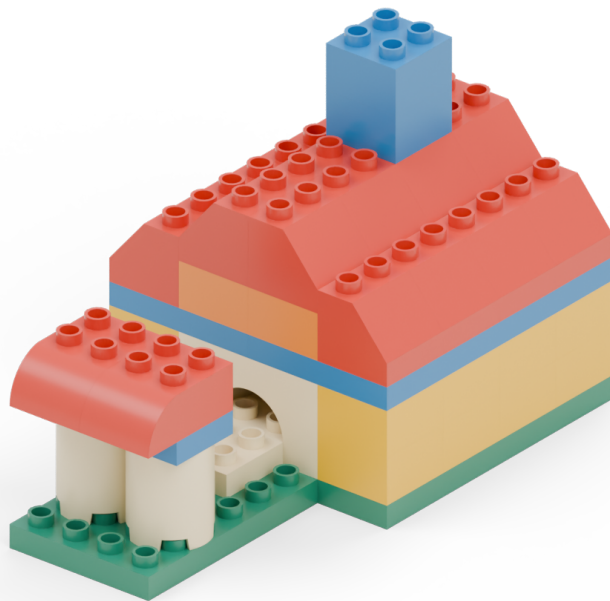


BUILD TOGETHER

Colourful cottage

52 pieces / 13 steps

A broad red roof, blue chimney and little covered porch make a cheerful home. Build the walls together, then add the roof one row at a time.



A little model, a little story

Name the people or creatures who live here.

Plan a welcome for their first visitor.

Describe what is cooking inside the cottage.

Digital guide; no bricks included. Make it together with an adult.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Match the shapes

Compare each part with its picture and count its rows of studs. A square brick has two rows of two studs; a long brick has two rows of four. Use the full parts list for the exact shapes and quantities.

Follow the colours

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep contrasting colours where they help you recognise the model.

Count the studs

The bumps on top are called studs. Count them when a step asks for a gap or an overhang. Put the build on a flat surface and keep its front facing the same way as in the pictures.

Add a little at a time

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces look lighter so you can see what has changed. Each list tells you exactly what to add.

Build together

An adult can read the steps while a child finds the pieces. The counts are for this one model. For two models to stay built, add their parts lists together.

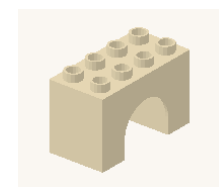
About this build

The window and doorway openings stay open; there are no opening doors or shutters.

[] 2 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs)

[] 6 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs)

[] 2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs)

[] 2 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs)

[] 16 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs)

[] 18 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

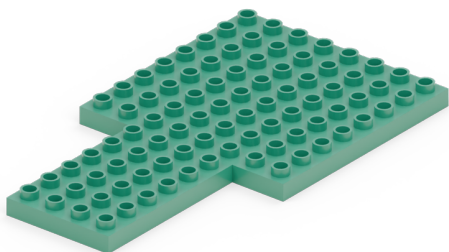
[] 1 x Wide plate (4 × 6 studs)

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 1 - 2

01 / Lay two green four-by-eight base plates side by side. Centre a green wide plate in front of them for the porch.



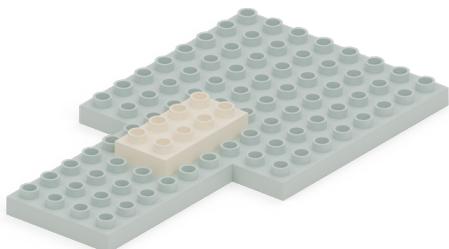
ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Green)

1 x Wide plate (4 × 6 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Bridge the porch seam with a cream small plate, centred on the house. Two rows sit inside the house and two outside.



ADD THESE PIECES

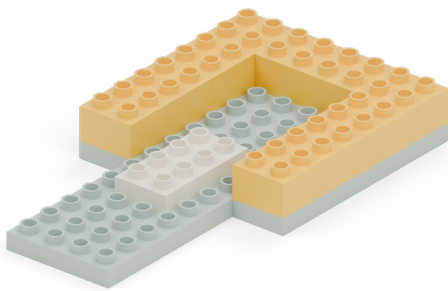
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 3 - 4

03 / Build the yellow side walls with four square bricks on each side. Join them across the back with a long brick.



