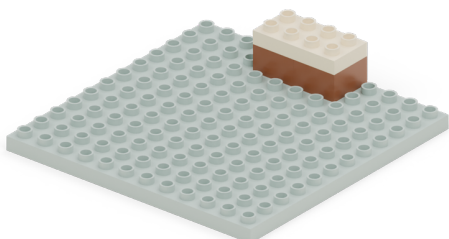


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Large base plate (6 × 12 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Make a garden bench behind the cabin: two brown square feet, then a cream small plate across them.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Cream)

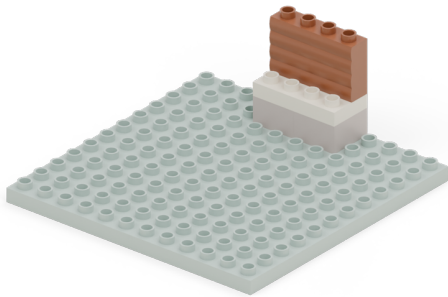
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 3 - 4

03 / Add two brown log bricks along the back of the bench, leaving the front row as a seat.

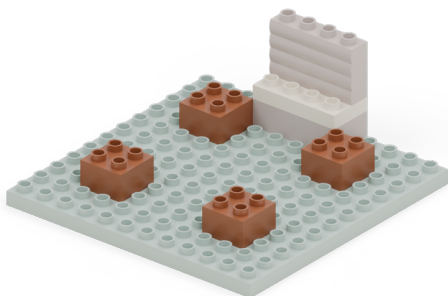


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Log wall brick (2 × 1 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Start four trunks with brown square bricks in a square. Leave two rows of green studs between the outside edges of each trunk and the nearest garden edges.



ADD THESE PIECES

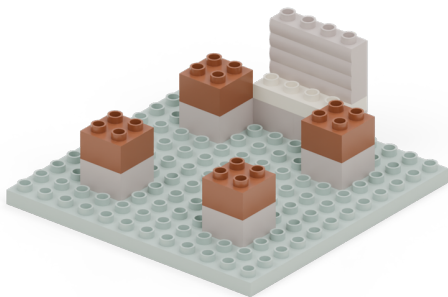
4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 5 - 6

05 / Add one brown square brick directly above each of the four trunks.

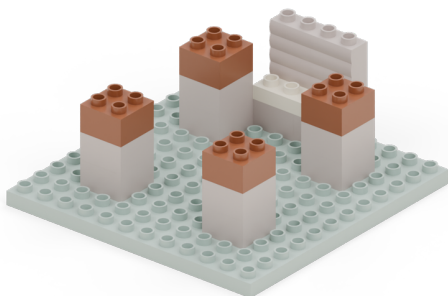


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Add another brown square brick to each trunk. All four are now three bricks high.



ADD THESE PIECES

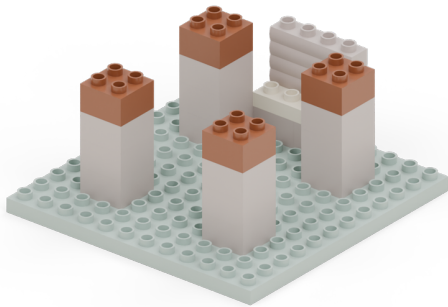
4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 7 - 8

07 / Add another brown square brick to each trunk, keeping all four at the same height.

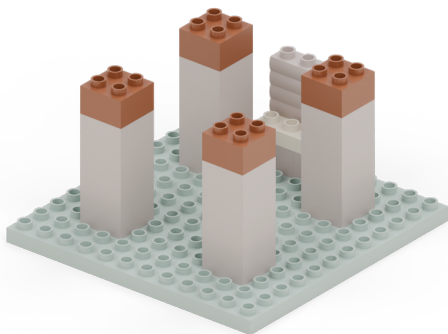


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Add one more brown square brick to each trunk. All four should now be five bricks high.

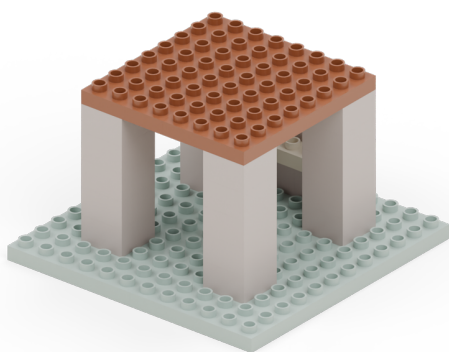
4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 9 - 10

09 / Make the raised deck with two brown base plates, side by side across the four trunks. Each plate runs eight studs from back to front.

