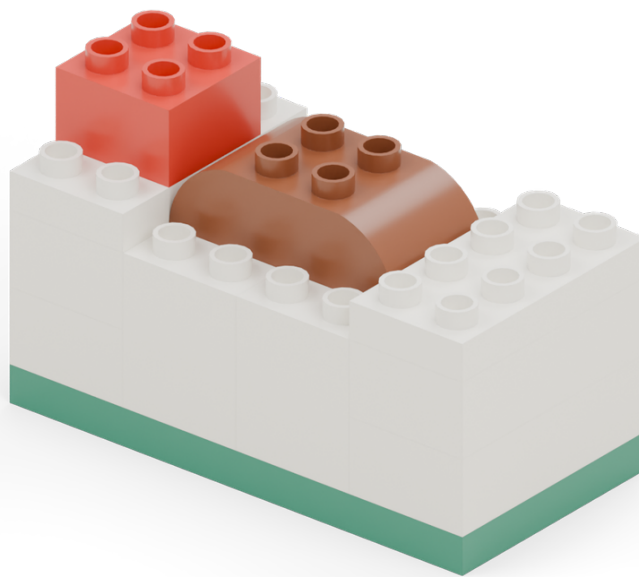


BUILD TOGETHER

Toaster and removable toast

15 pieces / 9 steps

Make a toaster with an open slot and a chunky slice of toast that lifts straight out.



A little model, a little story

Lift the toast by its top edge and serve it flat on the table.

Ask your customer to choose a pretend topping.

Put the toast back in the slot for the next order.

Build together with an adult. No bricks included.

GETTING STARTED

Before you build

Find the pieces

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Use the pictured part and stud dimensions to find the same shape.

Count the studs

Studs are the round bumps on top. Count the lines of studs across and along a piece. When a step leaves a clear row or column, keep that space empty. Match the picture to keep the model facing the same way.

Follow the colour

New pieces keep their colour in each step. Earlier pieces are lighter so you can see what to add. The finished-model picture shows all the colours together.

Choose how to play

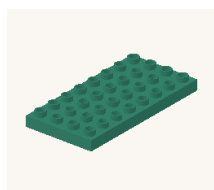
Choose one model and check its pieces first. Take it apart to reuse those pieces for another model. Pack-wide lists are optional planning tools; the exact-colour list follows the pictured palette.

GATHER YOUR PIECES

Exact parts checklist

Match the shapes and quantities. The pictures show our colours. Colour names in the steps refer to the pictures. Keep useful contrasts, such as a light belly against a dark body. Match the pictured shapes and part numbers to your bricks.

Counts below are for this complete model.



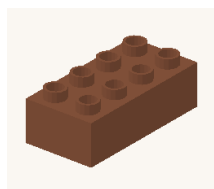
1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs)

Green / 4672a



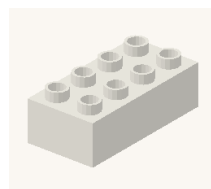
1 x Double curved brick (2 × 4 studs)

Reddish Brown / 98223b



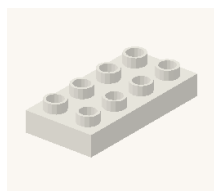
2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs)

Reddish Brown / 3011



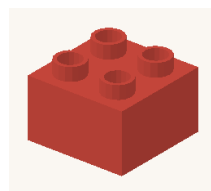
4 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs)

White / 3011



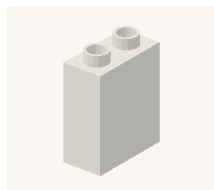
2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs)

White / 4066b

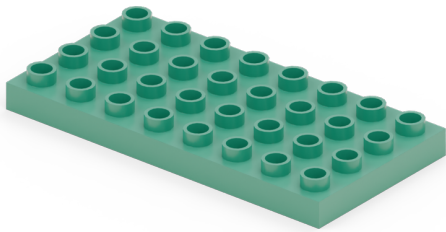
Shape-only checklist

[] 1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) / [] 1 x Double curved brick (2 × 4 studs) / [] 6 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) / [] 2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) / [] 1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) / [] 4 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height)

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 1 - 2

01 / Turn the green base plate across the table, with eight studs from left to right.

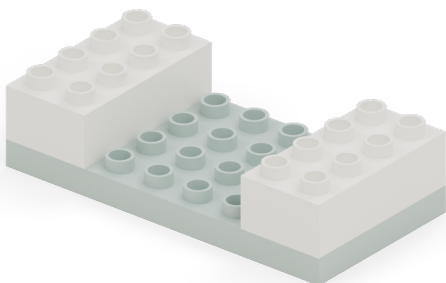


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Base plate (4 × 8 studs) (Green)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

02 / Put a white long brick down each end of the plate, running from back to front.



