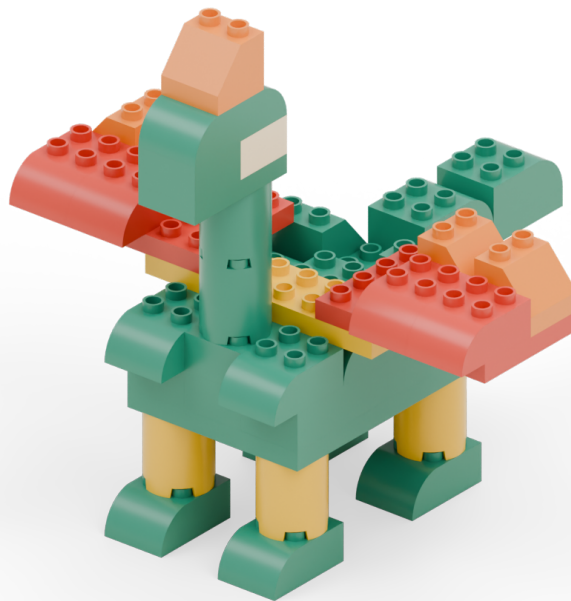


BUILD TOGETHER

Sky dragon

44 pieces / 19 steps

Wide red wings, a long neck and an orange crest make a dragon with a bold outline. Build its four feet and broad body before adding the wings.



A little model, a little story

Give the dragon a name.

Choose a place it guards or looks after.

Tell a story about a friendly journey above the clouds.

Digital guide; no bricks included. Make it together with an adult.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Match the shapes

Compare each part with its picture and count its rows of studs. A square brick has two rows of two studs; a long brick has two rows of four. Use the full parts list for the exact shapes and quantities.

Follow the colours

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep contrasting colours where they help you recognise the model.

Count the studs

The bumps on top are called studs. Count them when a step asks for a gap or an overhang. Put the build on a flat surface and keep its front facing the same way as in the pictures.

Add a little at a time

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces look lighter so you can see what has changed. Each list tells you exactly what to add.

Build together

An adult can read the steps while a child finds the pieces. The counts are for this one model. For two models to stay built, add their parts lists together.

About this build

The wings, legs and neck are fixed. Support the body when moving the dragon.

Use this list to sort the shapes. Check the full colour list before building; the two lists count the same pieces.

[] 12 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs)

[] 3 x Double curved brick (2 × 4 studs)

[] 1 x Extra-long brick (2 × 6 studs)

[] 6 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs)

[] 2 x Long plate (2 × 8 studs)

[] 1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs)

[] 6 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs)

[] 7 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs)

[] 2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

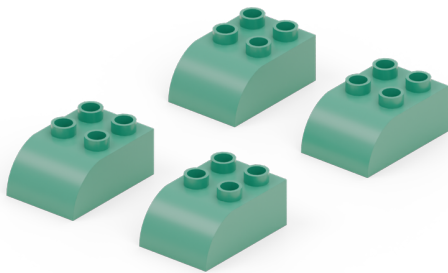
[] 4 x Wide plate (4 × 6 studs)

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 1 - 2

01 / Set out four green curved feet in a rectangle. Leave two stud columns between the left and right feet, and three clear rows between the front and back feet. All toes point forward.

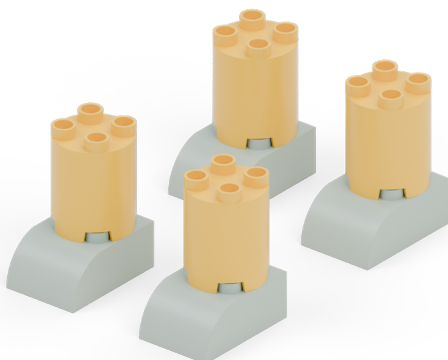


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Stand a yellow round leg on the flat rear part of each foot.



