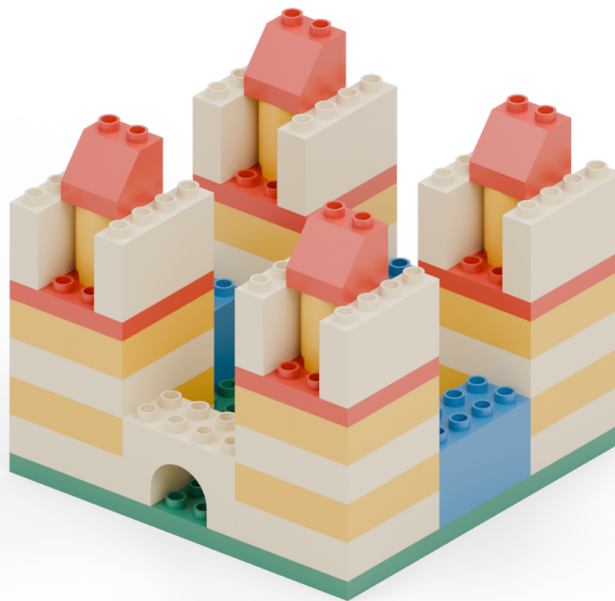


BUILD TOGETHER

Storybook castle

73 pieces / 15 steps

Four striped towers surround a courtyard with a little archway. Build the walls, add the battlements and finish with a path for your story's visitors.



A little model, a little story

Name the castle.

Invent a friendly visitor and a reason for their journey.

Tell a story that begins in the courtyard.

Digital guide; no bricks included. Make it together with an adult.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Match the shapes

Compare each part with its picture and count its rows of studs. A square brick has two rows of two studs; a long brick has two rows of four. Use the full parts list for the exact shapes and quantities.

Follow the colours

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep contrasting colours where they help you recognise the model.

Count the studs

The bumps on top are called studs. Count them when a step asks for a gap or an overhang. Put the build on a flat surface and keep its front facing the same way as in the pictures.

Add a little at a time

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces look lighter so you can see what has changed. Each list tells you exactly what to add.

Build together

An adult can read the steps while a child finds the pieces. The counts are for this one model. For two models to stay built, add their parts lists together.

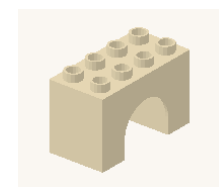
About this build

The arch is a small opening, and the turrets are fixed. No matching vehicle clearance has been checked.

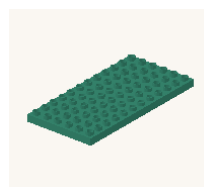
Exact parts checklist

Use this list to sort the shapes. Check the full colour list before building; the two lists count the same pieces.

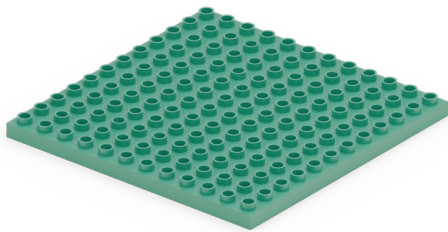

- [] 38 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs)
- [] 1 x Long plate (2 × 8 studs)
- [] 4 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs)
- [] 4 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs)
- [] 3 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)
- [] 4 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs)
- [] 16 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 1 - 2

01 / Set two green large base plates side by side to make a twelve-by-twelve-stud courtyard.

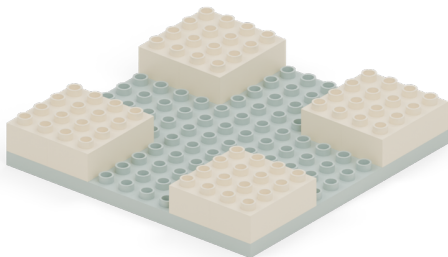


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Large base plate (6 × 12 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Start the four corner towers. At each corner, place two cream long bricks side by side to make a four-by-four square.

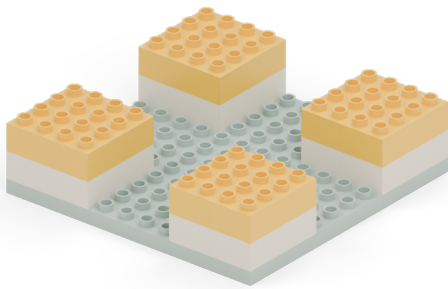
8 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 3 - 4

03 / Add a yellow layer to each tower using two long bricks side by side. Line up the edges with the cream layer below.