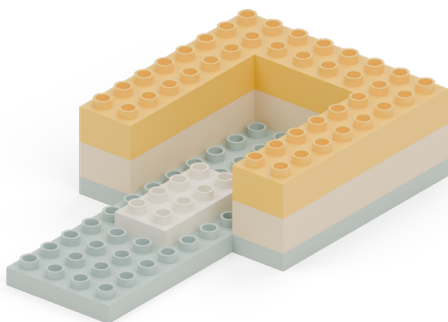
ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

8 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Repeat that yellow wall layer, leaving the front doorway clear.

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

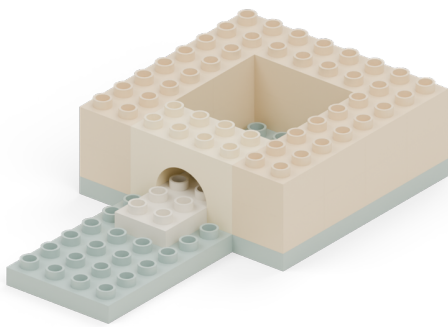
8 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 5 - 6

05 / Put the cream arch over the front path, between the side walls. The thin path fits under the opening.

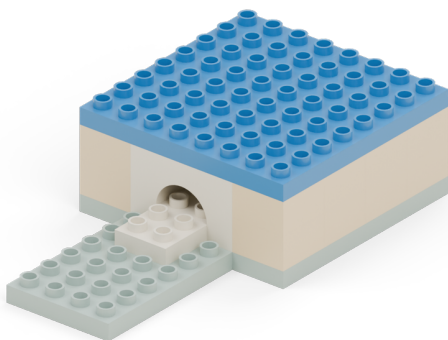


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Arch brick (2 × 4 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Cover the house with two blue base plates, side by side, to form the roof deck.



ADD THESE PIECES

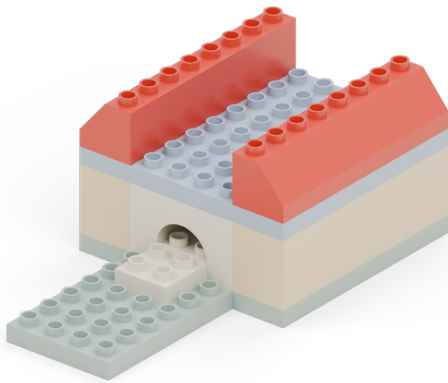
2 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 7 - 8

07 / Start the red roof with four slopes along each outside edge. Point the low ends outward, away from the centre.

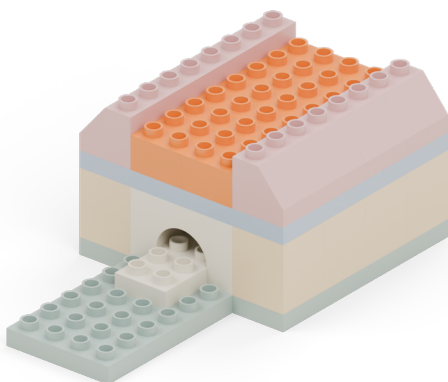


ADD THESE PIECES

8 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Build up the middle of the roof with four orange long bricks: two rows, each running from back to front.



ADD THESE PIECES

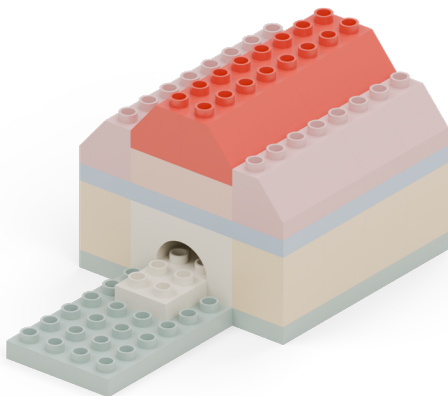
4 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 9 - 10

09 / Add the upper red slopes over the orange bricks. Again point the low ends outward; their high edges meet at the ridge.

