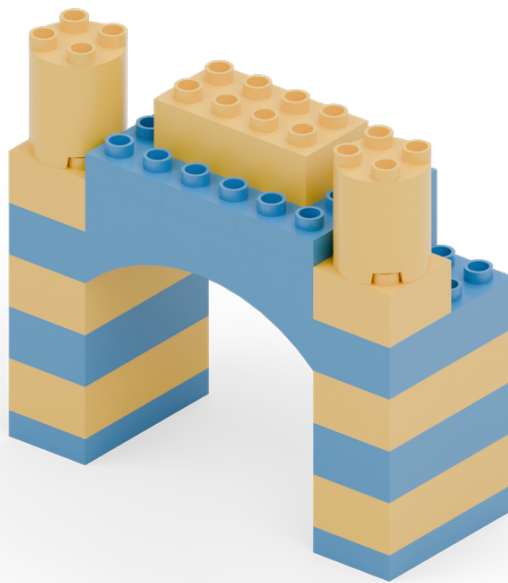


BUILD TOGETHER

Car-wash tunnel

24 pieces / 9 steps

Build an open car wash for the included little car, with a high canopy and fixed wash markers.



A little model, a little story

Make sure the way through is clear.

Drive the included little car straight through on a flat table.

Take turns greeting the driver and describing the pretend wash.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

Companion included: the 7-piece little car and its complete 6-step guide follow this model. Gather 31 pieces to build the tunnel and car together.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

Choose how to play

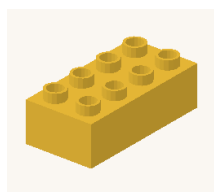
Choose one model and check its pieces first. Take it apart to reuse those pieces for another model. Pack-wide lists are optional planning tools; the exact-colour list follows the pictured palette.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

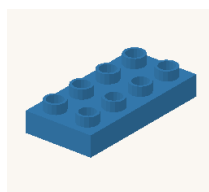
Exact parts checklist

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

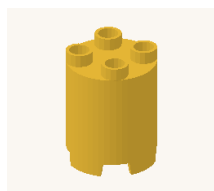

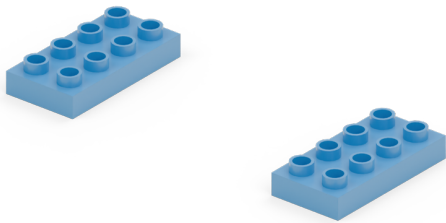
Shape-only checklist

[] 1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) / [] 5 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) / [] 2 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs) / [] 14 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) / [] 2 x Wide arch (2 × 10 studs)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Set two blue small plates parallel, with six clear stud columns between their inner edges. Leave the table between them clear for the car.

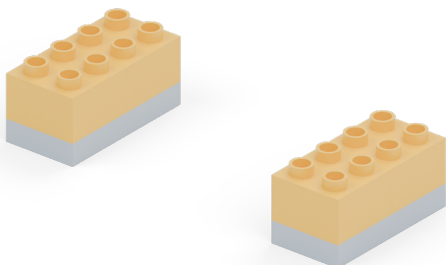


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Put one yellow square at the front and back of each side plate.



ADD THESE PIECES

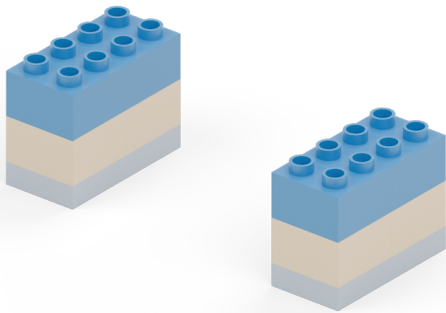
4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Stack a blue square on each of the four yellow squares.

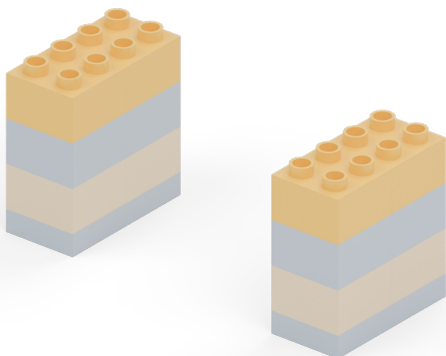


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Stack another yellow square on each blue square. All four columns now have the same height.



