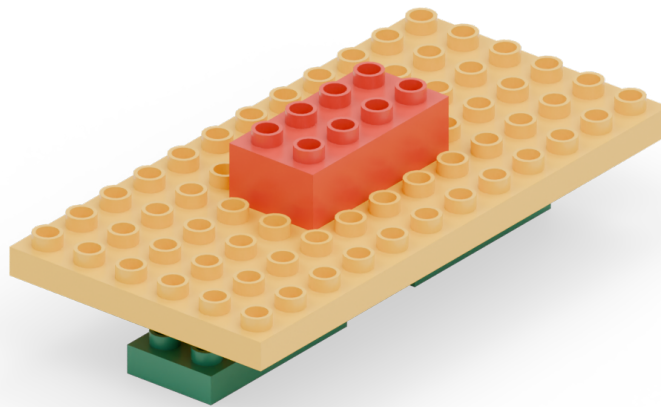


BUILD TOGETHER

Picnic table

6 pieces / 4 steps

Two feet and a broad yellow top make a simple picnic table. Add the red centrepiece and imagine a small gathering in the garden.



A little model, a little story

Choose a pretend picnic menu.

Count how many guests are coming.

Describe the view from the picnic spot.

Digital guide; no bricks included. Make it together with an adult.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Match the shapes

Compare each part with its picture and count its rows of studs. A square brick has two rows of two studs; a long brick has two rows of four. Use the full parts list for the exact shapes and quantities.

Follow the colours

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep contrasting colours where they help you recognise the model.

Count the studs

The bumps on top are called studs. Count them when a step asks for a gap or an overhang. Put the build on a flat surface and keep its front facing the same way as in the pictures.

Add a little at a time

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces look lighter so you can see what has changed. Each list tells you exactly what to add.

Build together

An adult can read the steps while a child finds the pieces. The counts are for this one model. For two models to stay built, add their parts lists together.

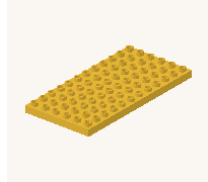
About this build

GATHER YOUR PIECES

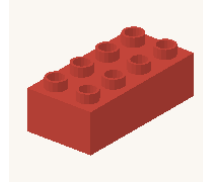
Exact parts checklist

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Choose your own colours for the same parts; changing a part's shape is a different substitution.

**1 x Large base plate (6 × 12 studs)**

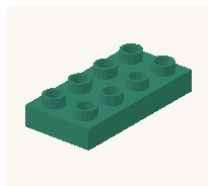

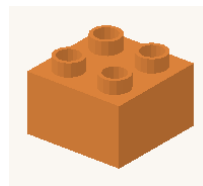

GATHER YOUR PIECES

Shape-only checklist

Use this list to sort the shapes. Check the full colour list before building; the two lists count the same pieces.

[] 1 x Large base plate (6 × 12 studs)

[] 1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs)

[] 2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs)

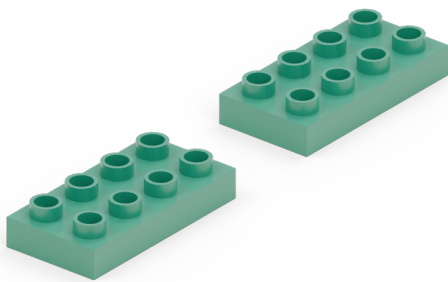
[] 2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

Total: 6 pieces

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 1 - 2

01 / Place two green small plates in a line, leaving two stud rows of space between them.

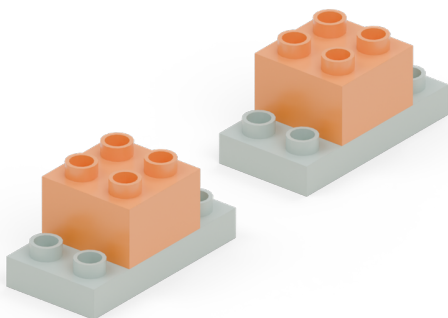


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Centre an orange square brick on each green plate. One row of each plate remains showing at either end.



ADD THESE PIECES

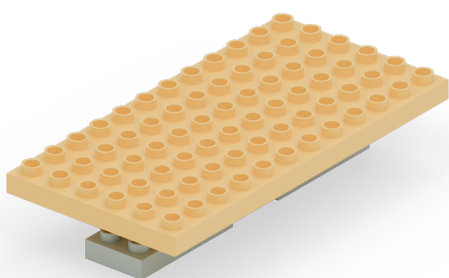
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 3 - 4

03 / Centre the large yellow base plate across both legs, with its long edge following the line of the feet. It overhangs each side by two stud columns and each end by one row.

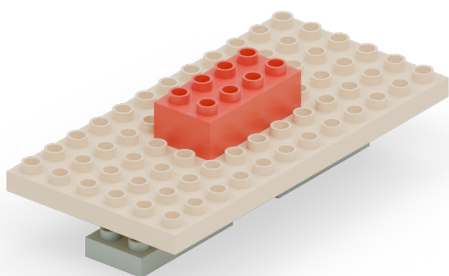


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Large base plate (6 × 12 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Add the red long brick in the middle of the tabletop. Check the wide tabletop and both legs stay attached.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

READY TO PLAY

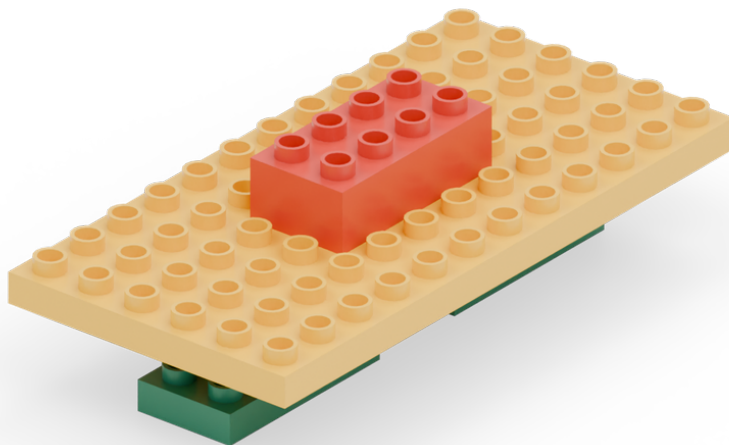
Your little story
