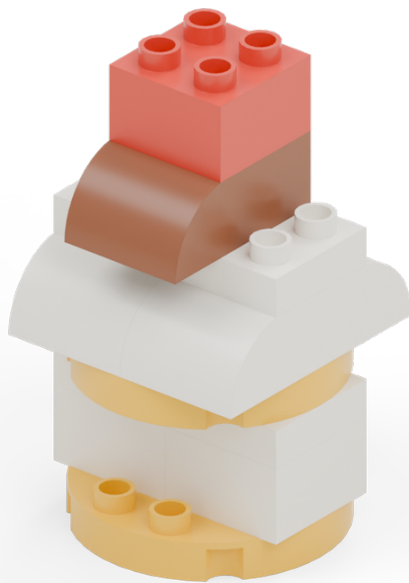


BUILD TOGETHER

Ice-cream sundae

10 pieces / 8 steps

Build a sundae with a broad dish, stacked scoops and a bright cherry on top.



A little model, a little story

Name the pretend vanilla, chocolate and cherry flavours.

Take turns ordering and serving a sundae.

Set the dish on the table and invent a name for your dessert.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

Choose how to play

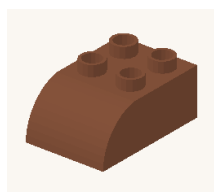
Choose one model and check its pieces first. Take it apart to reuse those pieces for another model. Pack-wide lists are optional planning tools; the exact-colour list follows the pictured palette.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

Exact parts checklist

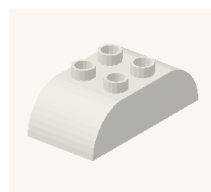
Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

Counts below are for this complete model.



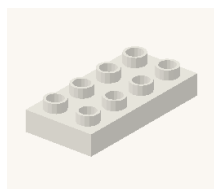
1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs)

Reddish Brown / 2302b



2 x Double curved brick (2 × 4 studs)

White / 98223b



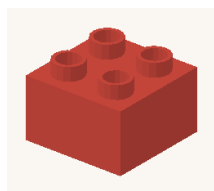
2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs)

White / 40666



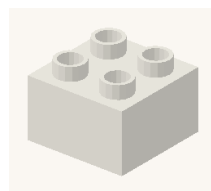
2 x Round plate (4 × 4 studs)

Yellow / 98222



1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

Red / 3437



2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

White / 3437



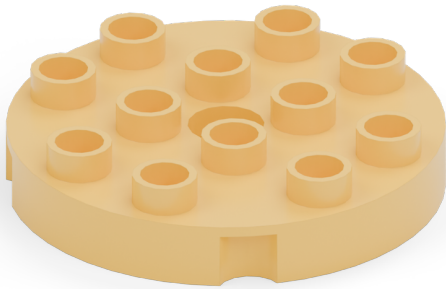
Shape-only checklist

[] 1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) / [] 2 x Double curved brick (2 × 4 studs) / [] 2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) / [] 2 x Round plate (4 × 4 studs) / [] 3 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Put the yellow round plate on the table as the foot of your sundae dish.

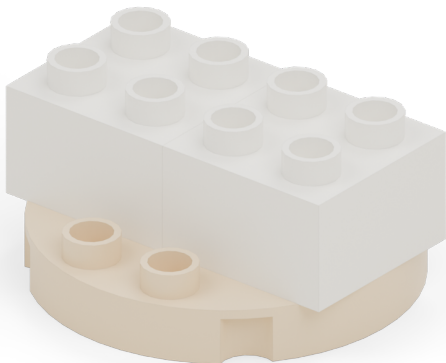


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Round plate (4 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Add two white square bricks side by side across the two middle rows. Keep a yellow row showing at the front and back.



ADD THESE PIECES

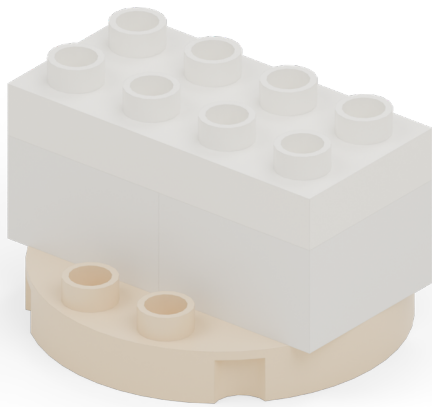
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Join the white bricks with a white small plate turned across their tops.

