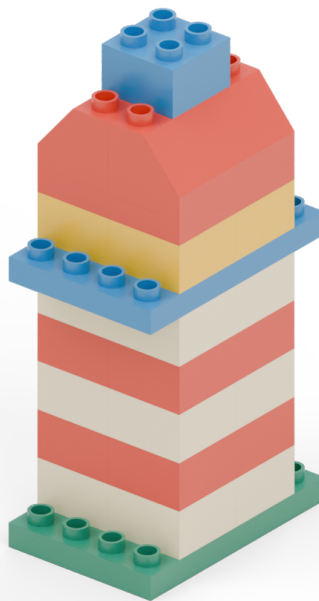


BUILD TOGETHER

Harbour lighthouse

28 pieces / 11 steps

Cream and red stripes rise to a yellow lantern room with a little roof. Build a harbour landmark and imagine its light guiding visitors home.



A little model, a little story

Name the harbour.

Make up a slow flashing-light pattern with your hands.

Describe a boat arriving before bedtime.

Digital guide; no bricks included. Make it together with an adult.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Match the shapes

Compare each part with its picture and count its rows of studs. A square brick has two rows of two studs; a long brick has two rows of four. Use the full parts list for the exact shapes and quantities.

Follow the colours

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep contrasting colours where they help you recognise the model.

Count the studs

The bumps on top are called studs. Count them when a step asks for a gap or an overhang. Put the build on a flat surface and keep its front facing the same way as in the pictures.

Add a little at a time

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces look lighter so you can see what has changed. Each list tells you exactly what to add.

Build together

An adult can read the steps while a child finds the pieces. The counts are for this one model. For two models to stay built, add their parts lists together.

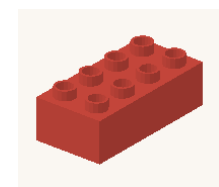
About this build

The lantern is a coloured brick detail; it does not light up.

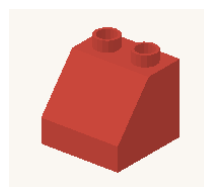
Exact parts checklist

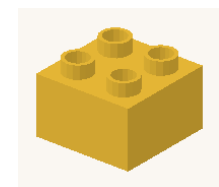

GATHER YOUR PIECES

Shape-only checklist

Use this list to sort the shapes. Check the full colour list before building; the two lists count the same pieces.

[] 4 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs)

[] 4 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs)

[] 17 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

[] 1 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs)

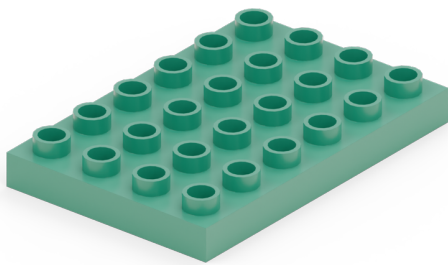
[] 2 x Wide plate (4 × 6 studs)

Total: 28 pieces

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 1 - 2

01 / Place the green wide plate with its six-stud length running from back to front.

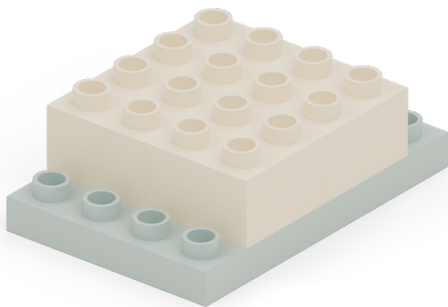


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Wide plate (4 × 6 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Start the tower with four cream square bricks, leaving one clear row at the front and back of the green plate.



ADD THESE PIECES

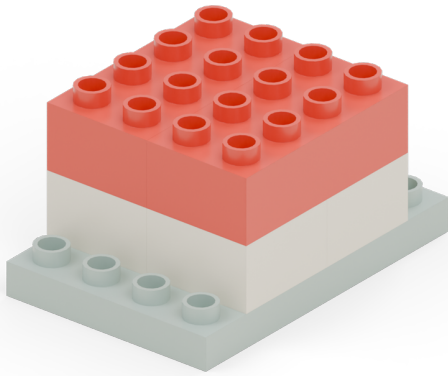
4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 3 - 4

03 / Add a red stripe with two long bricks side by side, running from back to front.

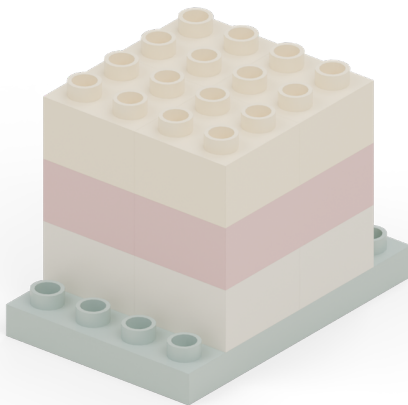


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Add another cream layer with four square bricks.