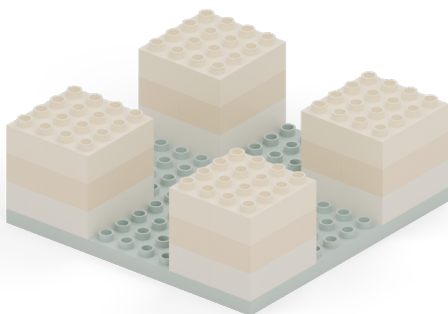


ADD THESE PIECES

8 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Add another cream layer to each tower using two long bricks side by side.

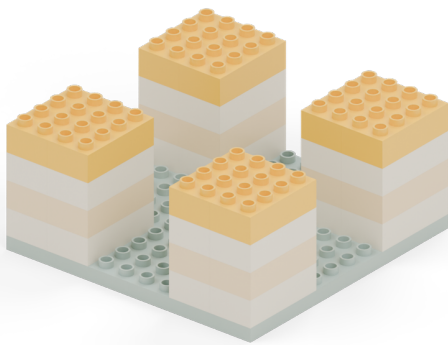
8 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 5 - 6

05 / Add another yellow layer to each tower using two long bricks side by side. All four towers should now be four layers high.

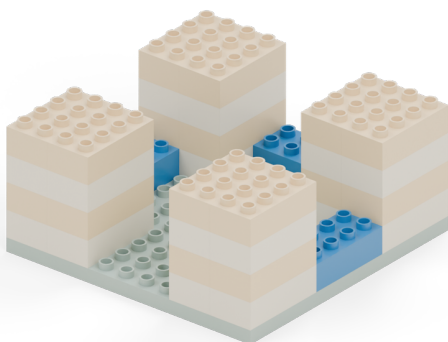


ADD THESE PIECES

8 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Join the rear towers with a blue wall, then join each pair of towers along the sides. Leave the front middle open.



ADD THESE PIECES

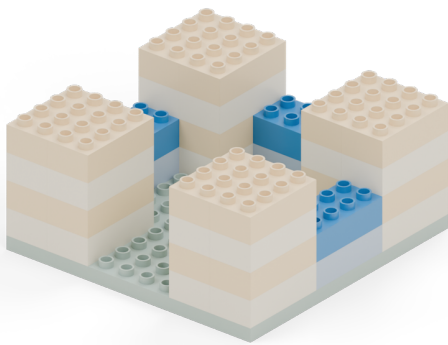
3 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 7 - 8

07 / Add another blue long brick to each connecting wall.

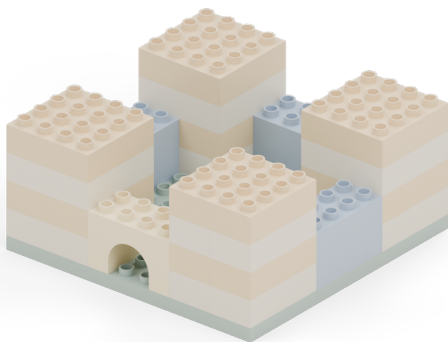


ADD THESE PIECES

3 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Place the cream arch across the front entrance, between the two front towers. Its opening faces out of the courtyard.



ADD THESE PIECES

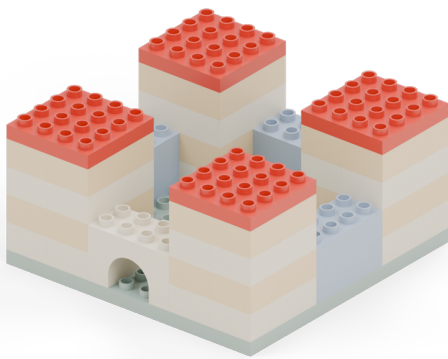
1 x Arch brick (2 × 4 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 9 - 10

09 / Cap each tower with a red square plate.

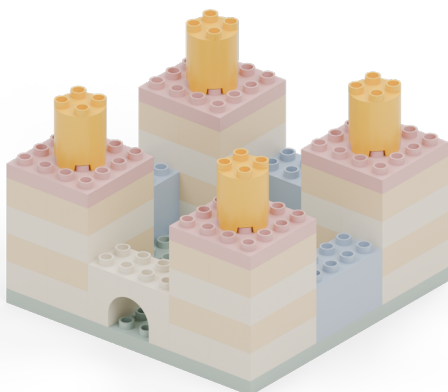


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

10 / Centre one yellow round tower brick on each tower roof.



ADD THESE PIECES

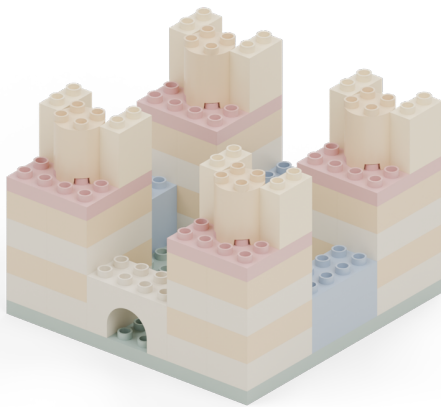
4 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 11 - 12

11 / Add cream battlements to the rear half of each tower: one wall brick on each outside edge.

