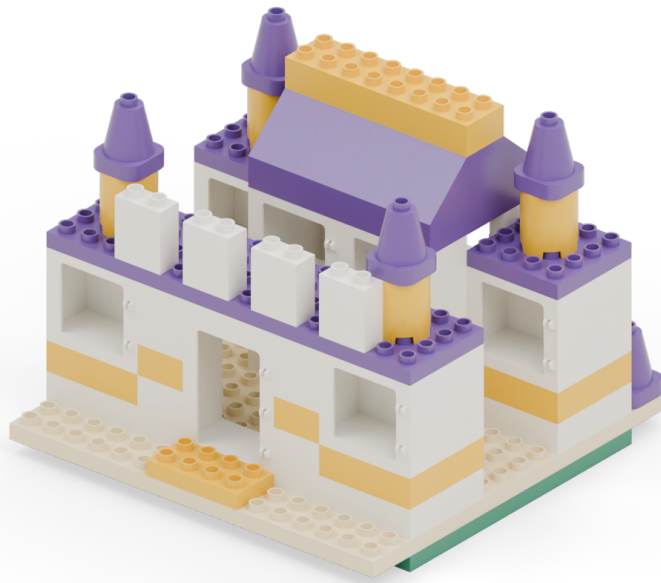


BUILD TOGETHER

Fairytale palace

105 pieces / 29 steps

Four turrets, a purple roof and a wide terrace make a palace for a longer building session. Work around the towers together, then add the central hall and entrance.



A little model, a little story

Choose a name for the palace.

Plan a celebration on the terrace.

Tell a story that starts with a knock at the tall doorway.

Digital guide; no bricks included. Make it together with an adult.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Match the shapes

Compare each part with its picture and count its rows of studs. A square brick has two rows of two studs; a long brick has two rows of four. Use the full parts list for the exact shapes and quantities.

Follow the colours

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep contrasting colours where they help you recognise the model.

Count the studs

The bumps on top are called studs. Count them when a step asks for a gap or an overhang. Put the build on a flat surface and keep its front facing the same way as in the pictures.

Add a little at a time

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces look lighter so you can see what has changed. Each list tells you exactly what to add.

Build together

An adult can read the steps while a child finds the pieces. The counts are for this one model. For two models to stay built, add their parts lists together.

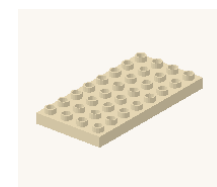
About this build

This is the largest guide in the library. Leave room to keep it in place between sessions. The windows and doorway are open frames.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 1 - 2

01 / Make a sixteen-by-twelve foundation from six green base plates. Each plate runs eight studs across and four from back to front.

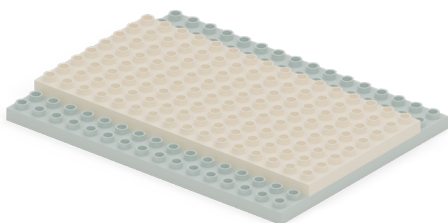


ADD THESE PIECES

6 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Add four cream base plates lengthways through the middle, two rows in from the back. They cross the seams in the green foundation.

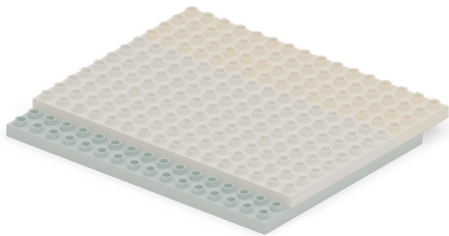
4 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 3 - 4

03 / Finish the rear terrace with four cream square plates, from left to right. Their inner two rows rest on the green foundation; the outer two rows overhang at the back.

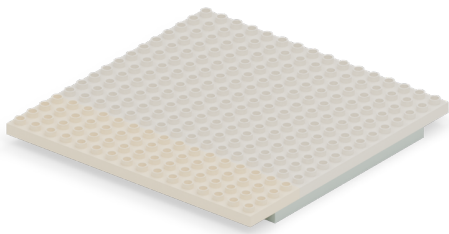


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Finish the front terrace with four cream square plates in the same way, extending two rows beyond the green foundation.



ADD THESE PIECES

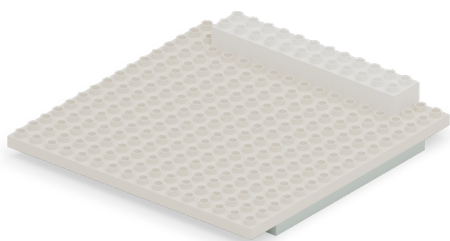
4 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 5 - 6

05 / Join the terrace plates with three white long bricks along the rear outer edge, centred across the seams at columns four, eight and twelve.