ADD THESE PIECES

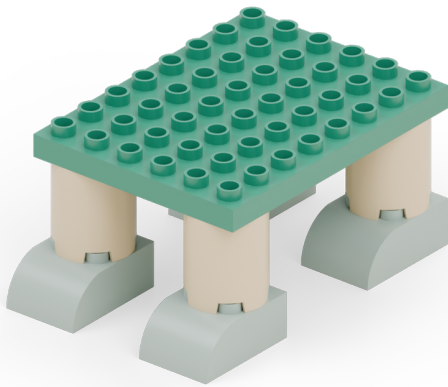
4 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 3 - 4

03 / Turn two green wide plates across the legs, end to end, to form a six-by-eight-stud belly.

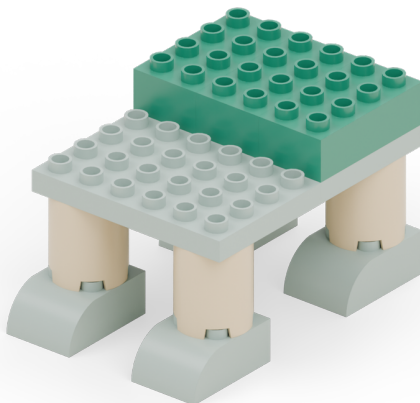


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Wide plate (4 × 6 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Cover the back half of the belly with three green long bricks side by side.



ADD THESE PIECES

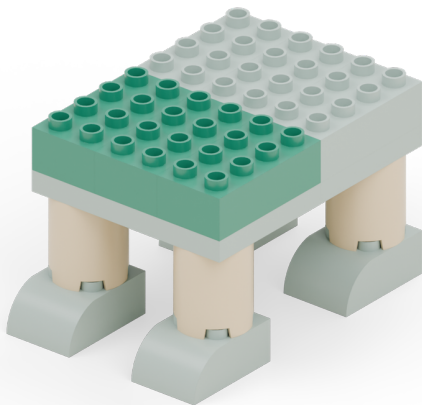
3 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 5 - 6

05 / Cover the front half of the belly with three green long bricks side by side.

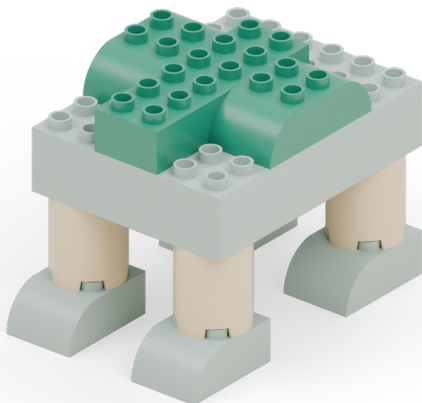


ADD THESE PIECES

3 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Join the body halves with an extra-long green brick down the centre, starting two rows in from the back. Add green double-curved bricks beside it, centred over the belly seam.



ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Double curved brick (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

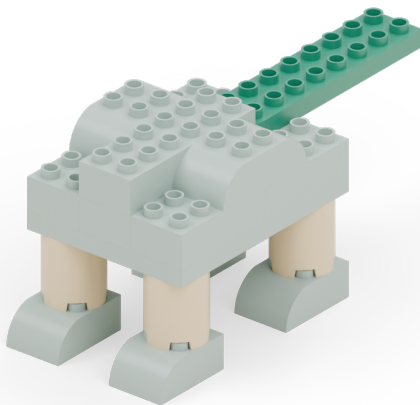
1 x Extra-long brick (2 × 6 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 7 - 8

07 / Add the green long plate behind the centre brick to make the tail. Its front two rows attach to the body; the rest projects backward.

