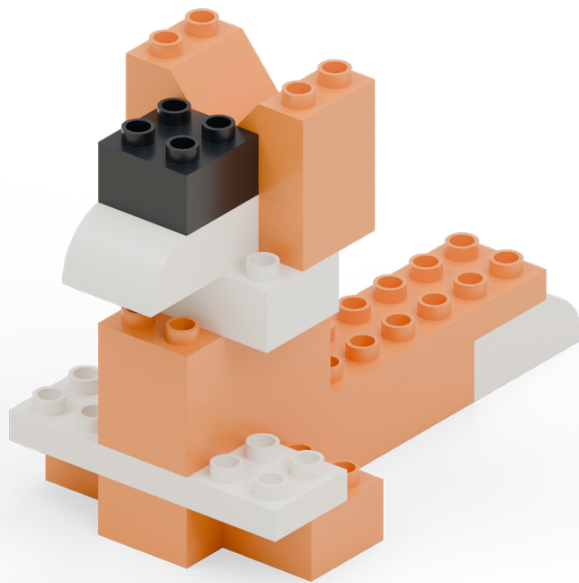


BUILD TOGETHER

Bushy-tailed fox

16 pieces / 11 steps

Build a sitting fox with pointed ears and a long, white-tipped tail resting on the ground.



A little model, a little story

Draw a winding trail for your fox to follow.

Make a den from a folded sheet of paper.

Take turns telling what the fox finds on its woodland walk.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

Choose how to play

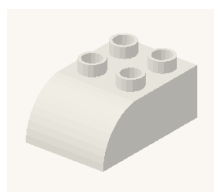
Choose one model and check its pieces first. Take it apart to reuse those pieces for another model. Pack-wide lists are optional planning tools; the exact-colour list follows the pictured palette.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

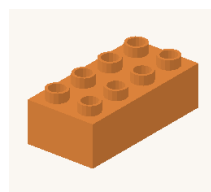
Exact parts checklist

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

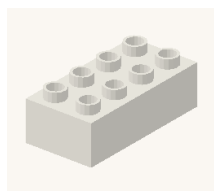

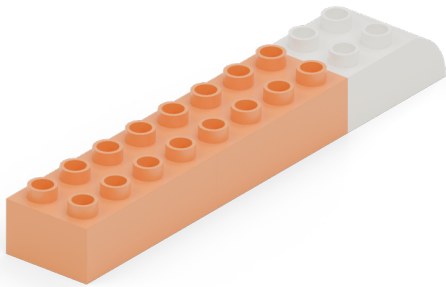
Shape-only checklist

[] 2 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) / [] 6 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) / [] 1 x Medium plate (2 × 6 studs) / [] 2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) / [] 2 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) / [] 3 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Place two orange long bricks end to end for a low tail and body support. Add a white curve at the back with its rounded tip pointing away from you.



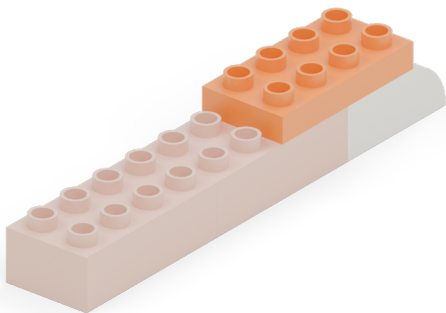
ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (White)

2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Join the white tip and orange tail with an orange small plate, centred over their join.



ADD THESE PIECES

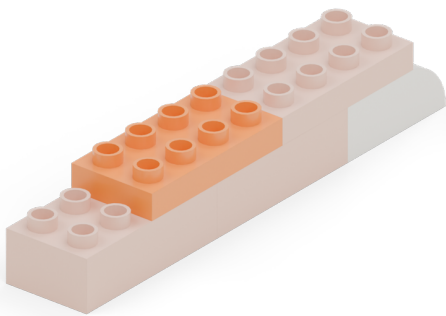
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Join the two orange support bricks with another orange small plate, centred over their join.

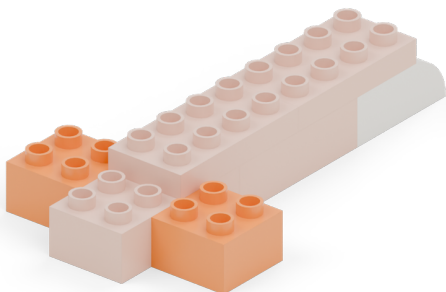


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Put two orange square feet on the table, one on each side of the front of the body.



