

BUILD TOGETHER

Long-neck giraffe

23 pieces / 11 steps

Four broad hooves support this tall giraffe, with neck spots, little horns and a rounded muzzle.



A little model, a little story

Draw a tall tree and help the giraffe reach its leaves.

Find the four hooves, spotted body and long neck.

Tell a story about the giraffe meeting a much smaller animal.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

Choose how to play

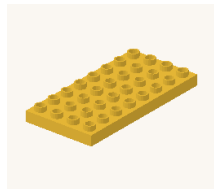
Choose one model and check its pieces first. Take it apart to reuse those pieces for another model. Pack-wide lists are optional planning tools; the exact-colour list follows the pictured palette.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

Exact parts checklist

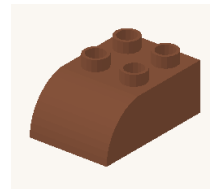
Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

Counts below are for this complete model.



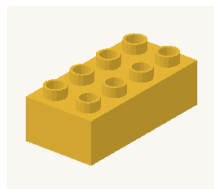
1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs)

Yellow / 4672a



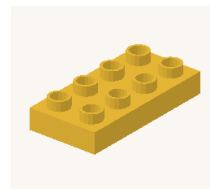
1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs)

Reddish Brown / 2302b



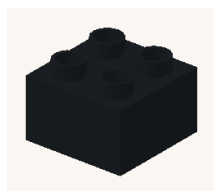
5 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs)

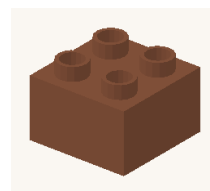
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs)

Yellow / 40666



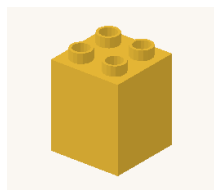
4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

Black / 3437



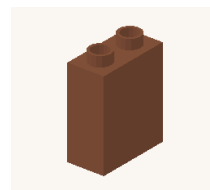
3 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

Reddish Brown / 4066b



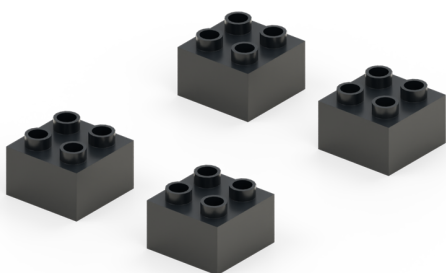
Shape-only checklist

[] 1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) / [] 1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) / [] 5 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) / [] 1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) / [] 7 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) / [] 6 x Tall square brick (2 × 2 studs, double height) / [] 2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Set four black square hooves in a rectangle. Leave two clear columns between the left and right feet, and four clear rows between the front and back pairs.

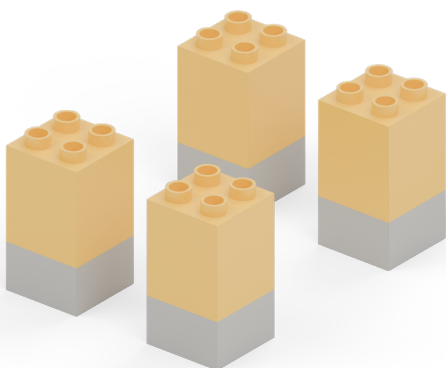


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Black)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Put a yellow tall square brick on each hoof for four long legs.



ADD THESE PIECES

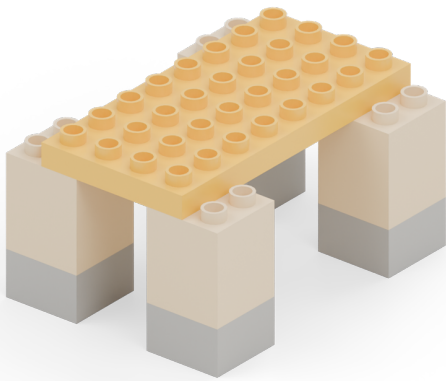
4 x Tall square brick (2 × 2 studs, double height) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Join the four legs with the yellow base plate. One outer column of each leg remains visible at the sides.

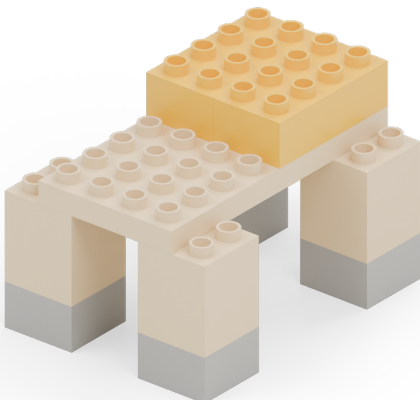


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Cover the rear half of the body with two yellow long bricks side by side.