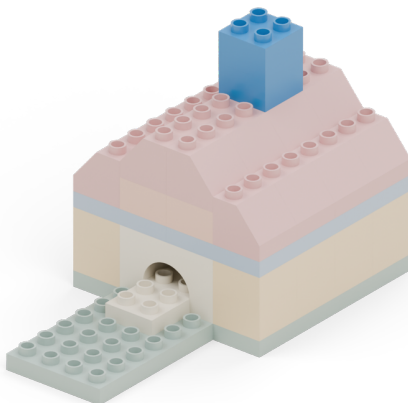


ADD THESE PIECES

8 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

10 / Stack two blue square bricks across the roof ridge near the back to make the chimney.



ADD THESE PIECES

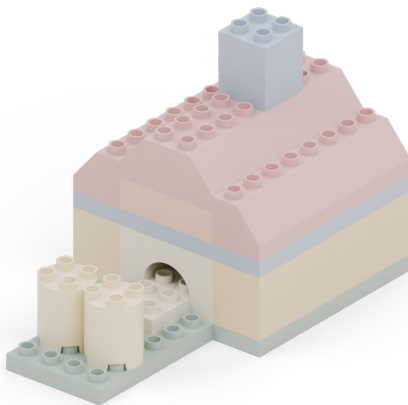
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 11 - 12

11 / Stand two cream round posts side by side near the front of the porch, one clear row beyond the path.

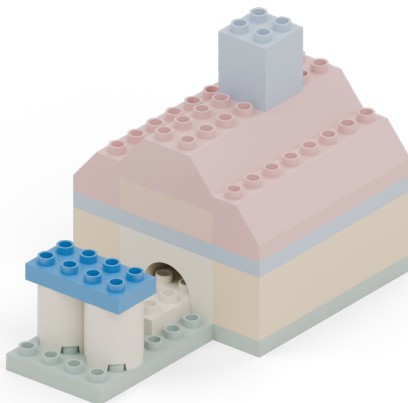


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

12 / Join the porch posts with a blue small plate, turned across both posts.



ADD THESE PIECES

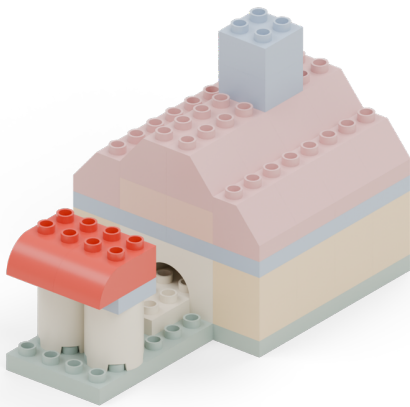
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 13

13 / Put two red curved bricks side by side on the porch canopy. Their curved ends project toward the front.



ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

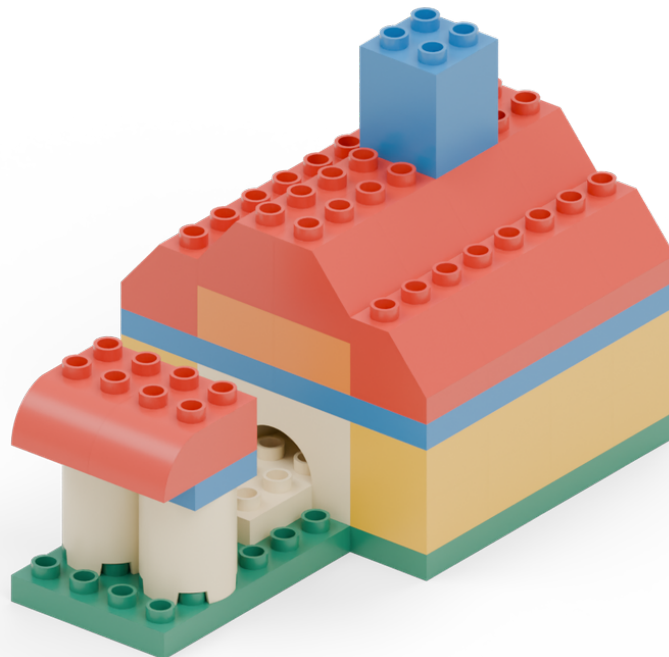