ADD THESE PIECES

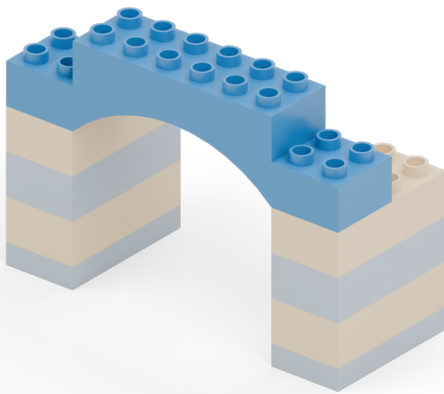
4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Bridge the front pair of columns with the blue wide arch, turned across the opening. The short feet of the arch sit on the outside columns.

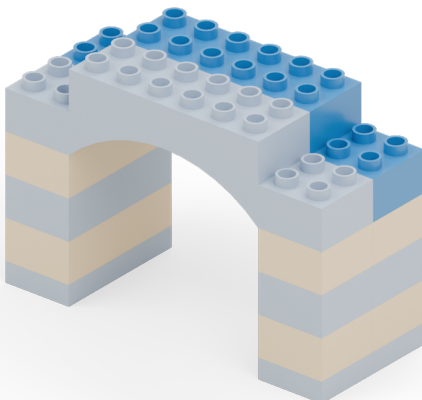


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Wide arch (2 × 10 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Bridge the back pair of columns with the second blue wide arch.



ADD THESE PIECES

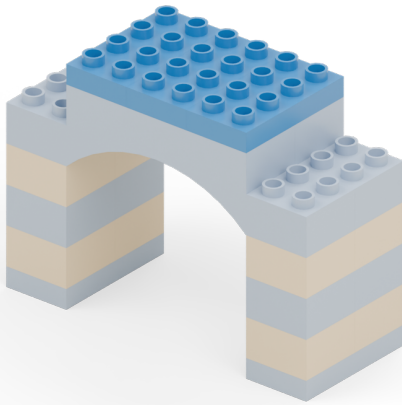
1 x Wide arch (2 × 10 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 7 - 8

07 / Join the two arch crowns with three blue small plates, running from back to front and filling the six middle columns.

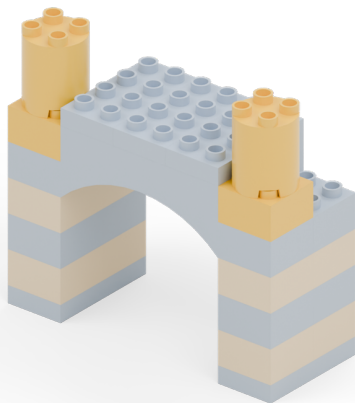


ADD THESE PIECES

3 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Put a yellow square and then a yellow round tower on each outside arch foot at the front. These are fixed wash markers; they do not turn.



ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

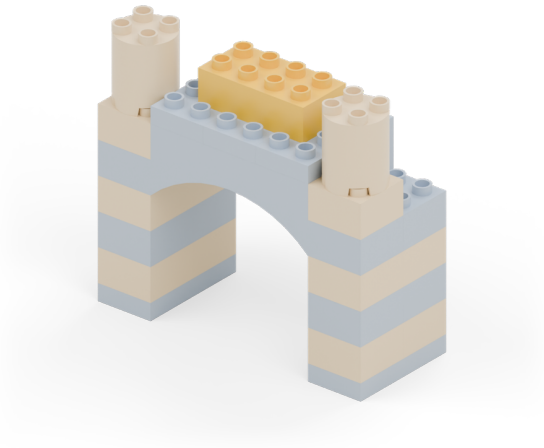
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 9

09 / Add a yellow long brick across the middle of the canopy as the sign. Use the included little car on the bare table through the centre; the bus is a separate route activity.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

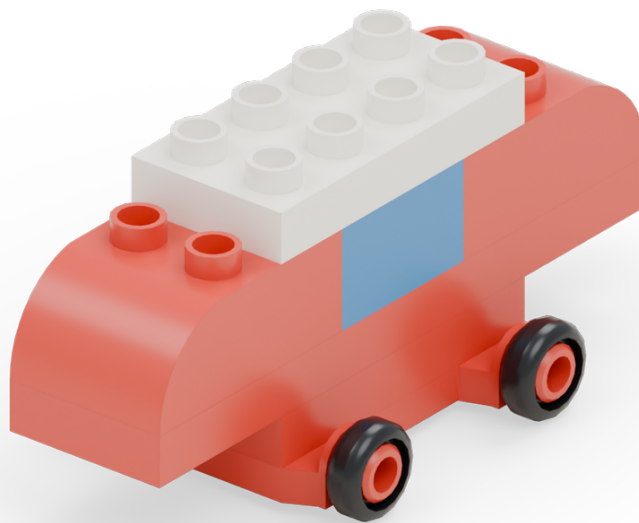
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BUILD TOGETHER

Little car

7 pieces / 6 steps

A small car with a red base and a blue cab, ready for the car wash or a paper-road adventure.



