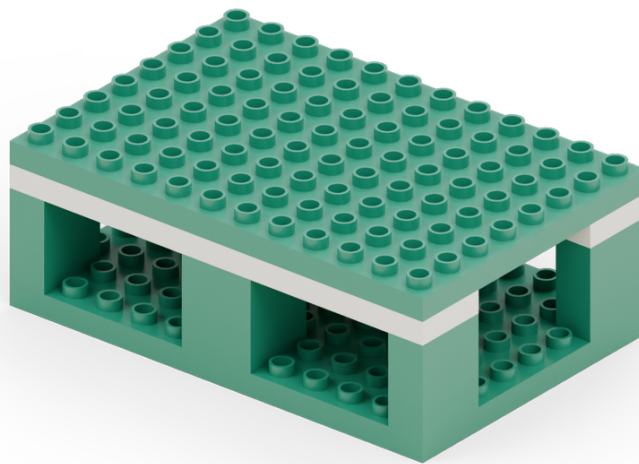


BUILD TOGETHER

Cafe serving counter

16 pieces / 8 steps

Build a café counter with open storage bays and space to serve one food beside the till.



A little model, a little story

Choose a burger, sundae or pizza from the picture menu.

Put that food beside the till on the counter; keep other foods on the table.

Take turns as customer and café owner.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

Choose how to play

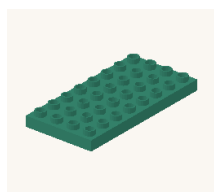
Choose one model and check its pieces first. Take it apart to reuse those pieces for another model. Pack-wide lists are optional planning tools; the exact-colour list follows the pictured palette.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

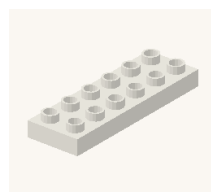
Exact parts checklist

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

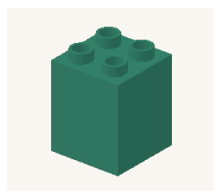
Counts below are for this complete model.

**6 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs)**

Green / 4672a

**4 x Medium plate (2 × 6 studs)**

White / 98233

**2 x Tall square brick (2 × 2 studs, double height)**

Green / 31110

**4 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)**

Green / 4066b

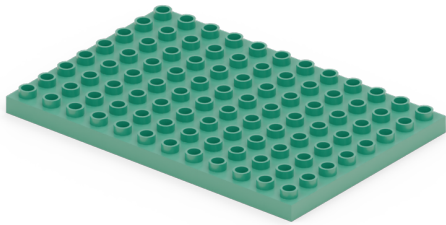
Shape-only checklist

[] 6 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) / [] 4 x Medium plate (2 × 6 studs) / [] 2 x Tall square brick (2 × 2 studs, double height) / [] 4 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Set three green base plates side by side, long edges touching, for a wide counter floor.

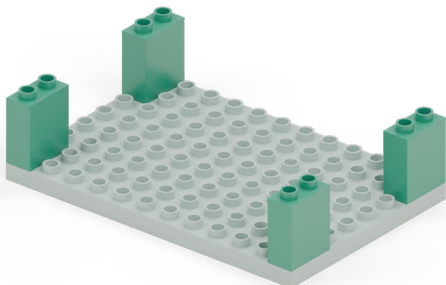


ADD THESE PIECES

3 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Put a green wall brick at each outside corner, with its narrow edge facing the front. Leave the spaces between the corners open.



ADD THESE PIECES

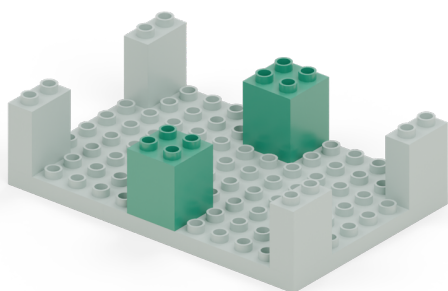
4 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Centre a green tall square brick on the front two rows, and another on the back two rows. They form the middle support.

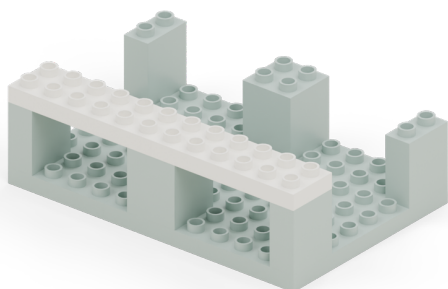


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Tall square brick (2 × 2 studs, double height) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Bridge the front supports with two white medium plates turned across the counter. They meet over the middle support.



ADD THESE PIECES

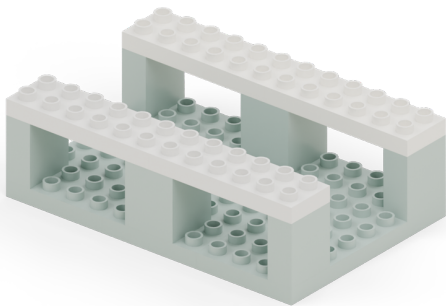
2 x Medium plate (2 × 6 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Bridge the back supports with two more white medium plates, again meeting in the middle.

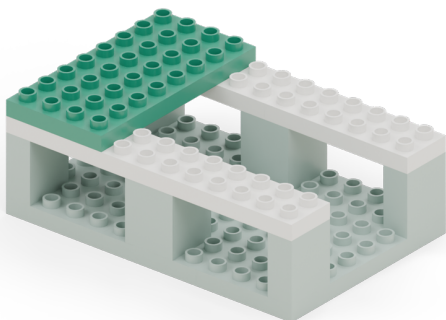


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Medium plate (2 × 6 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Put a green base plate over the left third of the white beams, running from back to front.



ADD THESE PIECES

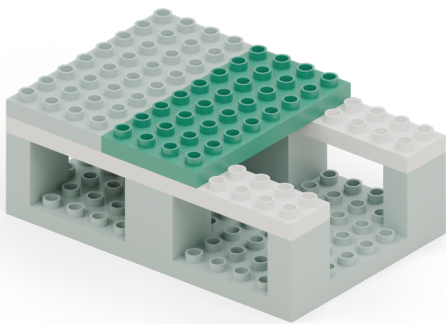
1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 7 - 8

07 / Add a green base plate over the middle third, with its long edge touching the first.

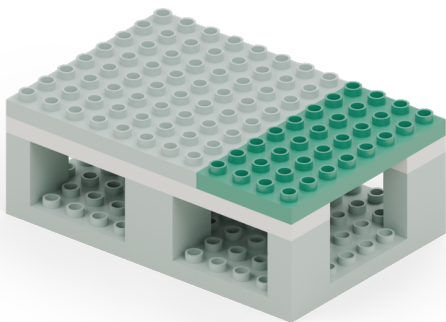


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Finish the surface with the last green base plate on the right. The pizza tray fits beside the till; serve the burger and sundae in separate orders.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.