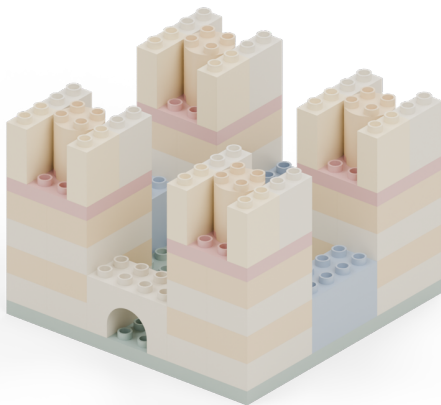


ADD THESE PIECES

8 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)
(Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

12 / Add cream battlements to the front half of each tower: one wall brick on each outside edge.



ADD THESE PIECES

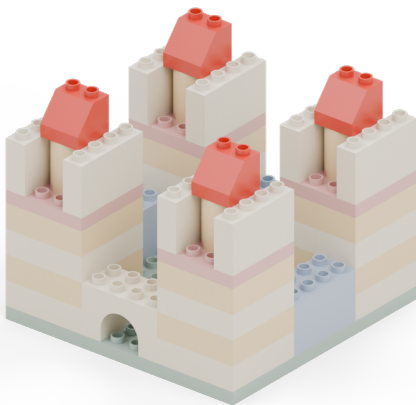
8 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 13 - 14

13 / Add a red roof slope to each round turret, with all four slopes pointing toward the front entrance.

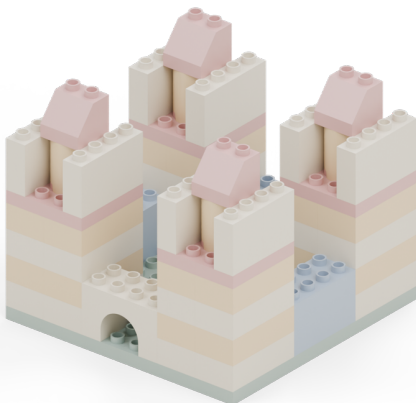


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

14 / Lay the blue long plate down the centre of the courtyard. It starts two rows in from the back wall and stops before the gate.



ADD THESE PIECES

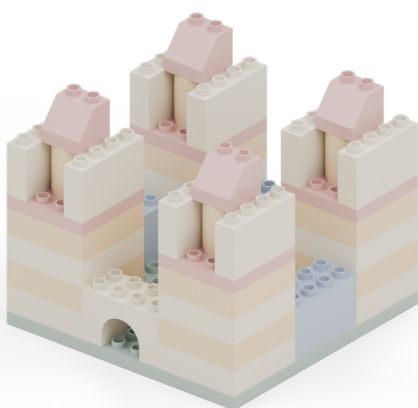
1 x Long plate (2 × 8 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 15

15 / Add three yellow stepping stones along the courtyard plate, starting at its back end.



ADD THESE PIECES

3 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

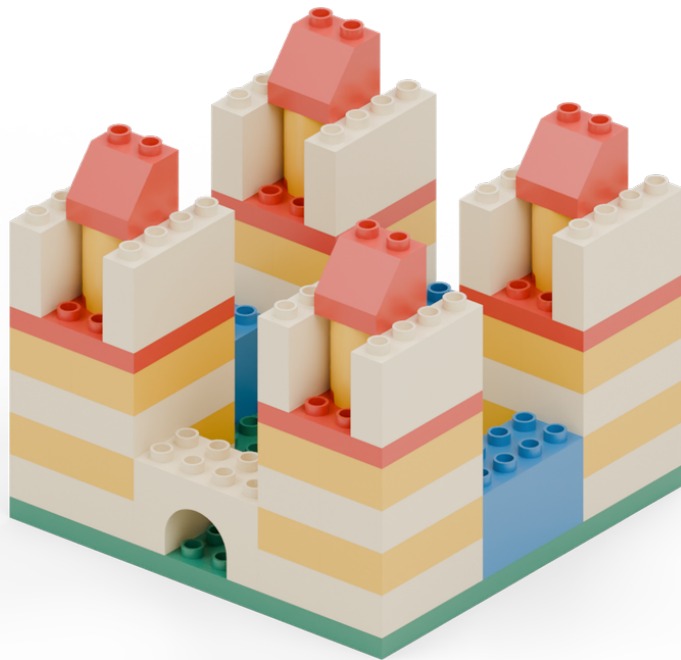