ADD THESE PIECES

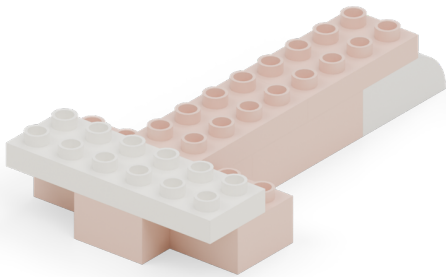
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Join the feet to the body with a white medium plate across the front. It sits on the feet, below the projecting body.

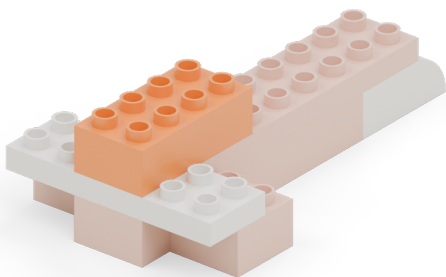


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Medium plate (2 × 6 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Put an orange long brick over the front support, starting one row behind the feet. Its rear half rests on the joining plate.



ADD THESE PIECES

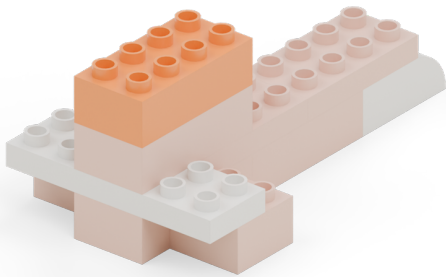
1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 7 - 8

07 / Stack another orange long brick directly on the first for a sitting body.

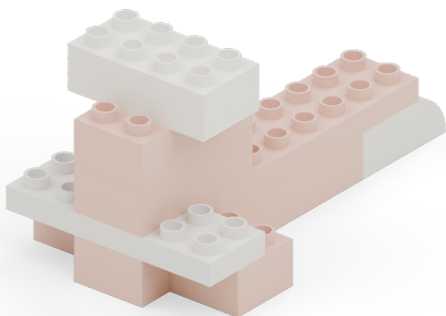


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Place a white long brick across the top of the body as the cheeks, centred left to right.



ADD THESE PIECES

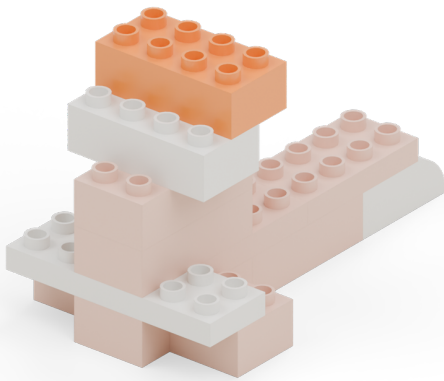
1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 9 - 10

09 / Add an orange long brick across the cheeks for the head.

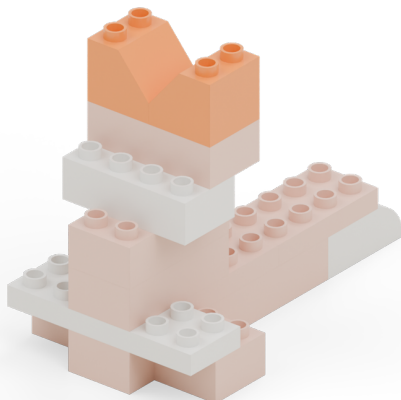


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

10 / Add an orange slope at each side of the head for two ears. Their high studded edges face outward, leaving a dip between the ears.



ADD THESE PIECES

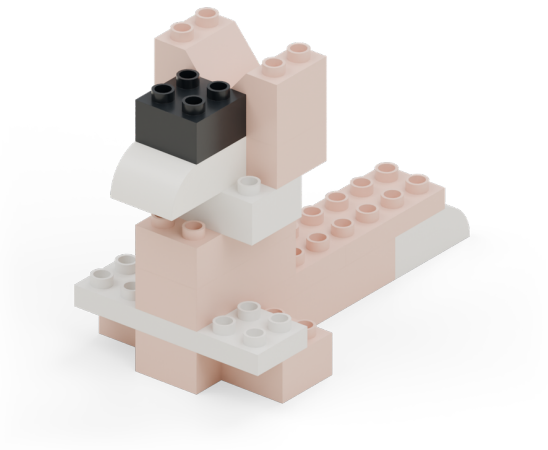
2 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) (Orange)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 11

11 / Place a white curve on the exposed front row of the cheeks, pointing forward as the muzzle. Add a black square on its flat rows for the nose.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (White)

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Black)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.