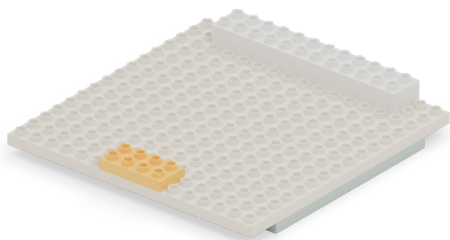


ADD THESE PIECES

3 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Place a yellow small plate across the front terrace as the entrance step. Centre it across the middle four columns; the doorway comes later.



ADD THESE PIECES

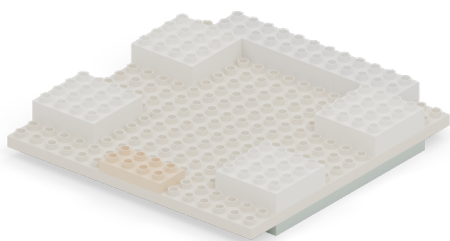
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 7 - 8

07 / Start all four corner towers with a white layer. Use two long bricks side by side at each corner, making a four-by-four square.

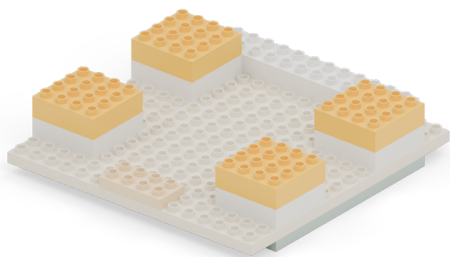


ADD THESE PIECES

8 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Add a yellow layer to all four corner towers. Use two long bricks side by side on each white square, keeping the edges lined up.



ADD THESE PIECES

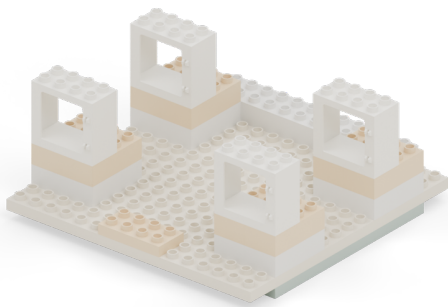
8 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 9 - 10

09 / Add a white window frame across the front half of each tower. Face the small hinge details toward the front; leave the openings clear.

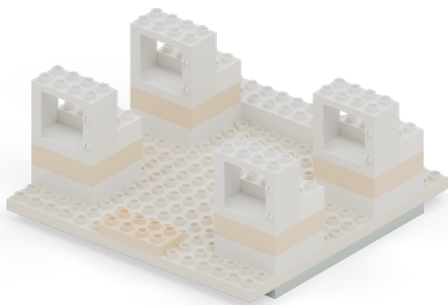


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Window / door frame (4 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

10 / Place one white long brick behind each tower window, across the back half of the tower. Keep the front openings clear.



ADD THESE PIECES

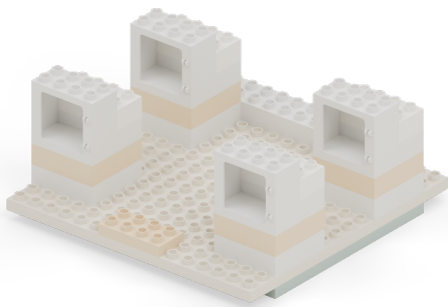
4 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 11 - 12

11 / Stack another white long brick on the brick behind each tower window. Keep the edges lined up with the layer below.

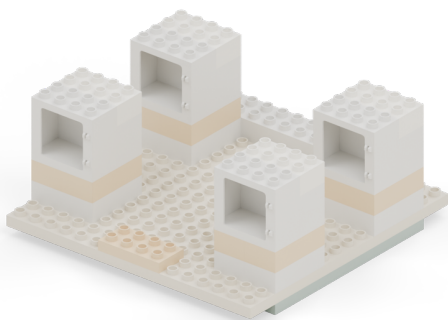


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

12 / Add a third white long brick behind each tower window. The backs of the towers are now level with the window frames.