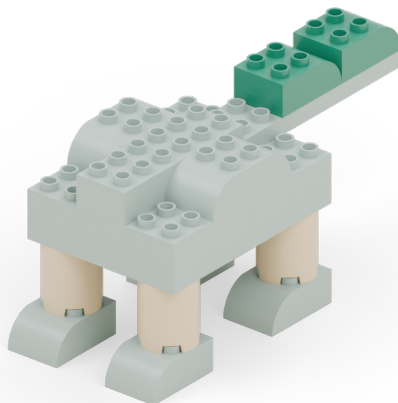


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long plate (2 × 8 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Cover the back six rows of the tail with two green curved bricks, pointing backward.



ADD THESE PIECES

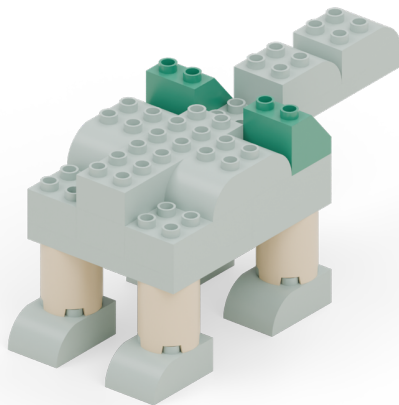
2 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 9 - 10

09 / Add green slopes over the back hips, with the low ends pointing toward the tail.

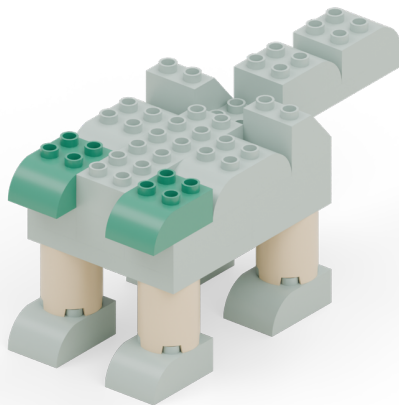


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

10 / Add green curved bricks over the front hips, curving forward beyond the belly.



ADD THESE PIECES

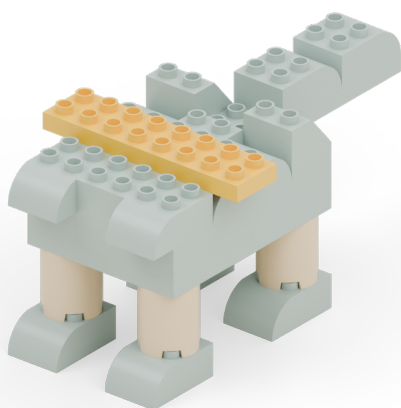
2 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 11 - 12

11 / Turn the yellow long plate across the back for a wing support. Its front edge lines up with the back of the neck position, and it overhangs by one stud at each side.

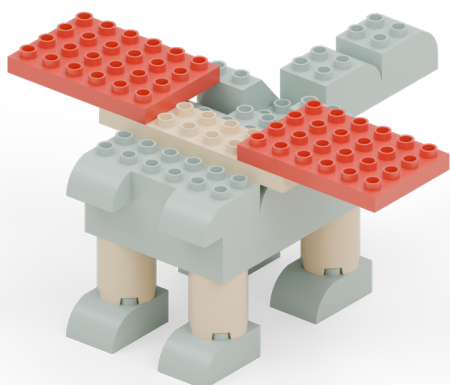


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long plate (2 × 8 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

12 / Add a red wide plate at each end of the yellow support, with their six-stud lengths pointing outward. Each wing overlaps two columns of the support and extends two rows behind it.



ADD THESE PIECES

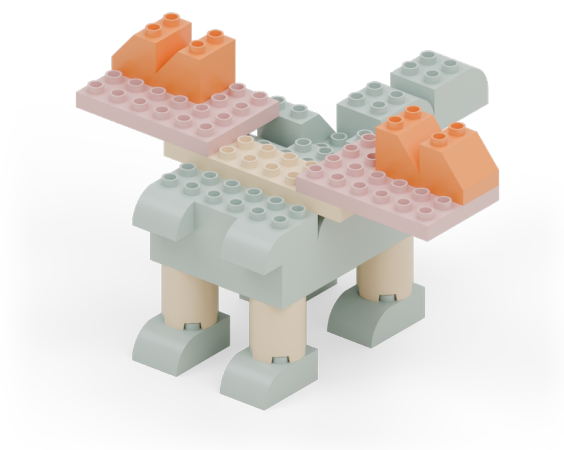
2 x Wide plate (4 × 6 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 13 - 14

13 / Put two orange slopes along the back half of each wing, starting at the outer tips. Point their low ends away from the body.