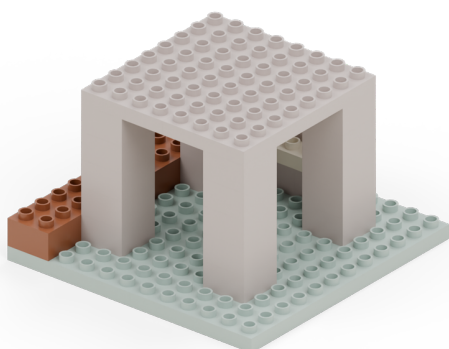


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

10 / Start the staircase along the left edge of the garden. Place five brown square bricks in a line from front to back.



ADD THESE PIECES

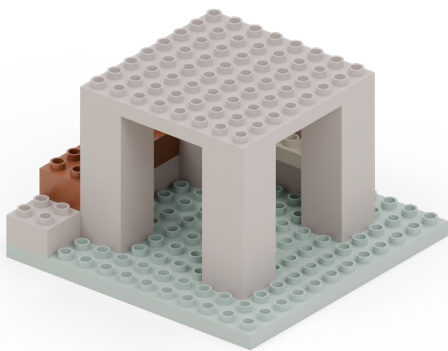
5 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 11 - 12

11 / Place four brown square bricks on the back four bricks of the stair row. Leave the front brick uncovered as the first step.

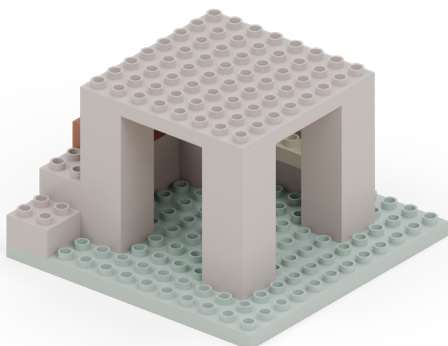


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

12 / Place three brown square bricks on the back three bricks of the new layer. Leave the next step uncovered at the front.



ADD THESE PIECES

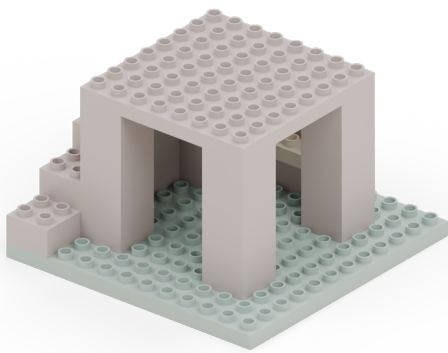
3 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 13 - 14

13 / Place two brown square bricks on the back two bricks of the staircase. Leave the next step uncovered.

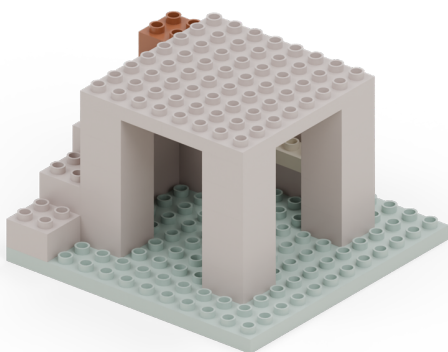


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

14 / Put one brown square brick on the rearmost stair brick. The top step is now beside the raised deck.



ADD THESE PIECES

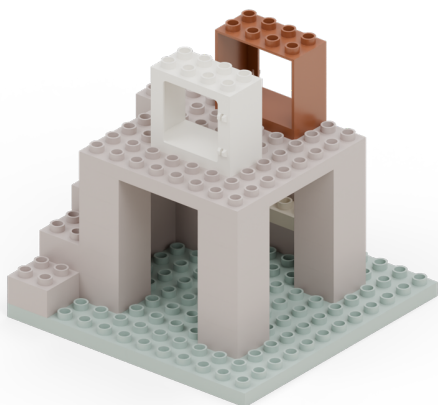
1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 15 - 16

15 / Place a brown window frame at the back of the cabin and a white frame at its front. The cabin is four studs wide and six studs deep, centred on the deck.



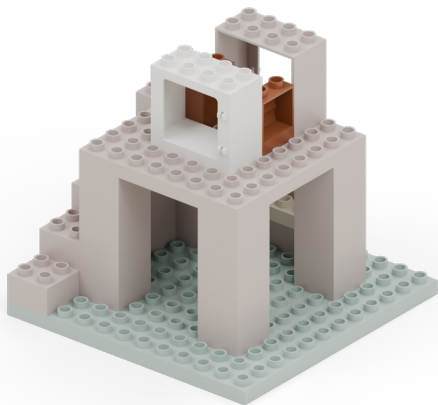
ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Window / door frame (4 × 2 studs) (Brown)

1 x Window / door frame (4 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

16 / Add a brown log wall along each side of the cabin, between the two frames. The open strip above the log walls is a side window.