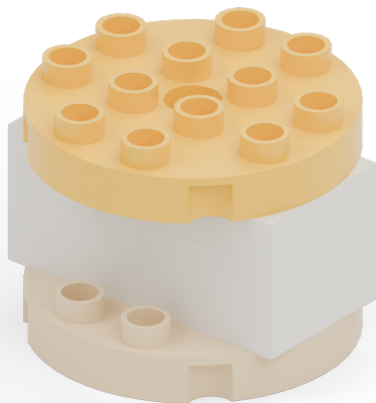


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Centre the other yellow round plate over the white stand for the dish.



ADD THESE PIECES

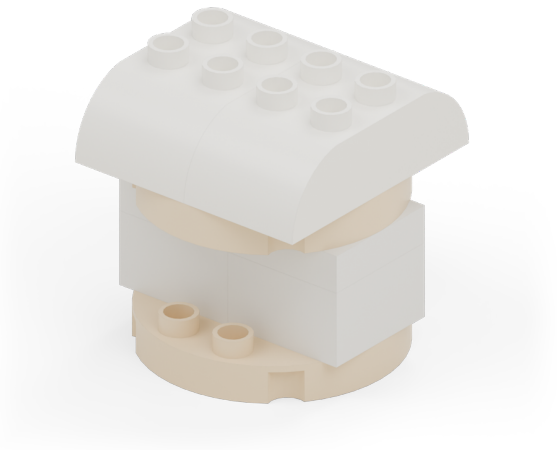
1 x Round plate (4 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Add two white double-curved bricks side by side as vanilla scoops, rounded ends towards the front and back.

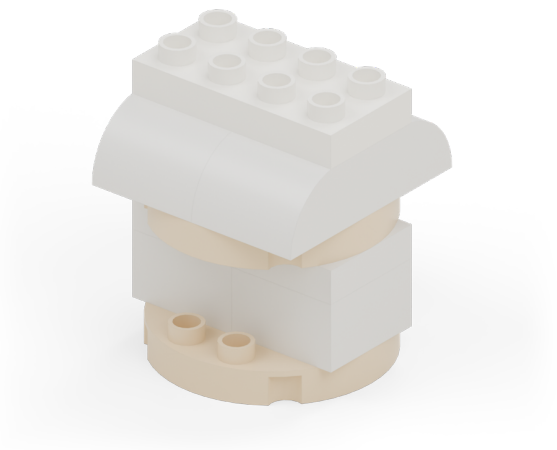


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Double curved brick (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Join the scoops with a white small plate across their two middle rows.



ADD THESE PIECES

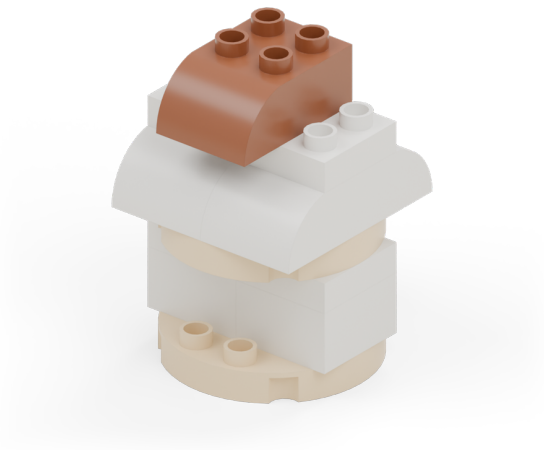
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 7 - 8

07 / Centre a brown curve on the white plate for a chocolate scoop, with its rounded end pointing towards you.

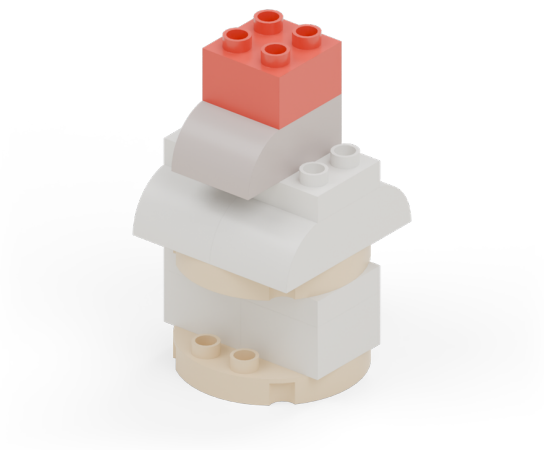


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Finish with the red square brick on the flat top of the brown curve for a chunky cherry.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.
