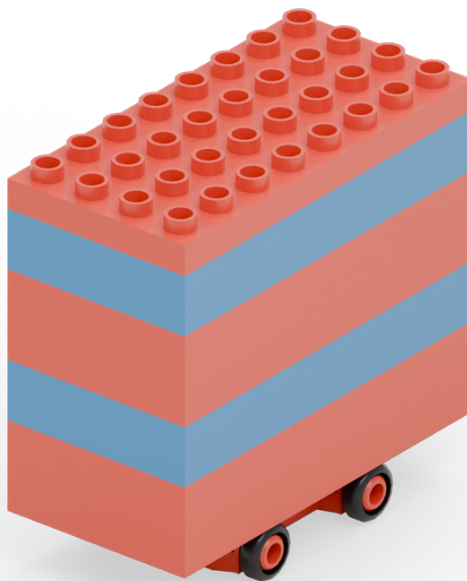


BUILD TOGETHER

Mini double-decker bus

21 pieces / 8 steps

Build a tall red bus with two blue window bands, ready for a slow journey around a paper town.



A little model, a little story

Draw a route with a home, park and café.

Move the bus slowly on a flat table and call out each stop.

Take turns driving and welcoming pretend passengers.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

Choose how to play

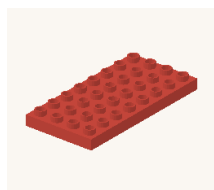
Choose one model and check its pieces first. Take it apart to reuse those pieces for another model. Pack-wide lists are optional planning tools; the exact-colour list follows the pictured palette.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

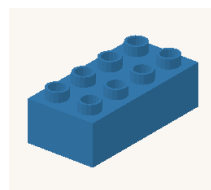
Exact parts checklist

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Compare your wheeled base with the picture before starting. We have not confirmed every real chassis and wheel version. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

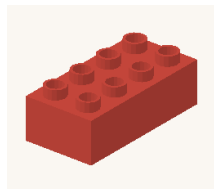
Chassis with attached wheels counts as one assembled piece.

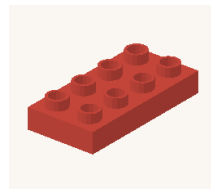

Shape-only checklist

[] 3 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) / [] 16 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) / [] 1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) / [] 1 x Wheeled vehicle base (4 × 4 studs)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Set the red wheeled base down, then cover its eight chassis studs with the red small plate.



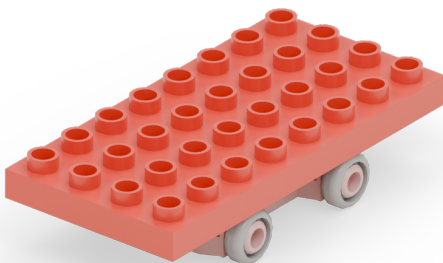
ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Red)

1 x Wheeled vehicle base (4 × 4 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Centre the red base plate over the chassis, with two rows projecting at each end.



ADD THESE PIECES

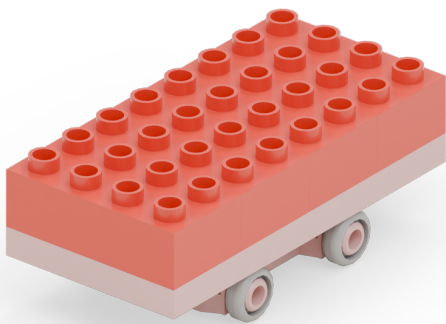
1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Make the lower red body with four long bricks laid across the floor in a row.

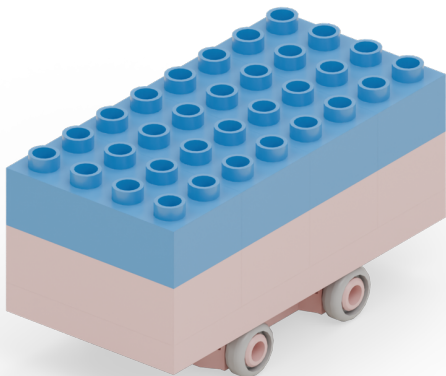


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Make a blue window band with four blue long bricks aligned over the red row.



ADD THESE PIECES

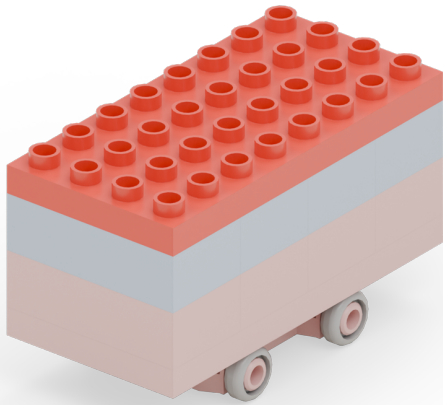
4 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Cover the windows with a red base plate as the upper-deck floor.

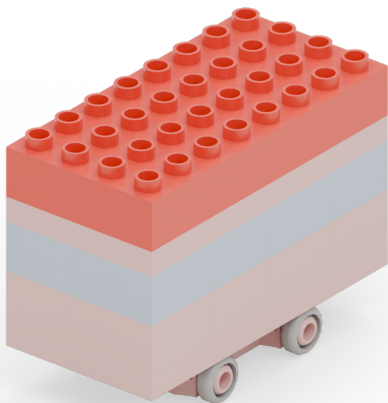


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Make the upper red body with four red long bricks across the floor.



ADD THESE PIECES

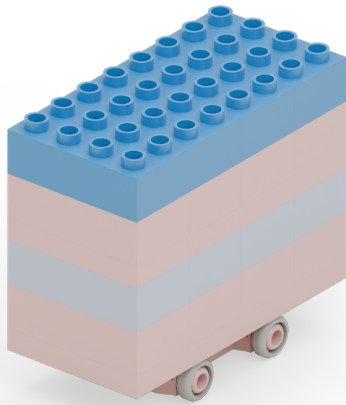
4 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 7 - 8

07 / Add four blue long bricks for the upstairs windows.

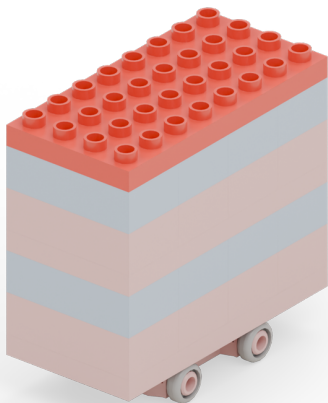


ADD THESE PIECES

4 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Finish with the red base plate for a flat roof. Move the bus slowly on a flat table; its tall body sits on a small wheeled base.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.
