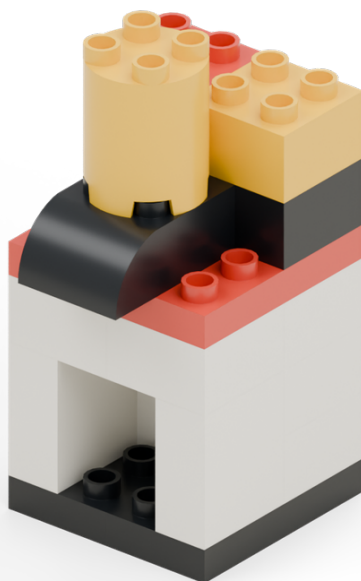


BUILD TOGETHER

Pretend coffee machine

15 pieces / 9 steps

Make a café machine with a little serving space for a paper cup and fixed pretend controls.



A little model, a little story

Place a tiny paper cup in the serving space.

Ask for a pretend drink, point to a control and serve your customer.

Take a coffee-and-toast order from the picture menu.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

Optional paper cup: up to 28 mm wide and 30 mm tall. Slide it in from the front; use pretend drinks only.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

Choose how to play

Choose one model and check its pieces first. Take it apart to reuse those pieces for another model. Pack-wide lists are optional planning tools; the exact-colour list follows the pictured palette.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

Exact parts checklist

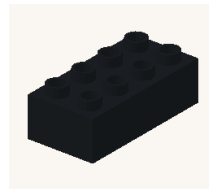
Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

Counts below are for this complete model.



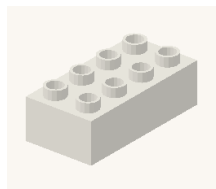
1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs)

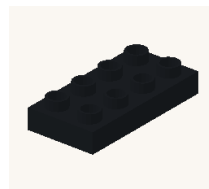
1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs)

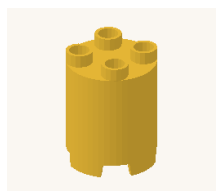
3 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs)

White / 3011



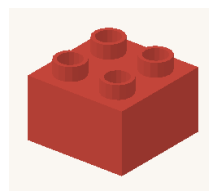
2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs)

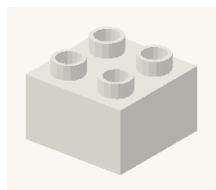
1 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs)

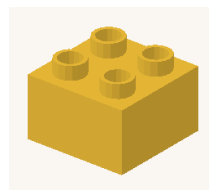
1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

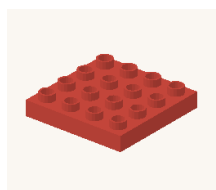
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

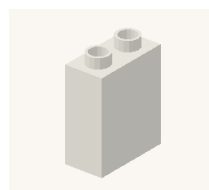
1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs)

Shape-only checklist

[] 1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) / [] 4 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) / [] 2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) / [] 1 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs) / [] 4 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) / [] 1 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs) / [] 2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Lay two black small plates side by side for the drip-tray base.

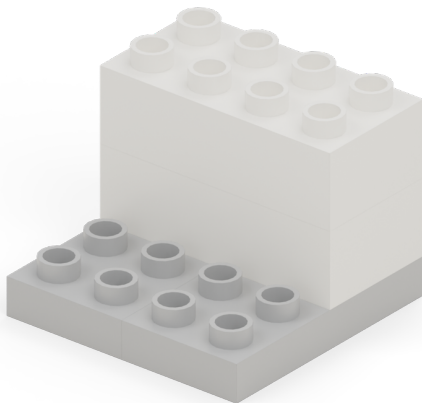


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Black)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Join the base plates with two white long bricks across the rear half, one on top of the other.



ADD THESE PIECES

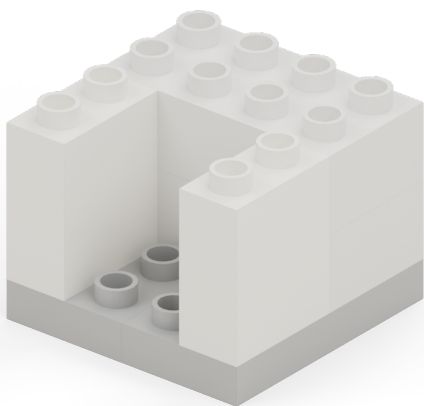
2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Put one white wall brick down each side of the front half. The two middle columns stay clear for a paper cup.

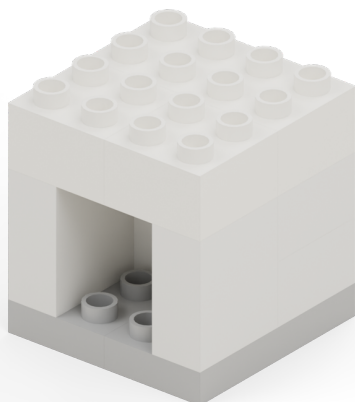


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)
(White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Add another white long brick across the back and a white square brick at each front corner. Together they bridge the top of the cup opening.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (White)

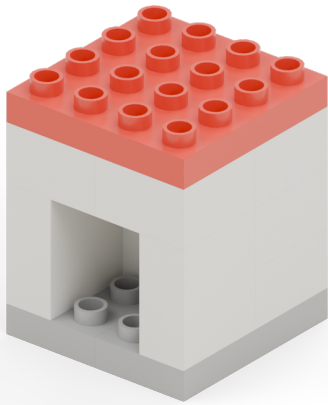
2 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Join the top with a red square plate. There is an open recess below the two front white squares.

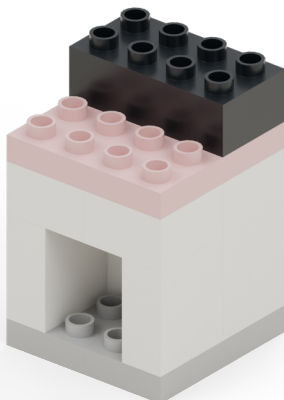


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Put a black long brick across the rear half of the top for the control panel.



ADD THESE PIECES

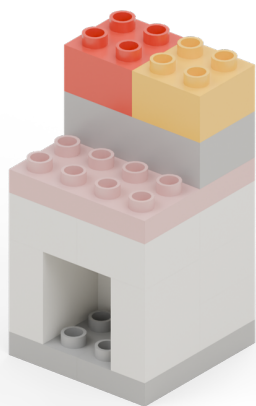
1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Black)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 7 - 8

07 / Put a red square at the left and a yellow square at the right of the panel for fixed pretend controls.



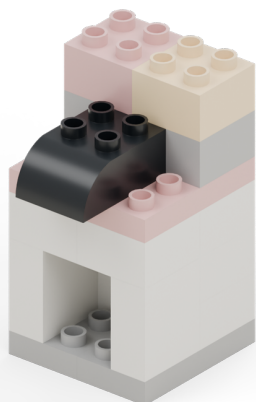
ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Red)

1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Add a black curve at the front of the red top plate, centred across it. Its rounded end projects forward as a fixed spout.



ADD THESE PIECES

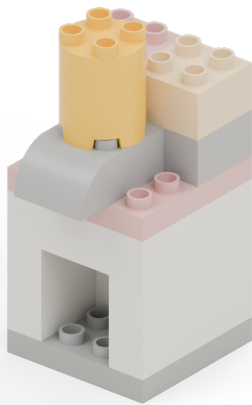
1 x Curved brick (2 × 3 studs) (Black)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 9

09 / Put a yellow round tower on the flat rows of the black spout for the pretend water tank. No real liquid goes in this model.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Round tower brick (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.
