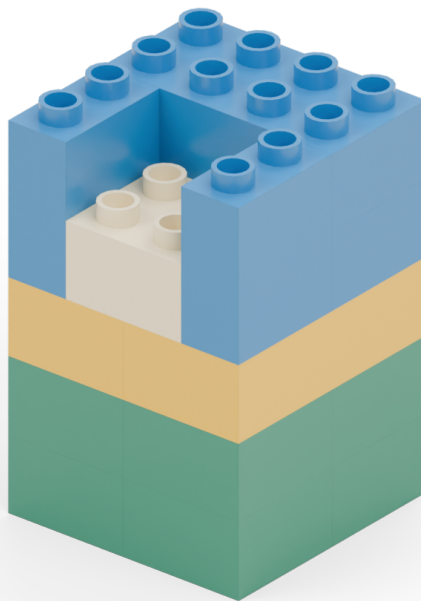


BUILD TOGETHER

Garden armchair

15 pieces / 7 steps

Make a cosy-looking armchair with blue arms and a cream seat cushion. A solid green base supports the bright seat and tall back.



A little model, a little story

Choose a pretend guest for the chair.

Describe the view from their garden seat.

Tell a short story for them to listen to.

Digital guide; no bricks included. Make it together with an adult.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Match the shapes

Compare each part with its picture and count its rows of studs. A square brick has two rows of two studs; a long brick has two rows of four. Use the full parts list for the exact shapes and quantities.

Follow the colours

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep contrasting colours where they help you recognise the model.

Count the studs

The bumps on top are called studs. Count them when a step asks for a gap or an overhang. Put the build on a flat surface and keep its front facing the same way as in the pictures.

Add a little at a time

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces look lighter so you can see what has changed. Each list tells you exactly what to add.

Build together

An adult can read the steps while a child finds the pieces. The counts are for this one model. For two models to stay built, add their parts lists together.

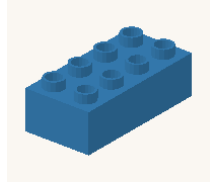
About this build

This is a miniature brick chair. Its cushion and arms are fixed in place.

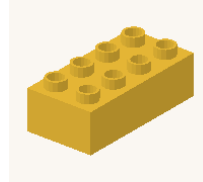
Exact parts checklist

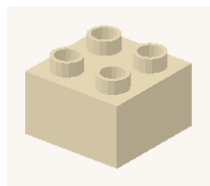

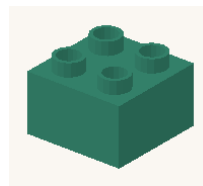

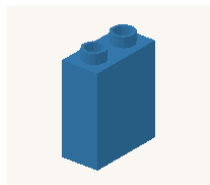

Use this list to sort the shapes. Check the full colour list before building; the two lists count the same pieces.

[] 9 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

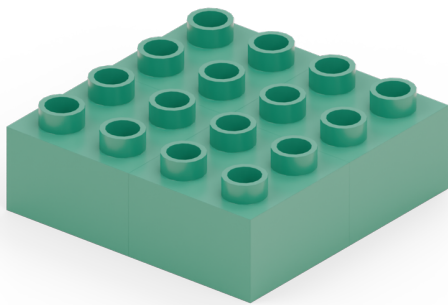
[] 2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 1 - 2

01 / Arrange four green square bricks into a four-by-four-stud square on the table.

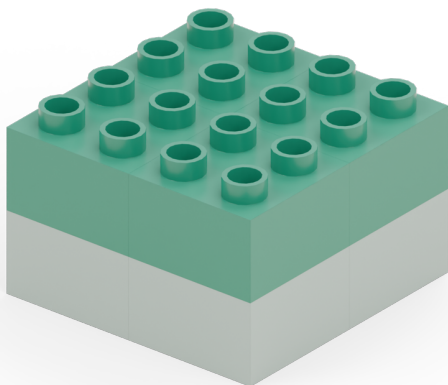


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Add one green square brick directly above each of the four base bricks.



