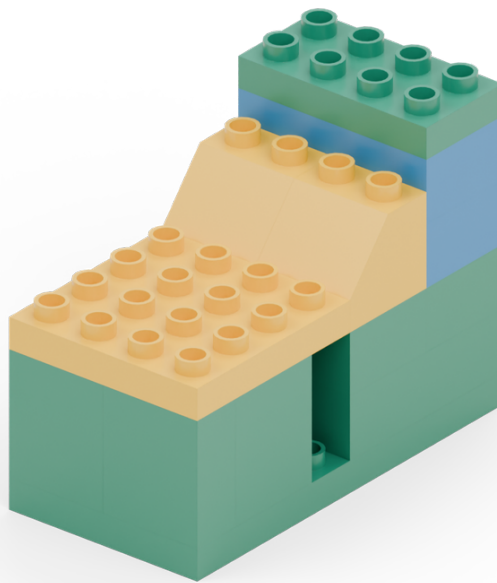


BUILD TOGETHER

Shop till

15 pieces / 9 steps

Make a shop till with a sloping keypad, a screen and a lift-off cash-box cover.



A little model, a little story

Lift the yellow cover to take a pretend payment.

Point to the screen and count the orders.

Swap customer and shopkeeper roles.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

Choose how to play

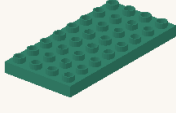
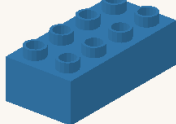
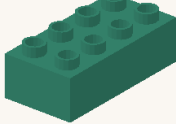
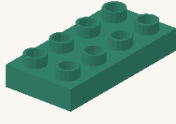
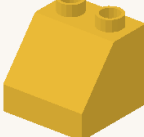
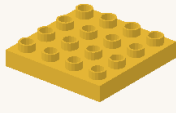
Choose one model and check its pieces first. Take it apart to reuse those pieces for another model. Pack-wide lists are optional planning tools; the exact-colour list follows the pictured palette.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

Exact parts checklist

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

Counts below are for this complete model.

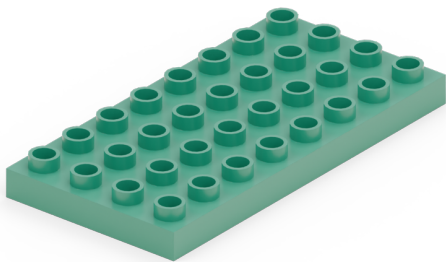
Shape-only checklist

[] 1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) / [] 6 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) / [] 1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) / [] 2 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) / [] 1 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs) / [] 4 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Place the green base plate lengthways. The cash box will be nearest you.

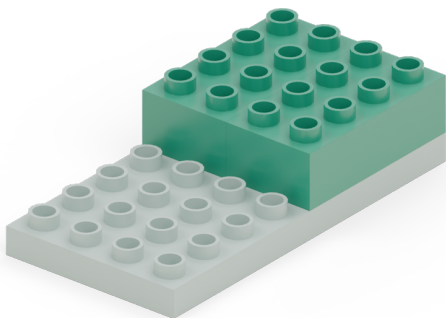


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Build the back housing with two green long bricks side by side, on the back four rows.



ADD THESE PIECES

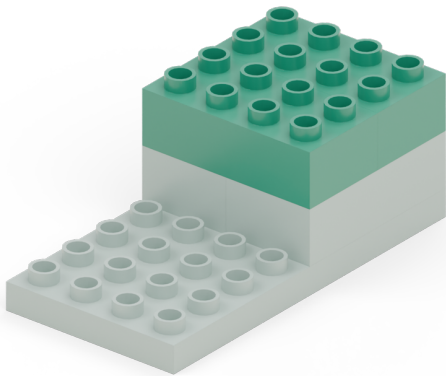
2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Raise the back housing with two more green long bricks, turned across the first pair.