ADD THESE PIECES

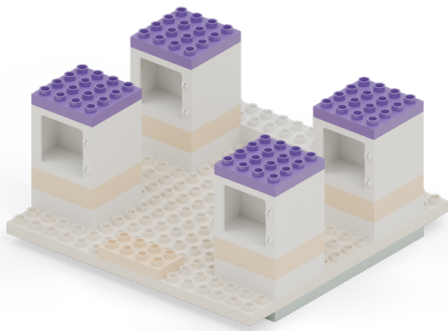
4 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (White)

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 13 - 14

13 / Cap the four towers with purple square plates, aligned with the tower walls.

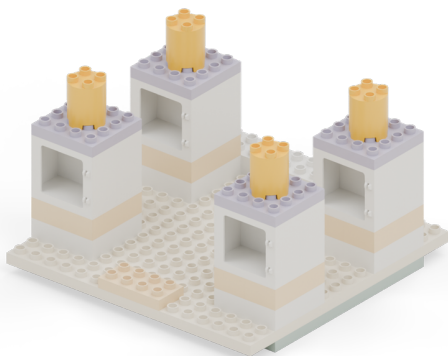


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs) (Purple)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

14 / Centre a yellow round tower brick on each purple roof, leaving one row of purple studs around it.



ADD THESE PIECES

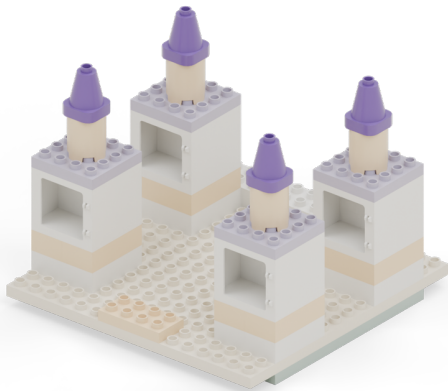
4 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 15 - 16

15 / Finish each turret with a purple tower cone. Its small top stud stays free.

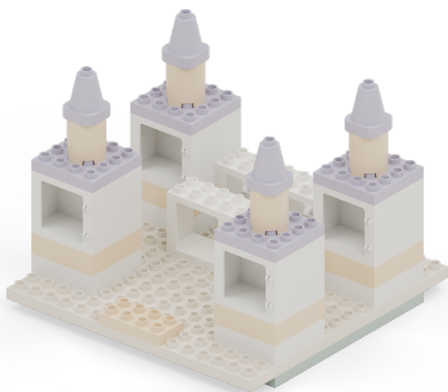


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Tower cone (2 × 2 studs) (Purple)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

16 / Build the lower hall: four white window frames, two across the back and two across the front. Leave a two-row passage between front and back walls.



ADD THESE PIECES

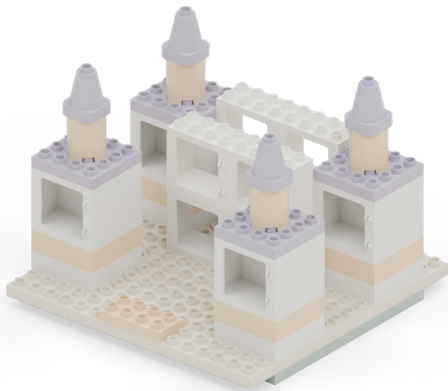
4 x Window / door frame (4 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 17 - 18

17 / Build the upper hall: four white window frames, two across the back and two across the front. Leave a two-row passage between front and back walls.

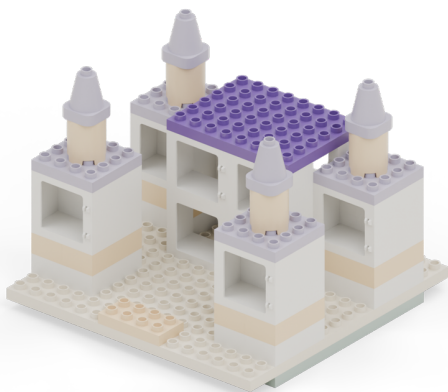


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Window / door frame (4 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

18 / Roof the hall with two purple wide plates, side by side. Each covers four studs across and six front to back.



ADD THESE PIECES

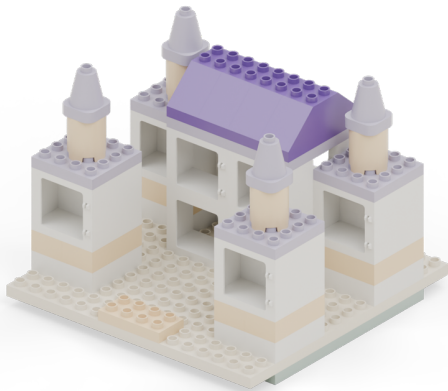
2 x Wide plate (4 × 6 studs) (Purple)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 19 - 20

19 / Add eight purple tall roof slopes. Point the low ends outward to the back and front, with the high edges meeting at the middle ridge.