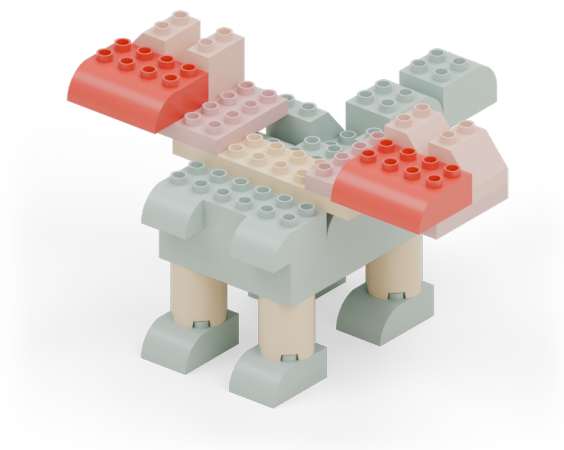


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

14 / Add two red curved bricks along the front half of each wing. Their rounded ends project one row beyond the red plates.



ADD THESE PIECES

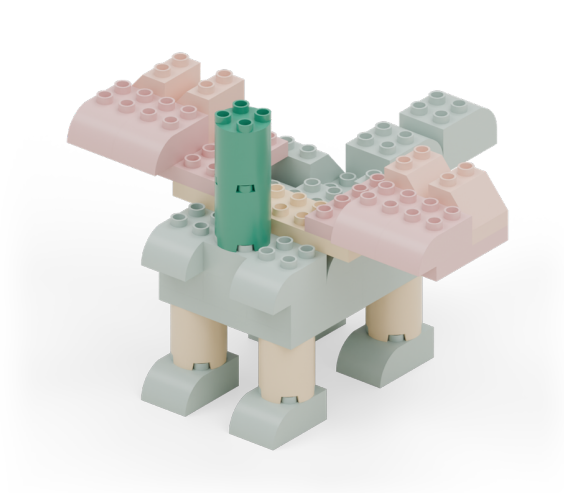
4 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 15 - 16

15 / Stack two green round bricks at the front of the centre body brick for the long neck.

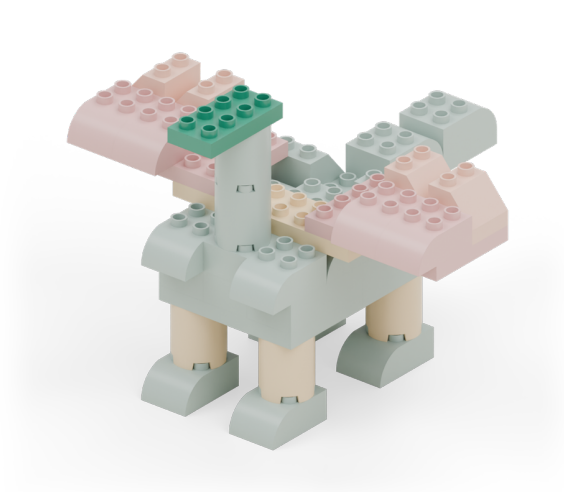


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

16 / Set the green small plate on the neck, with two rows projecting forward for the nose.



