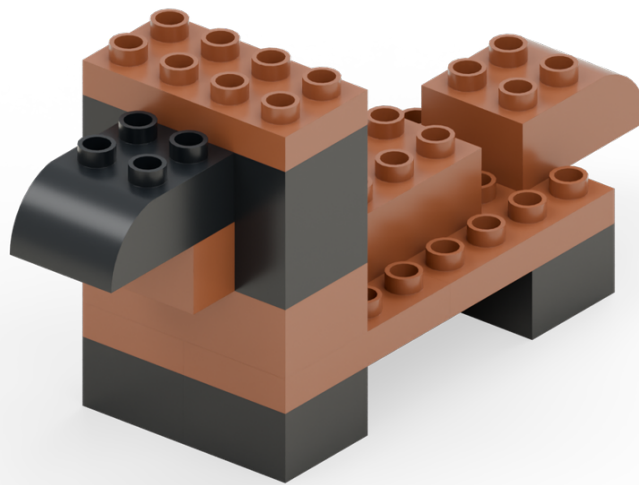


BUILD TOGETHER

Sausage dog

17 pieces / 9 steps

Build a long little dog with four short legs and ears that hang beside its face.



A little model, a little story

Draw a path and take your dog for a pretend walk.

Give the dog a name and describe its favourite game.

Make a paper blanket for a well-earned rest.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

Choose how to play

Choose one model and check its pieces first. Take it apart to reuse those pieces for another model. Pack-wide lists are optional planning tools; the exact-colour list follows the pictured palette.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

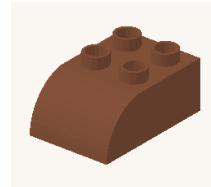
Exact parts checklist

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

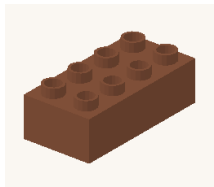

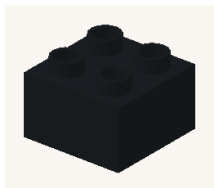

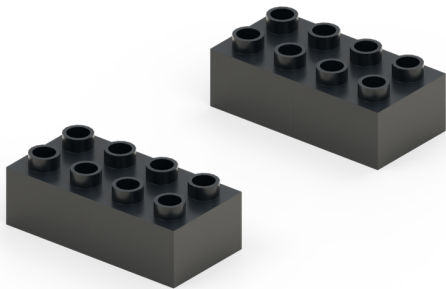
Shape-only checklist

[] 2 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) / [] 3 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) / [] 5 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) / [] 5 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) / [] 2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Set out four black square feet: a left and right pair at each end, with four clear rows between the front and back pairs.

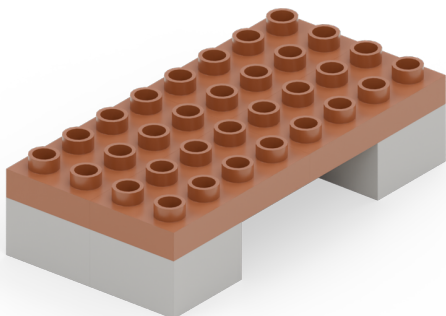


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Black)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Put four brown small plates over the feet to make a long body floor. The front and back plates meet in the middle.



ADD THESE PIECES

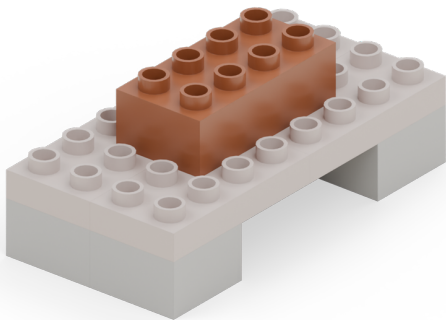
4 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Join all four floor plates with a brown long brick down the centre, crossing their middle join.

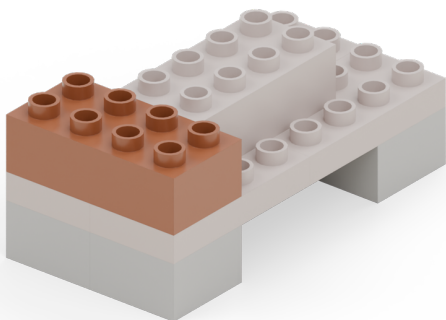


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Put a brown long brick across the front two rows for the base of the head.



ADD THESE PIECES

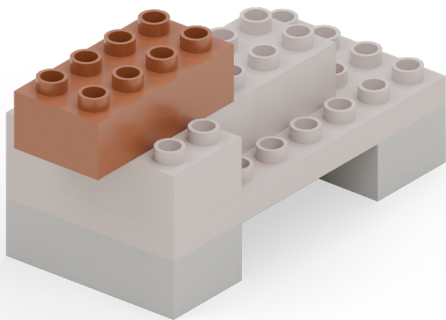
1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Centre another brown long brick along the head, running towards you. One row projects at each end of the lower head brick.

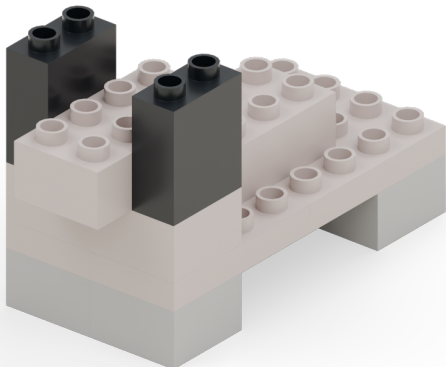


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Add a black wall brick at each side of the head for the long ears.



ADD THESE PIECES

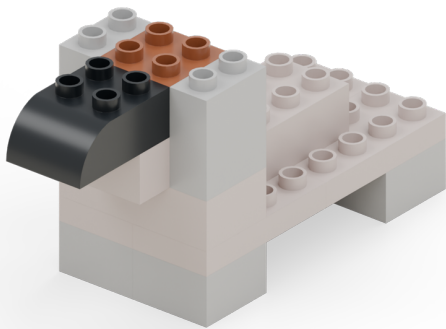
2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height) (Black)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 7 - 8

07 / Put a brown square between the ears. Add a black curve immediately in front of the nose, rounded end pointing towards you.



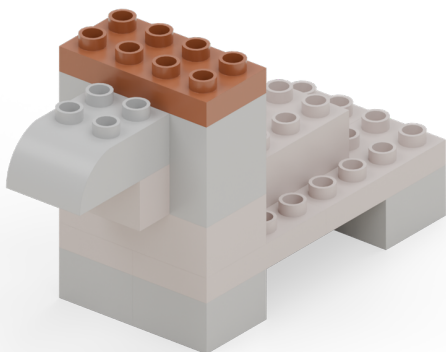
ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Black)

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Join the ears and head with a brown small plate turned across their tops.



ADD THESE PIECES

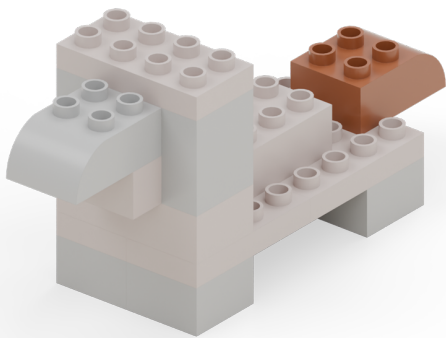
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 9

09 / Finish with a brown curve at the back for the short tail, rounded end pointing away. Its front row grips the body floor.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.