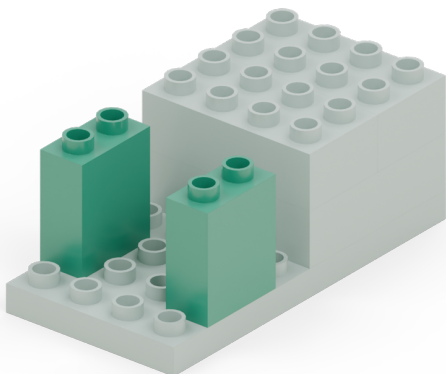


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Build the cash-box sides with a green wall brick on each outside edge at the front.



ADD THESE PIECES

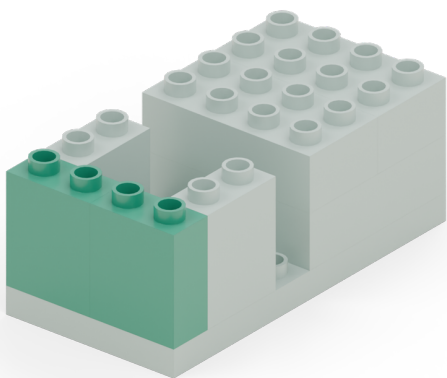
2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Close the front edge of the cash box with two green wall bricks turned across it, side by side. The two-by-three-stud well behind them stays empty.

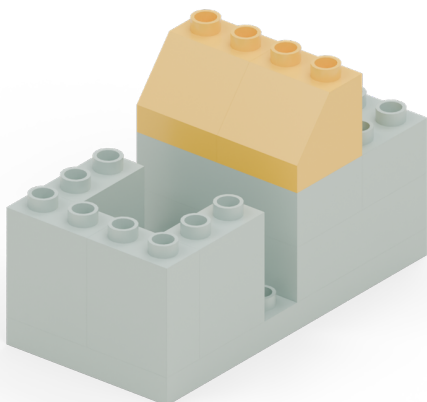


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)
(Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Put two yellow slopes on the front half of the back housing for the keypad. Point their low ends towards the cash box.



ADD THESE PIECES

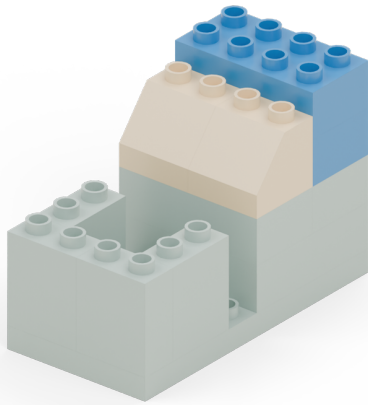
2 x Roof slope (2 × 2 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 7 - 8

07 / Put a blue long brick across the back row of the housing for a screen. Stack another blue long brick on it.

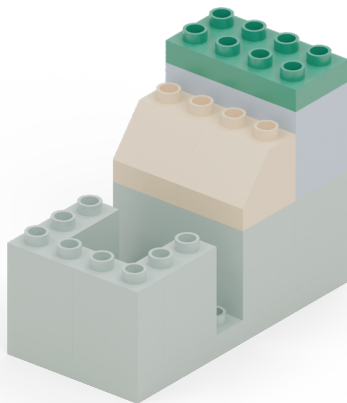


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Blue)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Cap the screen with a green small plate across it.



ADD THESE PIECES

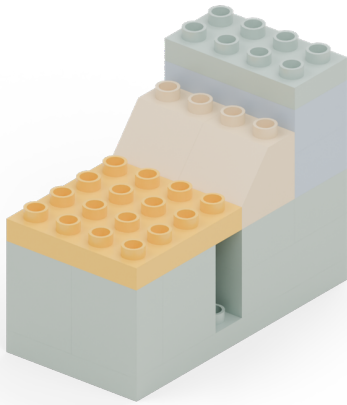
1 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 9

09 / Cover the cash box with the yellow square plate. Lift the whole plate straight up to open it. Use pretend payments when you play.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Square plate (4 × 4 studs) (Yellow)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.
