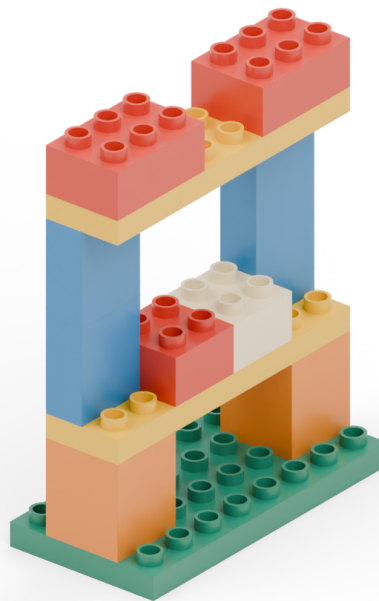


BUILD TOGETHER

# Market stall

15 pieces / 9 steps

Tall blue posts frame a narrow stall with a yellow counter. Add two display blocks and decide what your pretend shop will sell today.



## A little model, a little story

Choose two things for the stall to sell.

Take turns being the customer and shopkeeper.

Make up a cheerful market greeting.

Digital guide; no bricks included. Make it together with an adult.

## GETTING STARTED

# Before you build

## Match the shapes

Compare each part with its picture and count its rows of studs. A square brick has two rows of two studs; a long brick has two rows of four. Use the full parts list for the exact shapes and quantities.

## Follow the colours

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep contrasting colours where they help you recognise the model.

## Count the studs

The bumps on top are called studs. Count them when a step asks for a gap or an overhang. Put the build on a flat surface and keep its front facing the same way as in the pictures.

## Add a little at a time

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces look lighter so you can see what has changed. Each list tells you exactly what to add.

## Build together

An adult can read the steps while a child finds the pieces. The counts are for this one model. For two models to stay built, add their parts lists together.

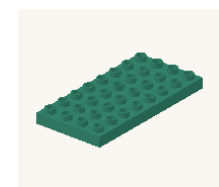
## About this build

The display blocks remain attached to the counter in this build.

# Shape-only checklist

Use this list to sort the shapes. Check the full colour list before building; the two lists count the same pieces.

[ ] 1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs)

[ ] 2 x Long plate (2 × 8 studs)

[ ] 2 x Medium brick (2 × 3 studs)

[ ] 6 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

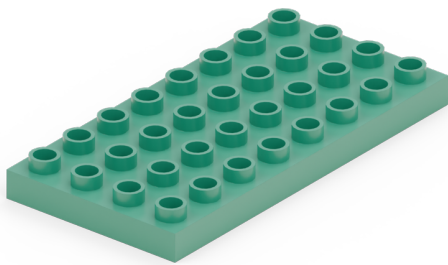
[ ] 4 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

## Step 1 - 2

**01 / Place the green four-by-eight base plate with its long edge running left to right.**

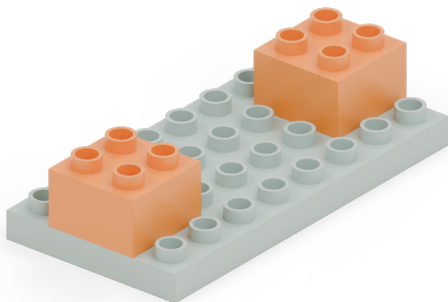


### ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

**02 / Place an orange square brick at each end, centred across the base.**



### ADD THESE PIECES

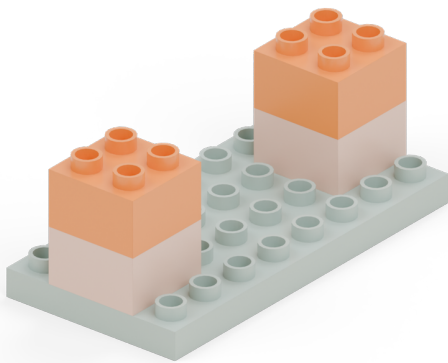
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

## Step 3 - 4

03 / Add an orange square brick to each support.

