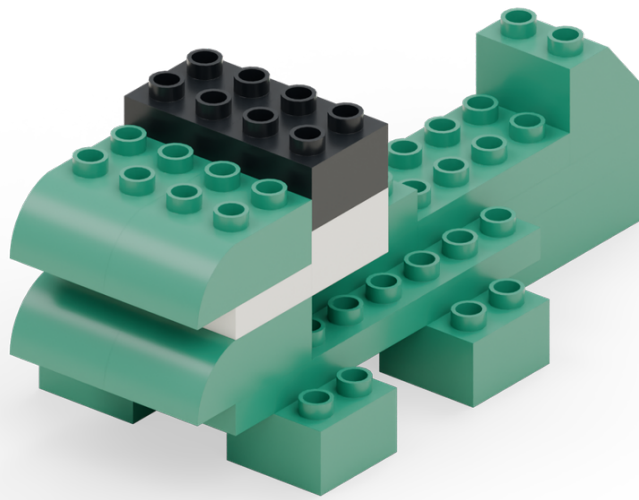


BUILD TOGETHER

Chunky crocodile

19 pieces / 11 steps

Make a low, long crocodile with a broad snout, raised eyes and a tail that rests on the table.



A little model, a little story

Draw a river on paper and park the crocodile beside it.

Count the bumps along its back.

Make up a story about a crocodile guarding a bridge.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

Choose how to play

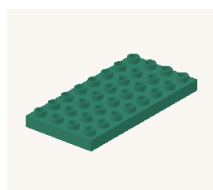
Choose one model and check its pieces first. Take it apart to reuse those pieces for another model. Pack-wide lists are optional planning tools; the exact-colour list follows the pictured palette.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

Exact parts checklist

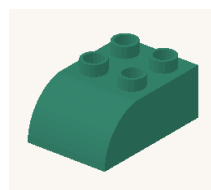
Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

Counts below are for this complete model.



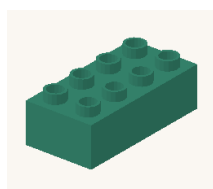
1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs)

Green / 4672a



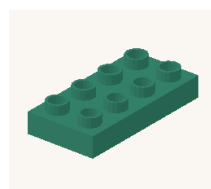
4 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs)

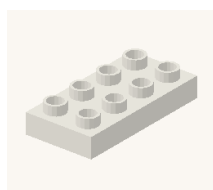
2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs)

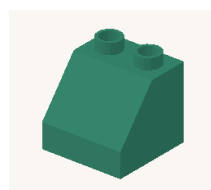
2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs)

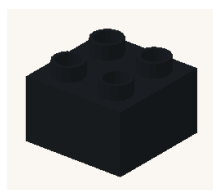
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs)

White / 40666



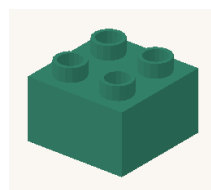
1 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs)

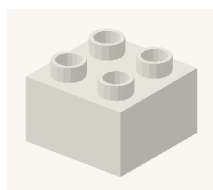
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

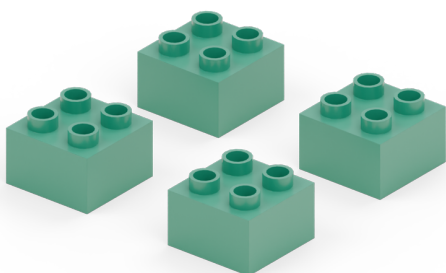
Shape-only checklist

[] 1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) / [] 4 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) / [] 2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) / [] 3 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) / [] 1 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) / [] 8 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Set out four green square bricks for the feet. Leave two clear columns between left and right feet, and two clear rows between the front and back pairs.

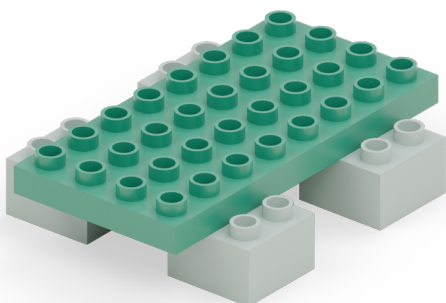


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Join the feet with the green base plate. One column of each foot sticks out at the sides, and one row of the plate projects at each end.



ADD THESE PIECES

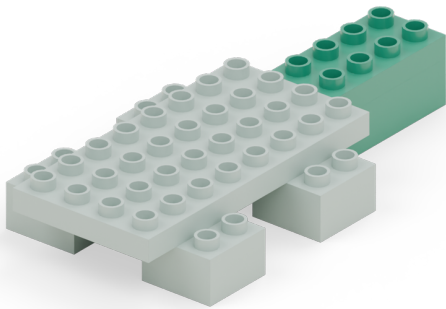
1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Put a green long brick on the table behind the body, centred across its width. Cover that tail brick with a green small plate.