ADD THESE PIECES

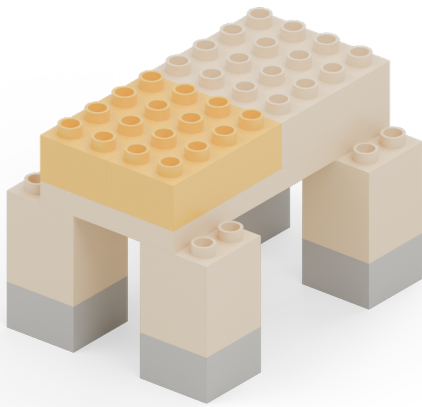
2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Cover the front half with two more yellow long bricks.

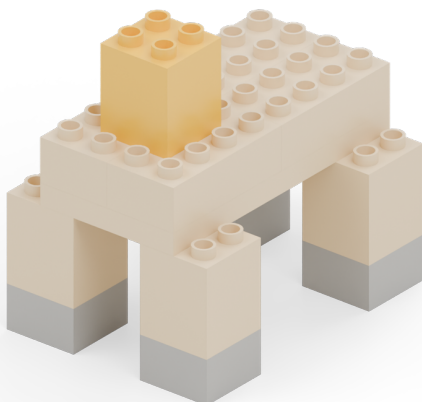


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Centre a yellow tall square near the front for the neck. Leave one body row showing in front.



ADD THESE PIECES

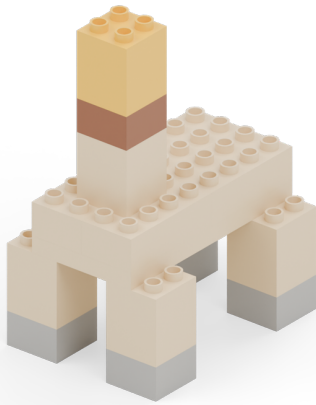
1 x Tall square brick (2 × 2 studs, double height) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 7 - 8

07 / Add a brown square brick to the neck for a spot. Stack a yellow tall square brick on it.



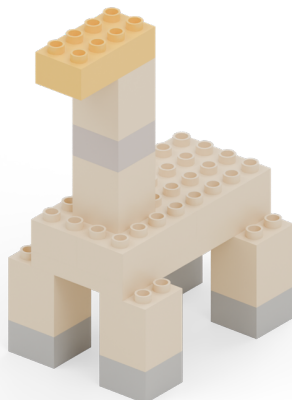
ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Reddish Brown)

1 x Tall square brick (2 × 2 studs, double height) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Put a yellow long brick along the top of the neck for the head, with two rows projecting forward.



ADD THESE PIECES

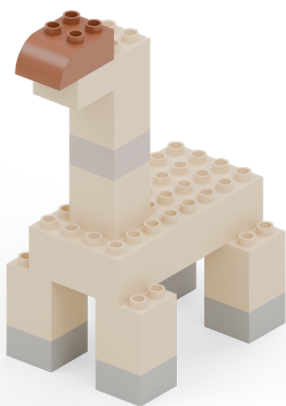
1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 9 - 10

09 / Put a brown curve at the front of the head for the muzzle. Its rounded end projects forward by one row.

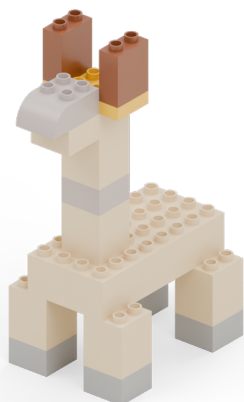


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

10 / Put a yellow small plate across the back half of the head for wide ears. Add a brown wall brick at each end for the two little horns.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

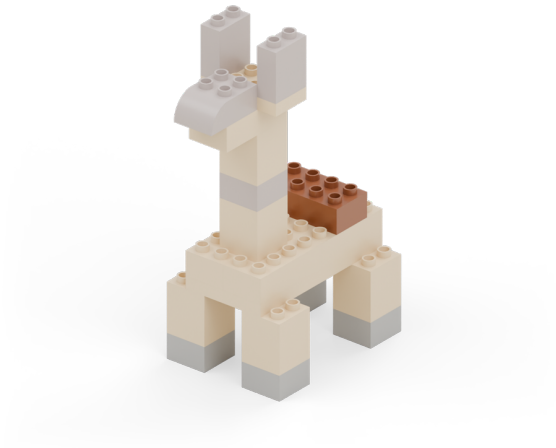
2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 11

11 / Add two brown squares side by side on the rear half of the back for body spots.



ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.