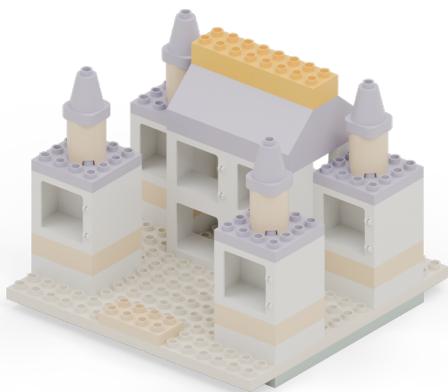


ADD THESE PIECES

8 x Tall roof slope (2 × 3 studs) (Purple)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

20 / Join the roof ridge with two yellow long bricks end to end, running across the hall.



ADD THESE PIECES

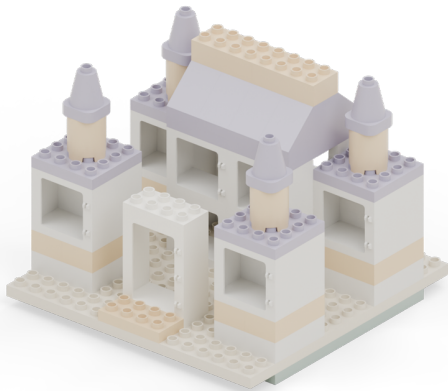
2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 21 - 22

21 / Place the white tall doorway at the centre of the front entrance, with its opening facing you.

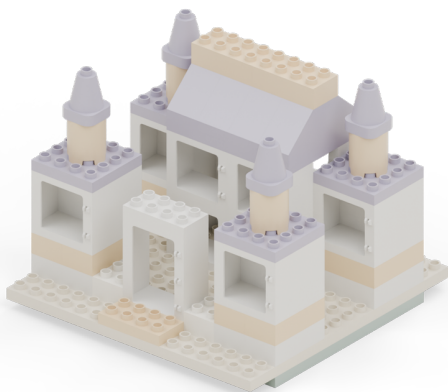


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Tall doorway frame (4 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

22 / Start the entrance pillars with one white square brick immediately beside each side of the tall doorway.



ADD THESE PIECES

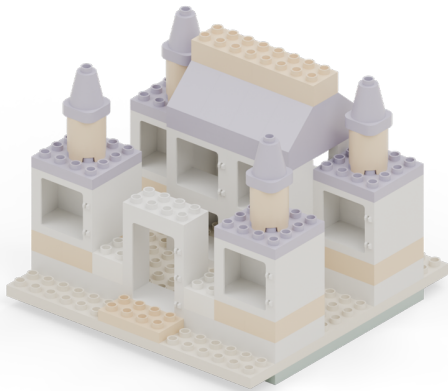
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 23 - 24

23 / Add one white square brick to each entrance pillar, directly above the first.

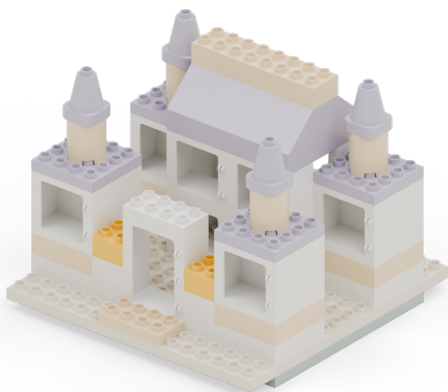


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

24 / Add one yellow square brick to each entrance pillar for a coloured stripe.



ADD THESE PIECES

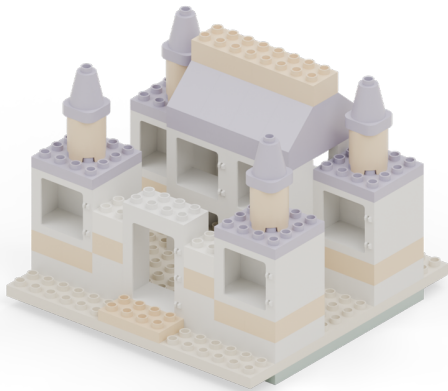
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 25 - 26

25 / Add one white square brick directly above each yellow stripe.