ADD THESE PIECES

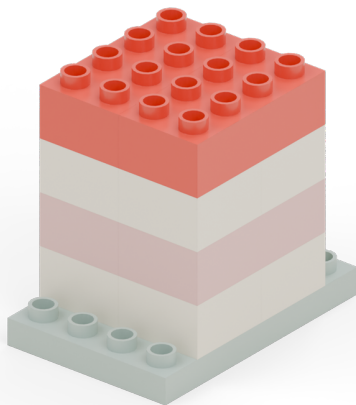
4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 5 - 6

05 / Add a red stripe with two long bricks side by side, running from back to front.

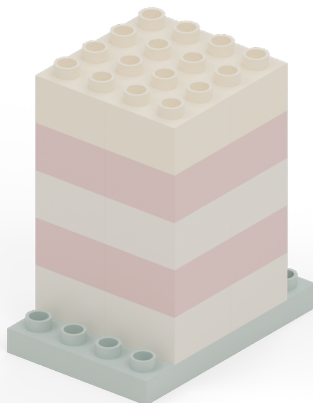


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Add another cream layer with four square bricks.



ADD THESE PIECES

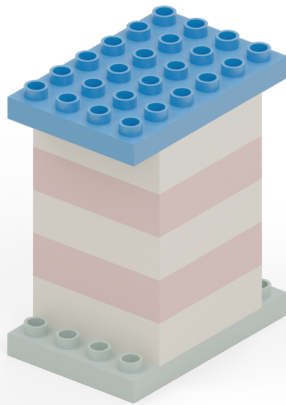
4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 7 - 8

07 / Cover the tower with the blue wide plate, aligned with the green base, to make a balcony.

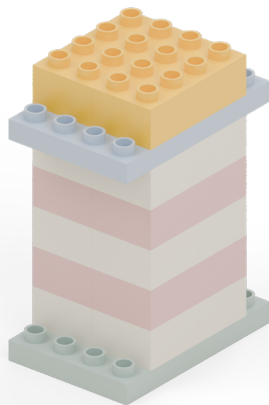


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Wide plate (4 × 6 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Make the lantern room with four yellow square bricks, directly above the tower.



ADD THESE PIECES

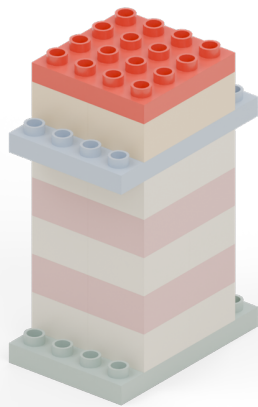
4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 9 - 10

09 / Put the red square plate over the yellow lantern room.

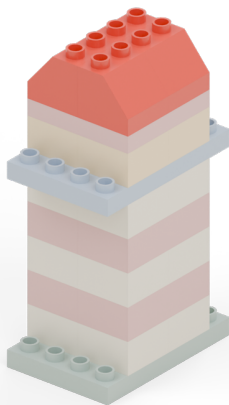


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

10 / Add four red roof slopes. Point the low ends outward to the left and right, with the high edges meeting in the middle.



ADD THESE PIECES

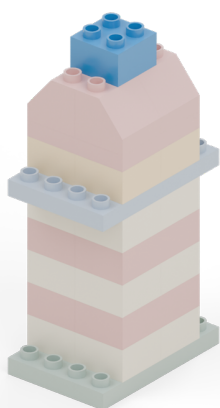
4 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 11

11 / Centre the blue square brick across the top ridge to finish the beacon.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

READY TO PLAY

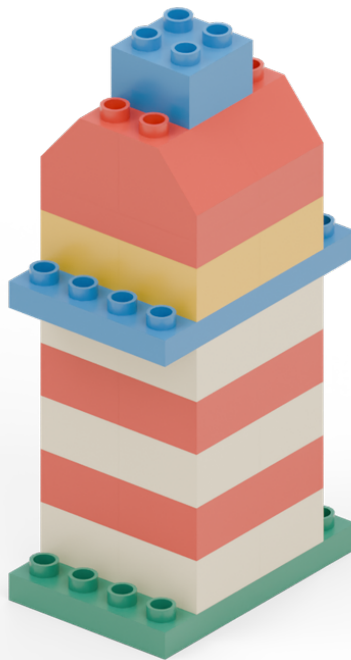
Your little story