ADD THESE PIECES

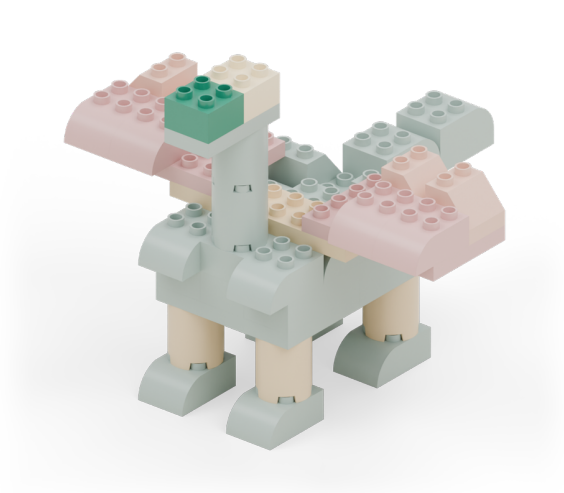
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 17 - 18

17 / Add a cream square over the neck for the eyes, then a green square in front for the nose.



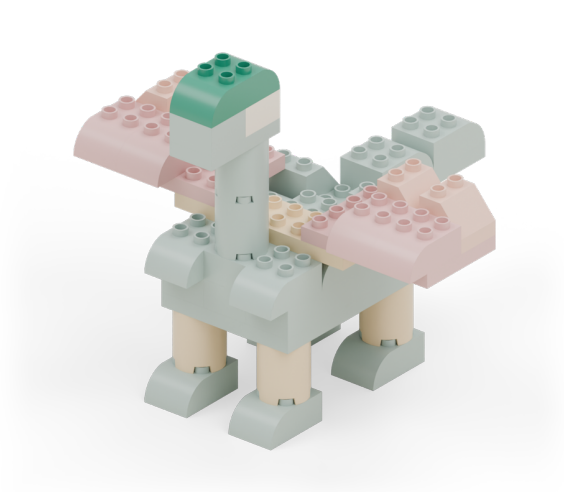
ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Cream)

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

18 / Finish the head with a green double-curved brick, lined up over both squares.



ADD THESE PIECES

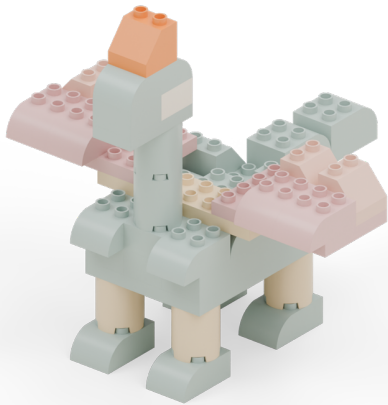
1 x Double curved brick (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 19

19 / Add an orange roof slope on the four flat top studs of the head, pointing forward, to make the dragon's crest.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

READY TO PLAY

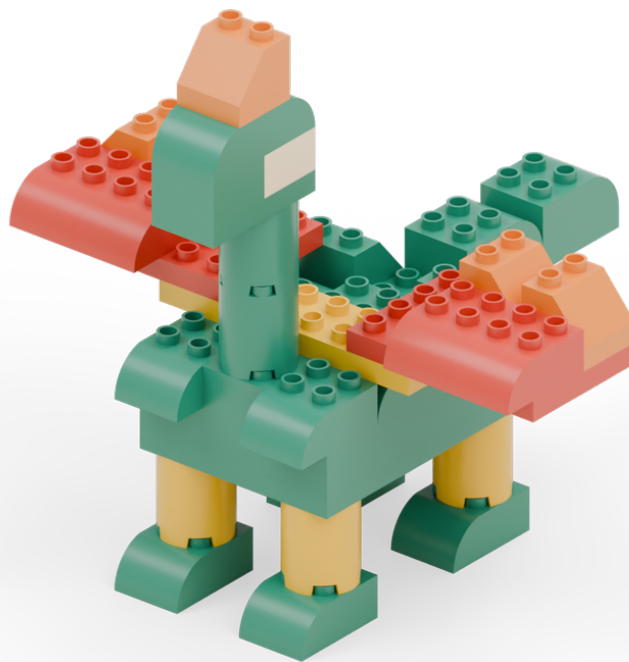
Your little story