ADD THESE PIECES

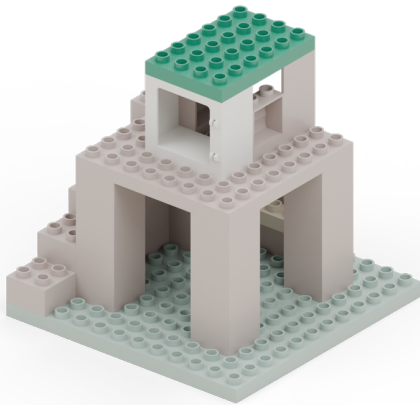
2 x Log wall brick (2 × 1 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 17 - 18

17 / Cover the cabin with a green wide plate. It spans the front and back frames.

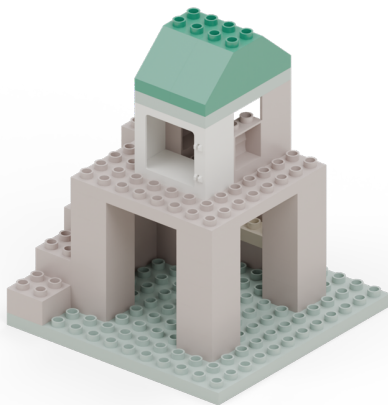


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Wide plate (4 × 6 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

18 / Make a pitched green roof with four tall roof slopes. Their low ends point outward toward the back and front.



ADD THESE PIECES

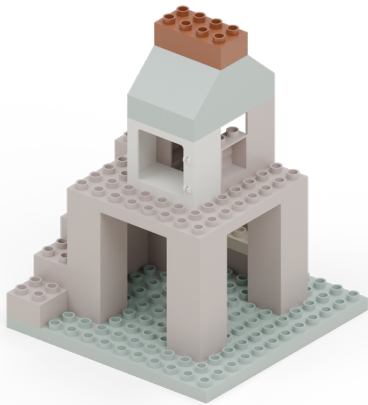
4 x Tall roof slope (2 × 3 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 19 - 20

19 / Cap the ridge with a brown long brick running across the cabin.

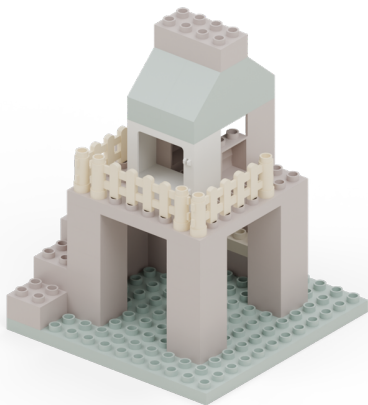


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

20 / Add cream fences along the two sides of the deck and across the front. Leave the rear of the left side open for the stairs.



ADD THESE PIECES

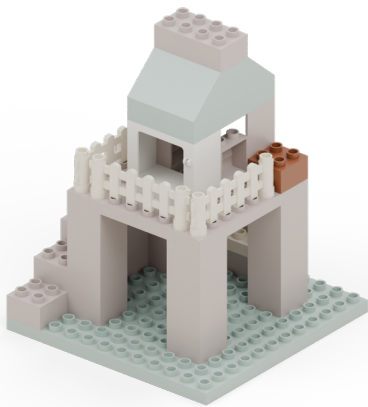
3 x Picket fence (6 × 1 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 21 - 22

21 / Extend both rear trunks above the deck with one brown square brick on each.



ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

22 / Add another brown square brick to each rear trunk, directly above the last pair.



ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 23 - 24

23 / Add one more brown square brick to each rear trunk. Both extensions should now be three square bricks high.

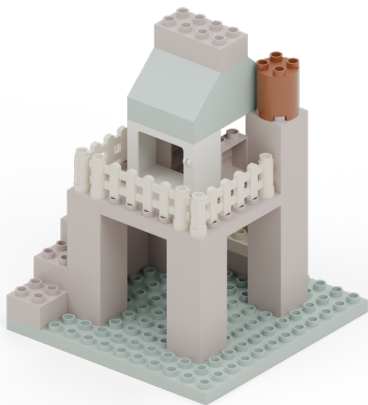


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

24 / Add a brown round tower brick to each rear trunk. These support the leafy canopy above the cabin.



ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 25 - 26

25 / Add a brown round tower brick to each rear trunk again. These support the leafy canopy above the cabin.



ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

26 / Raise the right branch by one brown square brick, then place green palm leaves on both branches. The right canopy sits one brick higher so the broad leaves clear each other.



ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Palm leaves (2 × 2 studs) (Green)

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

READY TO PLAY

Your little story

Name the treehouse club.

Describe what can be seen from the deck.

Tell a story about a visitor arriving up the steps.

This is a tall model. Support the base when moving it; the two leaf canopies finish at different heights so they clear each other.
