

BUILD TOGETHER

Pocket penguin

10 pieces / 8 steps

A little penguin with a bright beak and broad feet, ready for a waddle across the table.



A little model, a little story

Draw an iceberg on paper and help your penguin reach it.

Count its two flippers and two wide feet.

Tell a story about a penguin looking for a friend.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

Choose how to play

Choose one model and check its pieces first. Take it apart to reuse those pieces for another model. Pack-wide lists are optional planning tools; the exact-colour list follows the pictured palette.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

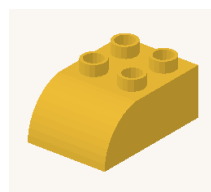
Exact parts checklist

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

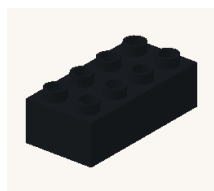

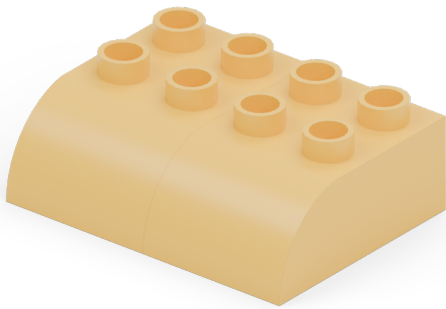
Shape-only checklist

[] 3 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) / [] 1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) / [] 2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) / [] 2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) / [] 2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Set two yellow curved feet side by side, rounded toes pointing towards you.

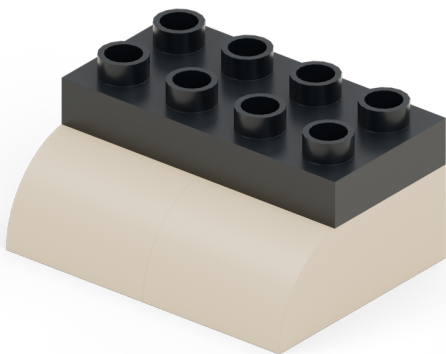


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Join the feet with a black small plate turned across their two flat rows. Keep both rounded toes visible.



ADD THESE PIECES

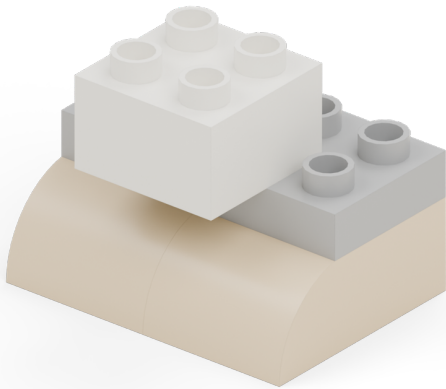
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Black)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Centre the white square belly on the front row of the black plate. One row projects towards the toes.

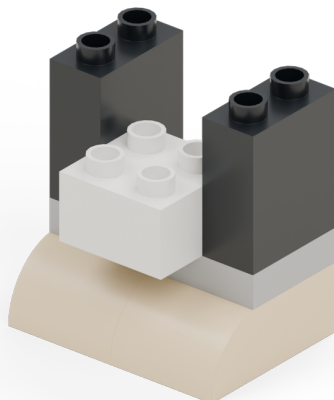


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Place a black wall brick on each side of the belly for the flippers. Their backs line up with the black plate.



ADD THESE PIECES

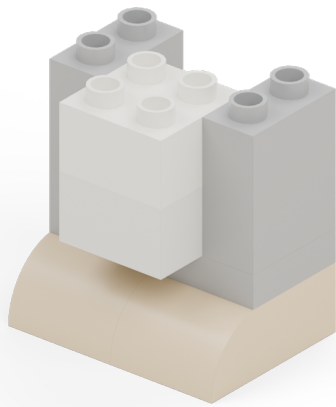
2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height) (Black)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Stack a second white square on the belly.

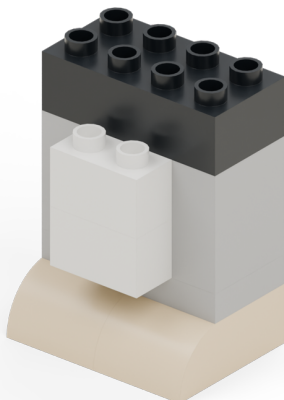


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Bridge the belly and flippers with a black long brick running from left to right.



ADD THESE PIECES

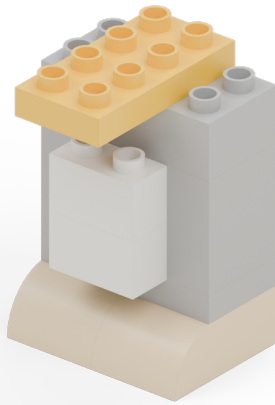
1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Black)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 7 - 8

07 / Centre a yellow small plate on the head, running towards you. Two rows project forward as the beak.

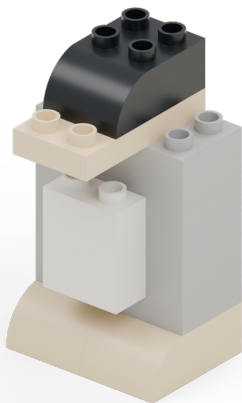


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Finish with a black curve over the back of the beak, rounded end pointing towards you. Leave the last yellow row showing.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Black)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.