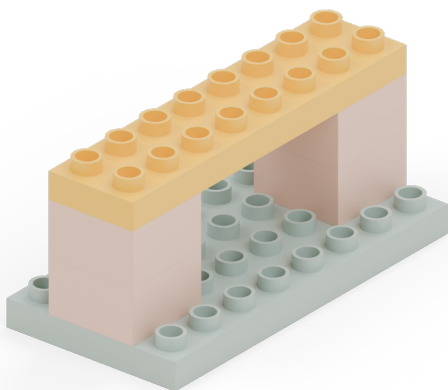


### ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Join the supports with the yellow long plate to make the counter.



### ADD THESE PIECES

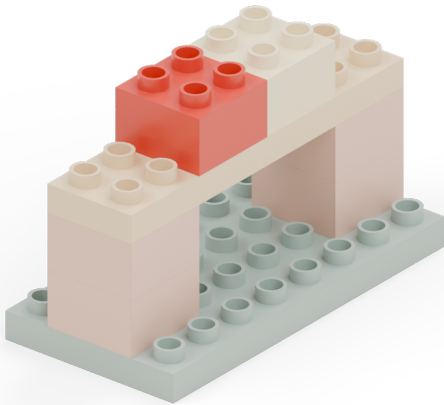
1 x Long plate (2 × 8 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

## Step 5 - 6

**05 / Add the red and cream square display blocks to the four middle rows of the counter.**



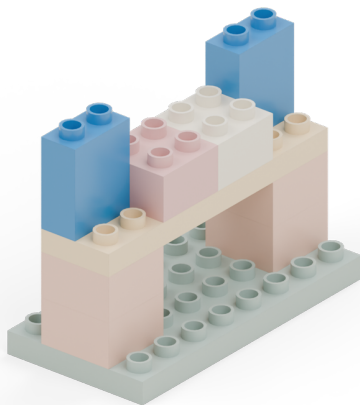
### ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Cream)

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

**06 / At each end, place a blue wall brick along the back row of the counter.**



### ADD THESE PIECES

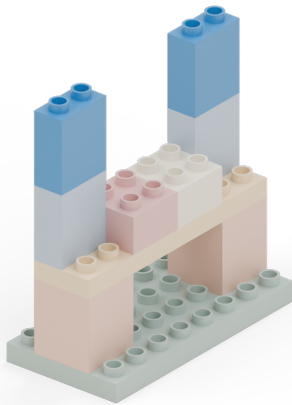
2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

## Step 7 - 8

07 / Add another blue wall brick directly above each back post.

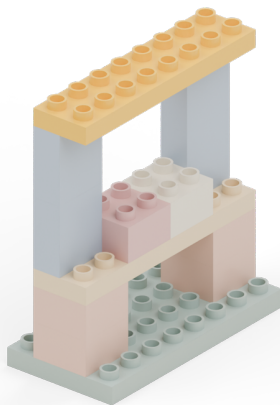


### ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)  
(Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Place a yellow long plate across the tall blue posts. Keep it directly above the counter, with one row projecting towards the front.



### ADD THESE PIECES

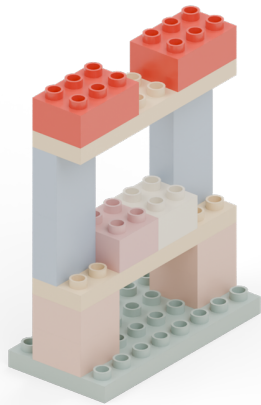
1 x Long plate (2 × 8 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

## Step 9

**09 / Add a red medium brick at each end of the roof, leaving two stud rows clear in the middle. Press the roof plate onto both blue posts.**



### ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Medium brick (2 × 3 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

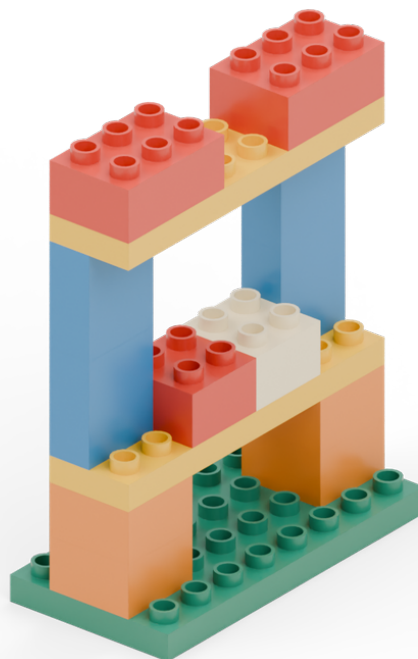