A little model, a little story

Follow a road drawn on paper.

Drive slowly through the matching car-wash tunnel.

Choose a parking place and plan the next journey.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

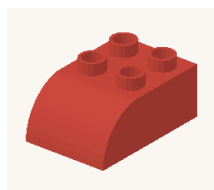

Exact parts checklist

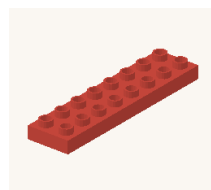
Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Compare your wheeled base with the picture before starting. We have not confirmed every real chassis and wheel version. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

Chassis with attached wheels counts as one assembled piece.



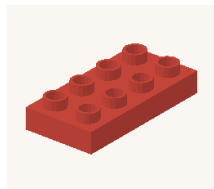
2 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs)

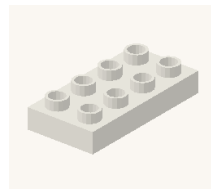
1 x Long plate (2 × 8 studs)

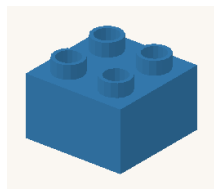
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs)

[] 2 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) / [] 1 x Long plate (2 × 8 studs) / [] 2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) / [] 1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) / [] 1 x Wheeled vehicle base (4 × 4 studs)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Set the red wheeled base on the table. It already has four black wheels; its two rows of top studs run along the car.

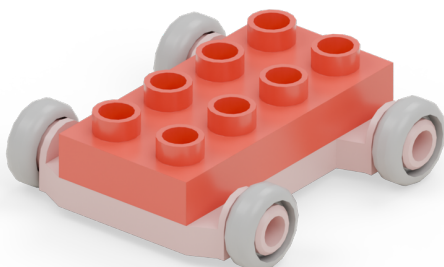


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Wheeled vehicle base (4 × 4 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Put the red small plate on all eight chassis studs to raise the body above the tyres.



ADD THESE PIECES

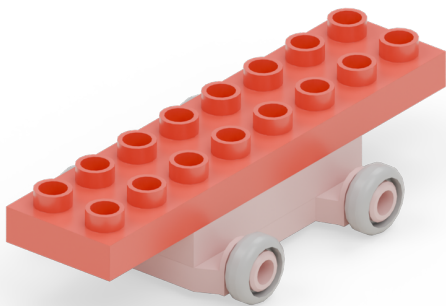
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Centre the red long plate lengthways over the chassis, overhanging by two stud rows at each end.

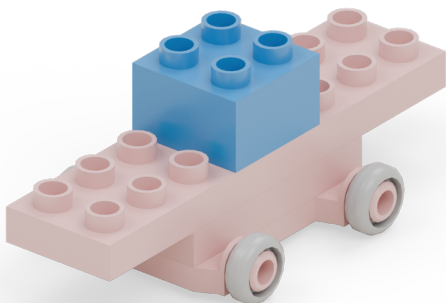


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long plate (2 × 8 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Centre the blue square on the long plate for the windows. Three rows of red studs remain at each end.



ADD THESE PIECES

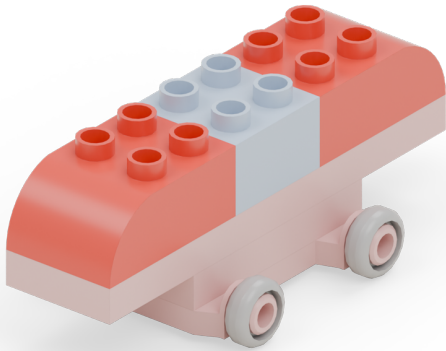
1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Fill each end of the long plate with a red curve. Point their rounded ends outward, away from the blue windows.

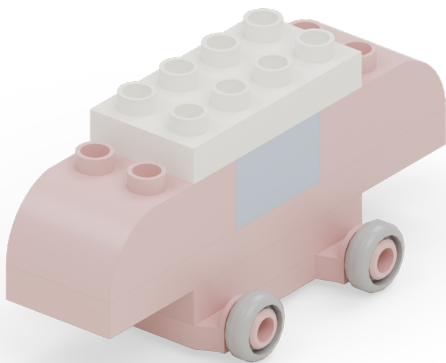


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Centre the white small plate above the windows. It also joins the first row of studs on each red curve.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.