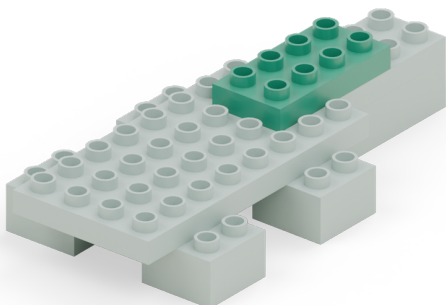
ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Join the tail to the body with a green small plate, centred over their meeting edge.



ADD THESE PIECES

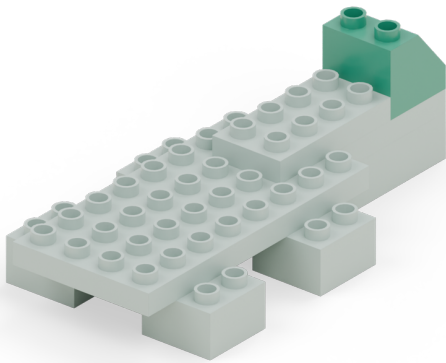
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Add a green slope to the back half of the tail, with the low end pointing away from the body.

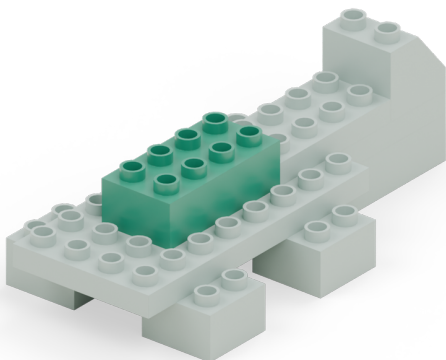


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Add a green long brick down the middle of the body, directly in front of the tail join.



ADD THESE PIECES

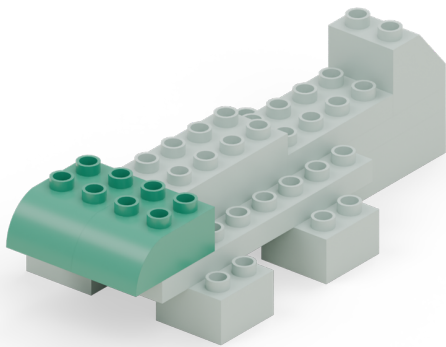
1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 7 - 8

07 / Put two green curves side by side at the front for the lower jaw. Their rounded ends project towards you.

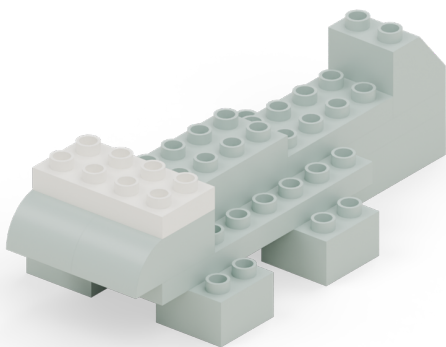


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Join the flat rows of the lower jaw with a white small plate turned across them for a pale mouth stripe.



ADD THESE PIECES

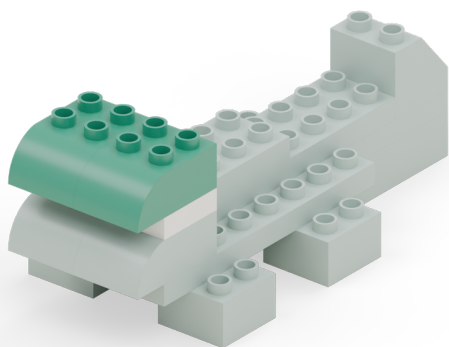
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 9 - 10

09 / Add two green curves over the mouth stripe for the upper jaw, rounded ends towards you. This snout stays fixed.

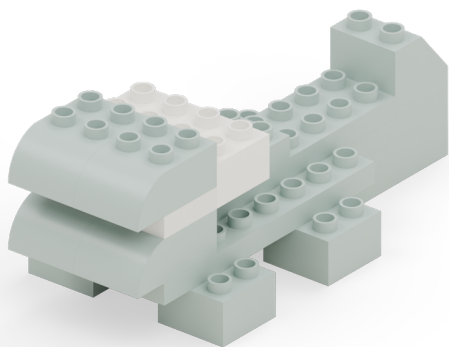


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

10 / Put two white square bricks just behind the snout, side by side across the body. Each grips one column of the middle green brick.



ADD THESE PIECES

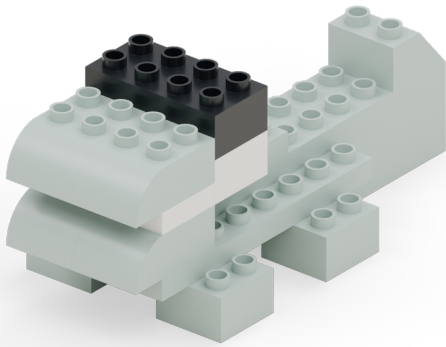
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 11

11 / Top the two white bricks with two black squares for raised eyes.



ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Black)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.