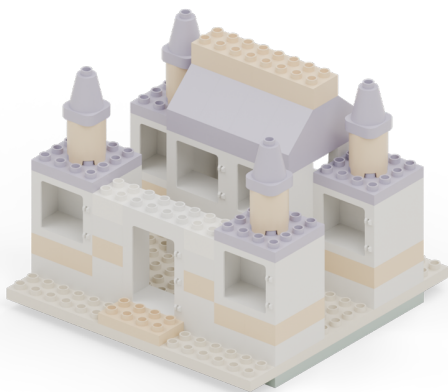


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

26 / Add one more white square brick to each entrance pillar. The pillars should now be level with the top of the doorway.



ADD THESE PIECES

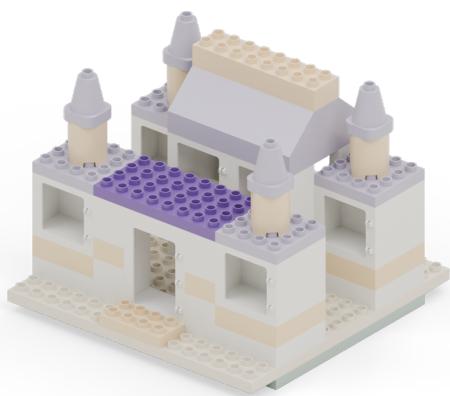
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 27 - 28

27 / Bridge the entrance with two purple square plates between the front towers. Align their front edges with the tower roofs.

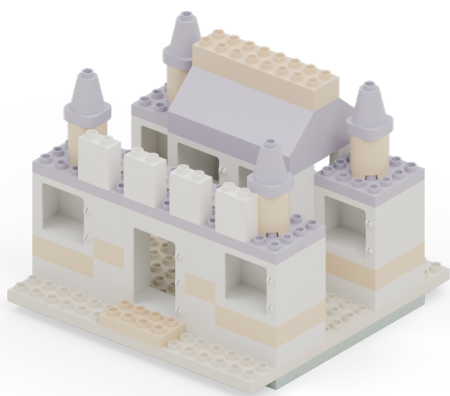


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs) (Purple)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

28 / Add four white battlements across the entrance roof. The middle two bridge the plate seams. Keep one stud column between neighbouring battlements.



ADD THESE PIECES

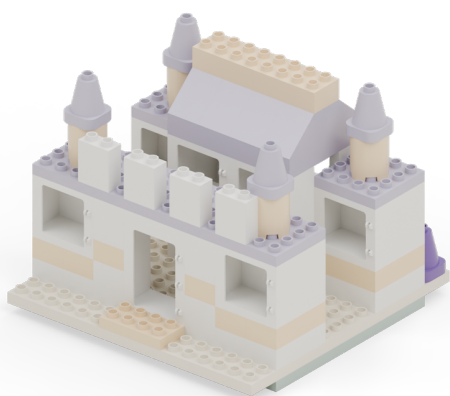
4 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 29

29 / Finish the rear terrace ends with a purple cone at each corner.



ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Tower cone (2 × 2 studs) (Purple)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

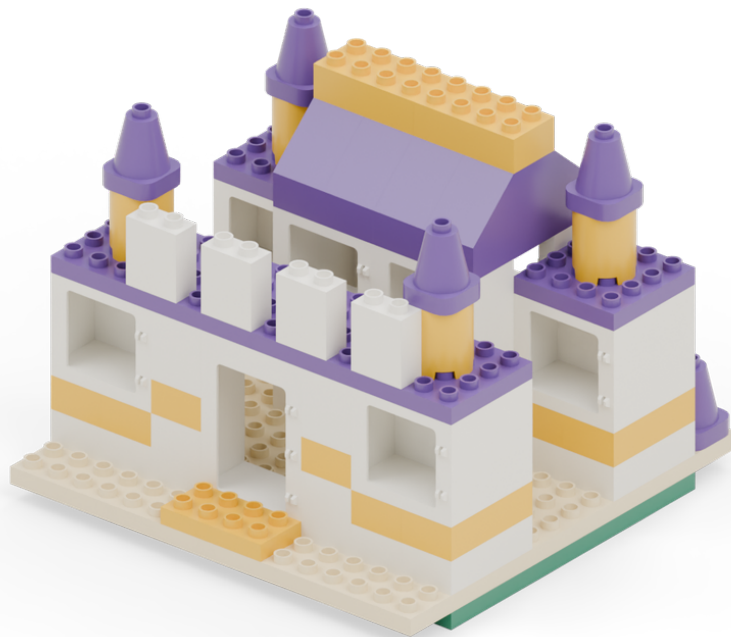