ADD THESE PIECES

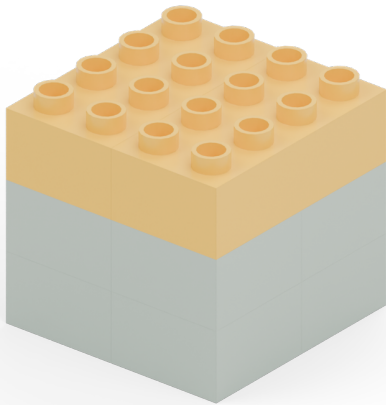
4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 3 - 4

03 / Make the seat with two yellow long bricks, side by side, running from front to back.

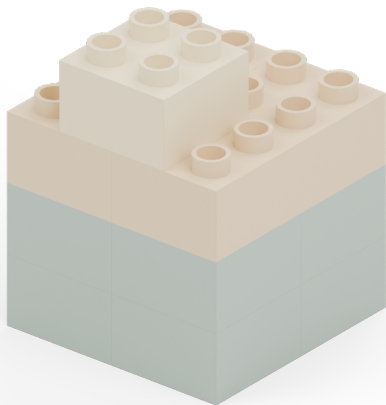


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Centre the cream square cushion on the front two rows of the seat. Leave one stud column showing on each side.



ADD THESE PIECES

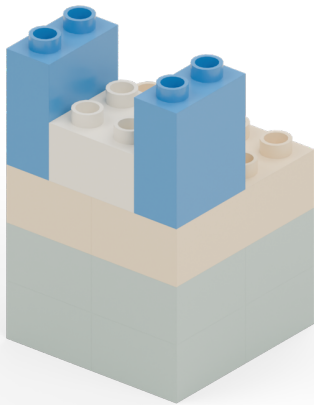
1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Cream)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 5 - 6

05 / Place a blue wall brick beside each side of the cushion to make the arms.

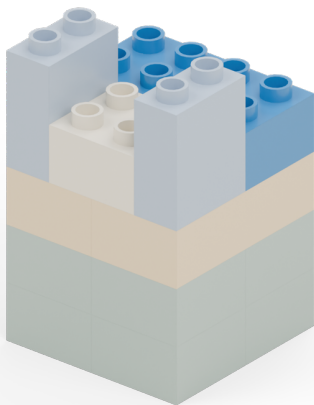


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)
(Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Turn a blue long brick across the back two rows of the seat to join both sides.



ADD THESE PIECES

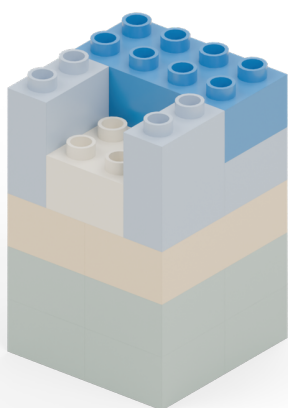
1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

BUILD, ONE STEP AT A TIME

Step 7

07 / Add a second blue long brick directly above the backrest. Press the back and both arms into place.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

READY TO PLAY

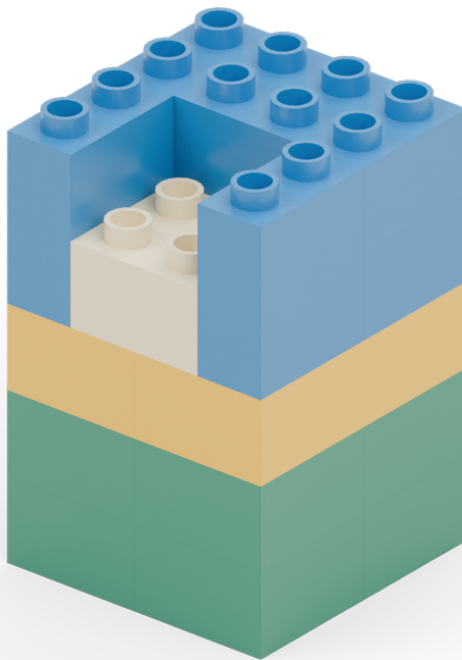
Your little story