ADD THESE PIECES

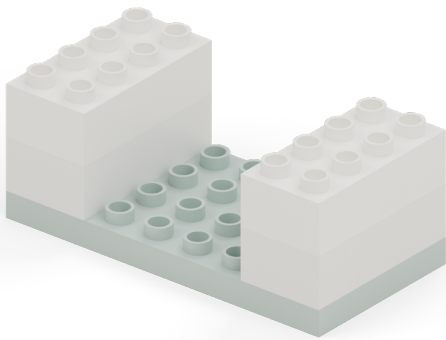
2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 3 - 4

03 / Stack a second white long brick on each end.

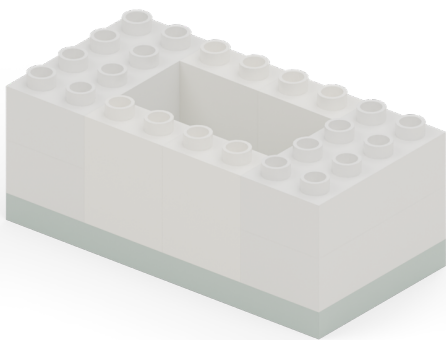


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

04 / Fill the middle of the front and back edges with white wall bricks turned across the slot. Leave the two middle rows clear.



ADD THESE PIECES

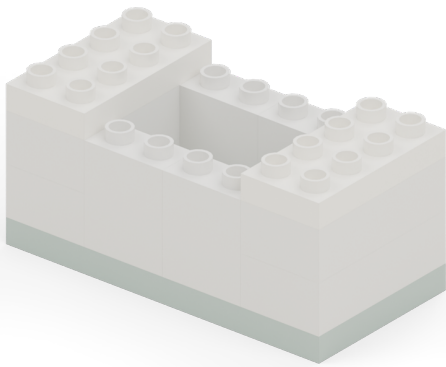
4 x Wall brick (1 × 2 studs, double height) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 5 - 6

05 / Cap each end with a white small plate running from back to front.

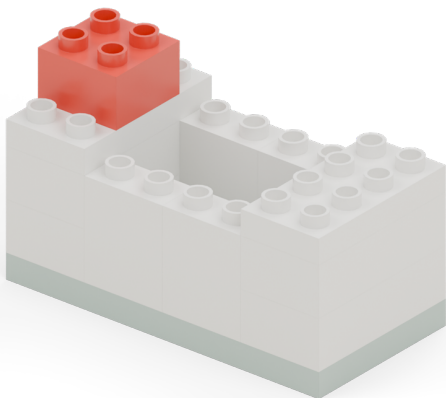


ADD THESE PIECES

2 x Small plate (2 × 4 studs) (White)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

06 / Add the red square on the left end as a pretend control. It stays fixed.



ADD THESE PIECES

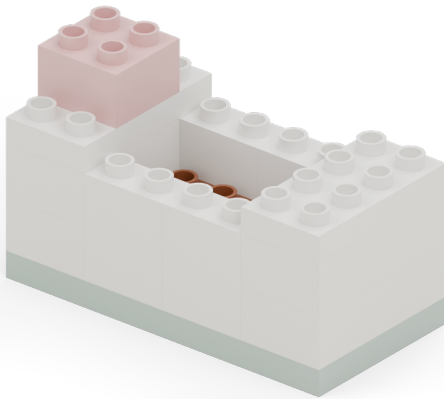
1 x Square brick (2 × 2 studs) (Red)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 7 - 8

07 / Start the toast in the slot with a brown long brick turned across the base. It fills the middle four columns and two rows.

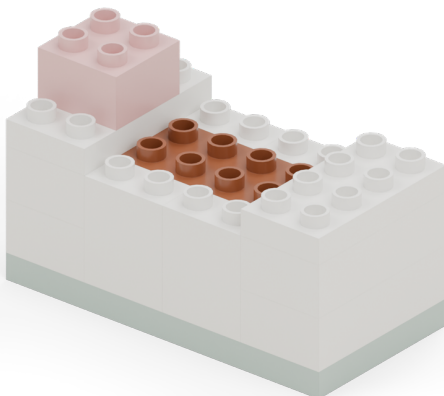


ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

08 / Stack a second brown long brick directly on the first.



ADD THESE PIECES

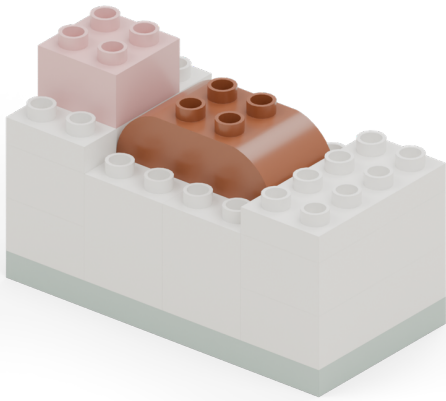
1 x Long brick (2 × 4 studs) (Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.

FOLLOW THE PICTURES

Steps 9

09 / Round off the toast with a brown double-curved brick turned across its top. Lift these three brown pieces together to remove the toast.



ADD THESE PIECES

1 x Double curved brick (2 × 4 studs)
(Reddish Brown)

New pieces keep their colour. Earlier pieces are lighter.
